Rescheduling Sheikh Sa'ad's OWV for July 12 instead of July 7 has put us in a very awkward position with the Kuwaitis. This will be the third time that we have changed signals on the timing of the visit. Sheikh Sa'ad formally accepted our offer of July 7 within 48 hours of our invitation to him last week, after being assured that this date was firm.

To ease the blow of yet another shift on our part, and maximize the chances for Kuwaiti acceptance, I suggest: (1) that the President sign a letter inviting Sheikh Sa'ad to visit on July 12; and (2) that you agree to a five-minute meeting with the Kuwaiti Ambassador on March 18 to deliver the letter.

U.S.-Kuwaiti cooperation over the past year has resulted in unprecedented improvement in our bilateral relationship. Kuwait remains the cornerstone of our Gulf maritime protection regime and an important ally in efforts to contain Iranian influence in the region. It has also been a staunch supporter of U.S. counter-terrorism efforts.

A visit by Sheikh Sa'ad, a key Kuwaiti decision-maker, would strengthen the foundation for future cooperation--as well as highlight one of the Reagan Administration's foreign policy success stories. We had originally proposed an Official Working Visit for Sa'ad in June 1988, but understand that the President's schedule will no longer permit that. We strongly urge an OWV in early July 1988, which State (Assistant Secretary Murphy) and our Ambassador in Kuwait (Nat Howell) believe would still fit into Kuwaiti scheduling plans. The beginning of the hajj--Muslim pilgrimage--season would make it difficult to schedule a visit in the second half of July.

The earlier we can propose a firm date, the better the chances of prompt Kuwaiti acceptance. We would ask that you avoid scheduling the visit on a Friday, which is the Muslim sabbath and which would also complicate efforts to arrange Congressional meetings for Sheikh Sa'ad after he sees the President.

U.S.-Kuwaiti cooperation over the past year has resulted in unprecedented improvement in our bilateral relationship. Kuwait remains the cornerstone of our Gulf maritime protection regime and an important ally in efforts to contain Iranian influence in the region. It has also been a staunch supporter of U.S. counter-terrorism efforts.

A visit by Sheikh Sa'ad, a key Kuwaiti decision-maker, would strengthen the foundation for future cooperation--as well as highlight one of the Reagan Administration's foreign policy success stories. We had originally proposed an Official Working Visit for Sa'ad in June 1988, but understand that the President's schedule will no longer permit that. We strongly urge an OWV in early July 1988, which State (Assistant Secretary Murphy) and our Ambassador in Kuwait (Nat Howell) believe would still fit into Kuwaiti scheduling plans. The beginning of the hajj--Muslim pilgrimage--season would make it difficult to schedule a visit in the second half of July.

The earlier we can propose a firm date, the better the chances of prompt Kuwaiti acceptance. We would ask that you avoid scheduling the visit on a Friday, which is the Muslim sabbath and which would also complicate efforts to arrange Congressional meetings for Sheikh Sa'ad after he sees the President.

Sheikh Sa'ad, Crown Prince and Prime Minister of Kuwait, has accepted President Reagan's invitation for an Official Working Visit to Washington, including a July 12 meeting and lunch with the President.

Sheikh Sa'ad is an active prime minister and key decision-maker in the Kuwaiti government. He has played a central role in the recent dramatic improvement in U.S.-Kuwaiti relations resulting, in part, from increased cooperation in the maritime protection effort. His visit, the first by a Kuwaiti leader in twenty years, is of major importance in light of the strengthened bilateral relationship, continuing efforts to coordinate Gulf War diplomacy, Kuwait's leadership of the Islamic Conference, and Kuwait's active role in the Arab world.

During his visit, Sheikh Sa'ad will meet with senior Administration officials. We are working to schedule meetings with the Secretaries of State, Defense, Energy, and Treasury, as well as with Congressional leaders.

Sheikh Sa'ad has recently hosted a number of senior Administration, Congressional, and military visitors, including Secretary Carlucci last January. The Department believes it would be valuable for the Vice President to host a function for Prime Minister/Crown Prince Sheikh Sa'ad during his visit to reciprocate for Kuwait's warm hospitality to American visitors and to hear first hand Kuwait's views of the evolving situation in the Gulf.
