Dear Senator Humphrey,

I hope this letter finds you in good health!

As Scott Wendell will readily verify, our rich, varied and extensive collections of United States history and heritage consists of thousands of items that has taken more than thirty years to assemble. One original autograph material of just presidents, that category of our collection in itself includes original autographs in varying format (documents, letters, signed books and pictures and just clipped signatures) of all but two presidents. The only earlier presidents still to be added to complete this segment of the collection are Andrew Jackson and William Henry Harrison. My reason for this particular letter to you is that we would cherish a picture with original signature (not auto pen) of our

President, Ronald Reagan for treasured permanent addition to our collection. You will recall that this collection which you have been invited to view is the pride and joy of our family as Scott well knows. Some rather interesting information concerning this was brought to my attention by a highly reputable dealer in manuscript, bibliophile and autograph materials. we want to do it properly unless you are in a position to obtain this for us and would be kind enough to do this.

Once again Audrey and I cannot ever forget your kindness when we visited Washington this past summer and we greatly hope you will have an opportunity to visit with us and see the collections at any time you visit this area! Our very best regards and best wishes to both. I look forward to your reply.
