

SUBJECT: Request for a Photo Op with the President by
 Italian Foreign Minister Andreotti

Giulio Andreotti, Foreign Minister of Italy, has requested a photo op with the President either Monday, February 2 or Tuesday, February 3. Andreotti will be in Washington as head of an Italian Interparliamentary Union delegation. He will meet with Secretary Shultz Monday, February 2 from 11 a.m. to noon.

Andreotti is a key Italian interlocutor as Foreign Minister and is currently the leading candidate to become Italy's next Prime Minister in March. He is certain to play a major role in the Venice Economic Summit and the President's state visit to Rome in June. Andreotti is often difficult and does not see eye-to-eye with us on some questions. However, the Italians are important, reliable allies and receiving Andreotti in Washington contributes significantly to maintaining our good bilateral ties. Ambassador Rabb strongly endorses this request for a photo op as does the Department of State.
