
Dear Kathy:

May I ask a favor of you to help make a Thursday night show on Oct. 28th in the dining room of the club a most memorable evening for Bohemians and guests?

The show, "Olé" will focus on a Mexican Fiesta theme in which the Mariachis playing Mexican music and Bohemian, Richard Clark (Metropolitan Opera) should further the American-Mexican partnership.
