

That Conference was attended by a number of leading Italian and American business leaders (Gianni Agnelli, Carlo de Benedetti, Jim Robinson, John Phelan, etc.). As a result of the Conference, the Italians formed a National Task Force on Private Sector Initiatives.

The President is scheduled to meet with Italian Prime Minister Gorla on December 16, 1987. In light of the developments in Italy and the President's strong interest in promoting Private Sector Initiatives, some type of Private Sector Initiatives event may be appropriate for that visit. This could range from simply adding it to the official discussion agenda to something on a larger scale such as a meeting of the Italian and American Private Sector Initiatives Committees.

I have discussed this with Ty Cobb and he is enthusiastic about the concept.

Could you please advise as to how you feel we should proceed.




