Dear Ron,

While we will be meeting soon in Toronto, I wanted to C0165 congratulate you quickly and personally on the results of your meetings with General Secretary Gorbachev in Moscow.

The arms control agenda facing you there was imposing and important. Although it was not possible to achieve a START agreement, I am encouraged by your evident determination to press forward on this issue and look forward to further positive results. I also congratulate you on ensuring that the INF treaty could be signed into force in Moscow.

At the same time I was pleased that you conveyed the general Western perception that, although the USSR has taken some positive steps on the question of human rights, much still remains to be done, particularly in the context of the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe Follow-up Meeting in Vienna.

Your discussions on regional questions helped to advance the day when we can expect resolution of some of the thornier questions, although no one expects miracles in the immediate future.

Finally, one of the most important features of the summit was the positive mood which the signature of so many bilateral agreements demonstrated. Greater cooperation between the USA and the USSR in so many fields can only serve to advance the prospects of resolving the more intractable problems between East and West.


