Dear Mr. Zweifel:

I have been asked to respond to your cable of August 18 to the President. As you may know, the United States immediately sent a team of specialists to assist the Government of Pakistan in its investigation into the cause of the air crash that killed President Zia, Ambassador Raphel, and BGen. Wassom. As of this writing, the investigation is not complete and the cause of the crash still not certain.

Since the tragic crash, the United States Government has reaffirmed its commitment to the security and integrity of Pakistan. We have condemned aerial attacks against Pakistan from across the Afghan border both publicly and in our private meetings with the Soviets. We continue to believe that our policy of unwavering support for Pakistan and the Afghan resistance while maintaining a dialogue with the Soviet Union is the most effective one for achieving the complete withdrawal of Soviet troops from Afghanistan, self determination for the Afghan people, and the return of the Afghan refugees to their homes in safety and honor.

Dear President Reagan:

This office has been retained by the families of the late President of Pakistan, Zia ul-Hag and the late head of the Pakistan Armed Forces, General Akhtar Abdul Rahman Khan, in connection with their deaths in Pakistan on August 17, as a result of an aviation accident. The crash also claimed the lives of the U.S. Ambassador to Pakistan, Arnold L. Raphel, and U.S. Brigadier General Herbert M. Wassom, as well as various Pakistani military officials.

To date there have been contradictory findings as to whether the crash was caused by a mechanical malfunction or sabotage. The families of the victims we represent believe that the actual cause of the crash is being withheld for the reason that it may be too politically sensitive. Inasmuch as President Zia was a staunch ally of the United States, his family and that of General Khan's demand that the truth be revealed. I am certain you share these feelings, especially in light of the deaths of Ambassador Raphel and General Wassom.

We have been informed that various U.S. Government agencies, as well as the Government of Pakistan, have undertaken investigations as to the cause of this aviation accident. We have requested, by way of the Freedom of Information Act, the results of these investigations from the State Department and the F.B.I. Your assistance in obtaining this information is requested.

Certainly, last week's tragedy in Scotland compels that the cause of these disasters be revealed in order that proper precautions may be taken to prevent like occurrences.
