SUBJECT: Gifts for the Geneva Trip

I understand that you have raised questions about gifts for the travelling party for the upcoming Geneva trip. I have given this matter a fair amount of attention over the last few weeks, and I've discussed it with Dennis Thomas, Bill Henkel and NSC staff.

The consensus is that a Presidential trinket such as the ones that have been distributed on prior international trips -- hanging bags, duffel bags, baseball caps and travel clocks --- would not be appropriate for what may be the most important international trip of the Reagan presidency. Instead, discussions have focused upon a more dignified and meaningful memento suitable for display in one's office or home. I would also like to keep the gift relatively inexpensive so that we can afford to distribute it to the same group of 200 to 250 people that have received gifts on international trips in the past. (This includes, in addition to the White House and NSC travelling party, allocations to the Secret Service, WHCA and State Department and military support.)

I do not recommend that we try to produce a gift before the trip in order to distribute it in Geneva or on the plane; to do so severely limits our options. Since we are not calling this a Summit, we don't expect a significant accord or treaty to be signed, and there is no major event (such as the United Nations General Assembly or an Economic Summit) around which the trip is built (other than the Gorbachev meeting itself) there is not much more we can inscribe on a gift at this time other than "President Reagan's Trip to Geneva, November 1985" or "President Reagan's Meeting with General Secretary Gorbachev, Geneva, 1985."

After the trip, in addition to stating the date and place, we will have the option of using a quote from a Presidential speech or a line from a joint communique if one is signed. If the meeting is successful enough that banner headlines are generated in domestic newspapers, a relatively inexpensive technique exists whereby the front page of a newspaper can be reproduced in miniature on brass and then appliqued.

More specific ideas are as follows:

1. A Presidential quote or newspaper page etched in brass and appliqued to a marble or wood paperweight-sized base along with the Presidential seal and appropriate statements as to the event, date and place;
2. A desksize flag stand using American, Russian and Swiss flags with a brass applique to the flag stand;
3. A Presidential quote embedded in lucite along with appropriate flags or the Presidential seal;
4. A Presidential quote etched in glass and mounted on a wooden stand.

Please let me know if you think I'm on the right track.




