Recently we reviewed the suggested appointments to the U.S. National Commission for UNESCO.

I have advised Drew Arena through Mike Parrell that a quick review pointed up three persons who should be removed or replaced: Mary Hatwood Futrell, Walter Orr Roberts, and Louis Clapper.

Futrell is a national officer of the National Education Association which actively participated in the political arena in 1980 and as you know, never for candidates who share the President's philosophy. This slot could easily go to an educator who actively supported the President in 1980, perhaps one who is a member of the National Association of Professional Educators, the professional association set up for those educators who wanted an alternative to the NEA.

Roberts is from the Aspen Institute on Hazanistic Studies. Upon talking with persons from The Heritage Foundation, they advised that for such a commission, the Aspen Institute would represent views contrary to the Administration's and that we should definitely be wary. Not knowing what perspectives this appointment is to bring I offer no replacement except to suggest that Robert Delano, President of the American Farm Bureau is much more likely to bring a point of view on food policy which would be more in tune with the Reagan Administration's.

Clapper is from the National Wildlife Federation. In light of their recent actions opposing Secretary James Watt and in light of the fact that they hired liberal and defeated Senator Gaylord Nelson as their chief spokesman, I think Clapper's appointment is totally unacceptable.

Should the decision on this commission not be imminent, I would like to receive more complete information on the remaining candidates so we might have a closer look.

I am writing this and sending it with Lawrence since I cannot be in Oskaloosa when you are there.

I wonder if you are aware that the White House is holding up the appointment of Julia Anderson, former Assistant Dean of the College of Home Economics at ISU, to the U.S. National Commission for UNFSCO. She was named by the American Home Economics Association to represent them when the AHEA was elected into NGO membership on the Commission.

Just as I indicated my indignation about the delay of the appointment of Mary Louise Smith, I am equally dismayed by this continued harrassment against organizations of our govt. that the men around President Reagan would like to destroy. It is bad enough that they have not granted the budget for the Commission that was already approved. Our executive director has to go begging to the State Dept. for every nickel. It is impossible for us to do sensible planning, and it is an affront to the new chairman, Dr. James Holderman, President of the University of South Carolina, himself handpicked by the White House, which in itself set a precedent. That the White House has chosen to tie Dr. Holderman's hands after he agreed to this post is incredible.

What IS going on? Does it not concern you that the Fxecutive Branch of this administration is riding roughshod over the Congress? The U.S. Commission is a Congressionally mendated Commission. Some of the most distinguished people I have ever met serve without pay in order to connect well and effectively with education, science, communication, and culture programs around the world.

Please do what you can to see that this injustice is rectified, and soon! Thank you.
