Dear President Reagan:

I am writing to solicit your help for the 12,000 remaining Jews in Ethiopia.

Although the Ethiopian Jewish Community numbered several hundred thousand at the beginning of this century, years of war, forced assimilation, and drought have greatly reduced their numbers. Today, the Marxist regime of Lt. Col. Mengistu denies its citizens their most basic human rights, such as the right to practice their religion and the right to emigrate.

While many Jews fled Ethiopia via Operation Moses in 1984, the doors to freedom are now closed. It is imperative that the Jews of Ethiopia be allowed to escape poverty and persecution and to rejoin their families in Israel.

I am calling upon you, as the President of the United States, to act on Concurrent Resolution 107 of 1984 "to use every appropriate forum, whether public or private, international or bilateral, to express the concern of the American people for the welfare of this religious minority and to be of assistance to them in their efforts to emigrate."

I thank you for your consideration in this most pressing matter.

Dear Mr. Isaac:

President Reagan has asked me to reply to your letter of November 15 in which you note the friendship between the people of Ethiopia and the U.S. and request us to continue our humanitarian efforts.

The events of the past few years show that our disagreements with the Government of Ethiopia have not weakened our friendship with the people of Ethiopia. We have been the leader in two massive humanitarian relief efforts for Ethiopia--in 1985-86 and during this past year (October 1987-September 1988). In the course of the second relief effort, the U.S. provided almost \$120 million of humanitarian relief for an estimated 5 - 7 million at-risk people in the drought-afflicted areas of Ethiopia. Judged by the results--few deaths, no camps formed, and no mass movements of people in search of food--we conclude that the relief effort was a success. Good rains and the promise of a good harvest suggest that the famine is over--for now.

At the present time, legislation prohibiting development assistance to Ethiopia prohibits support for projects such as the health clinic in Jijiga. We look forward to the time when Ethiopia's policies are such that we might once again provide development assistance for the Ethiopian people.

Thank you for the assistance you provided American citizens in a difficult time at some risk to yourself, and thank you also for your kind words about my adminstration's role in maintaining world peace. There is still much to be done.



Dear Mr. President:

My name is Isaac Gabriel, former Commander of the Imperial Ethiopian Navy and a Felashin Jew from Jigjiga, Ethiopia. I wish to ask for your help, but before I do so, I want to explain the circumstances that has led up to the writing of this letter.

When the former Ethiopian government was overthrown by the Marxists, I became the NHQ Operation Commander. I passed vital information to U.S. Navy MAAG Assistant Captain C. Fend, not knowing that my telephone was wired. I was arrested and court martialed at MOND (Pentagon) and convicted for passing information that concerned the Ethiopian Navy and 18,000 enthusiastic Cuban Soldiers to foreign agents, but was spared by Colonel Tesemma Abaderash and forced to retire due to my Jewish heritage and my anti-Marxist political ideology.

Within a month, I secured a job as a Technical Consultant for Emerson Electric Company Electronics and Space Division of St. Louis, an American company doing business with the socialist government.

On May Day in 1977 at the Red Square, in a fit of rage, Col. Mengistu filled five bottles with red ink and each time he dropped a bottle, to spill symbolic blood, he denounced American Imperialism, the CIA, American Bureaucracy, the EPRP, and the Revisionists. Ethiopians fled this rage as quickly as they could run.

At that time, I had four American Field Technicians in my care in Addis Hilton. The American Ambassador called the leading Technician and informed him how Mengistu had given a license to Ethiopians to kill Americans and ordered them to leave immediately.

I had to convince the Navy Commander to send me a car with a Navy license plate to drive my men to the airport. We were stopped every 500 meters for inspection. Each time, I had to convince them that they were government contractors, but at no time did I mention that they were Americans.
