SUBJECT: Request for Presidential Helicopter Support for Kuwait Prime Minister and Crown Prince Sheikh Sa'ad

Kuwaiti Prime Minister and Crown Prince Sheikh Sa'ad will be in Washington for an Official Working Visit with the President July 10-15. We normally provide aircraft support for Heads of State who are in Washington for Official Working Visits. 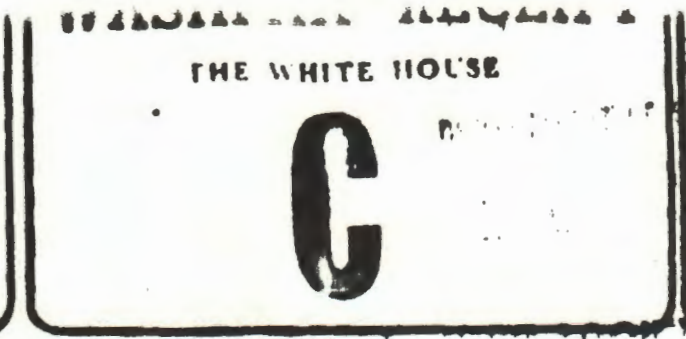
