I KNOW THAT SECRETARY BAKER HAS WELL IN MIND THE POSSIBLE NEED FOR A GROUP OF SEVEN MEETING PRIOR TO THE APRIL MEETINGS OF THE INTERIM AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEES. I FEEL CONFIDENT THAT OUR MINISTERS CAN WORK OUT THE BEST TIMING FOR ANY SUCH MEETING.

3. THE WHITE HOUSE DOES NOT PLAN TO RELEASE TEXT BUT HAS NO OBJECTION IF THE GOI WISHES TO DO SO. THERE WILL BE NO SIGNED ORIGINAL.

4. FYI: PM CRAXI'S MESSAGE, DELIVERED BY ITALIAN EMBASSY JANUARY 30, 1987, WAS AS FOLLOWS {ITALIAN EMBASSY TRANSLATION}. QUOTE: THE CONCERN WITH WHICH ITALY FOLLOWS THE DEVELOPMENTS IN THE MONETARY MARKETS, AND THE NEED FOR A STRICTER MONITORING, HAVE BEEN RECENTLY STATED IN A LETTER ADDRESSED BY THE ITALIAN MINISTER OF THE TREASURY, T.H. GIOVANNI GORIA, TO HIS COLLEAGUES OF THE MOST INDUSTRIALIZED COUNTRIES IN THE SPIRIT OF THE TOKYO AGREEMENTS. DURING THE FOLLOWING WEEKS, THE EXCHANGE RATES OF THE MAJOR CURRENCIES KEPT BEING SUBJECTED TO STRESSES, AND THE MONETARY SYSTEM REMAINS CHARACTERIZED BY A PREVAILING INSTABILITY.

THE RESTRICTED MEETING SCHEDULED IN ROME FOR FEBRUARY 4, AT THE DEPUTIES LEVEL, CERTAINLY CONSTITUTES A VERY USEFUL OCCASION FOR SEARCHING FOR WIDER COMMON UNDERSTANDINGS IN THE ANALYSIS OF THE PRESENT SITUATION AND, HOPEFULLY, FOR THE ADOPTION OF MORE APPROPRIATE MEASURES TO RE-ESTABLISH MORE NORMAL CONDITIONS IN THE MONETARY MARKETS. HOWEVER, WE CANNOT EXCLUDE THAT THE MAGNITUDE OF THE PROBLEMS TO BE RESOLVED COULD NECESSITATE ALSO A MEETING AT THE MINISTERIAL LEVEL. IN THAT CASE - CERTAINLY NOT REMOTE - I THINK THAT THE PRECONDITIONS EXIST FOR A MEETING TO BE CALLED AMONG THE MINISTERS OF THE TREASURY AND OF FINANCE OF THE SEVEN, AS IT IS ESTABLISHED BY THE TOKYO ECONOMIC DECLARATION. IN FACT, THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT THE PRIORITY SUBJECT OF SUCH A MEETING TO BE CONVENED WOULD CONCERN THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY SYSTEM AND OF THE CONNECTED MEASURES OF ECONOMIC POLICY.

Dear Bettino:

Thank you for your letter concerning recent developments in exchange markets, and noting that they may suggest the appropriateness of a meeting of the Group of Seven Finance Ministers. As you know, I strongly supported the creation of this Group at the Tokyo Summit. I continue to believe the Group can play an important role in ensuring close and continuous coordination of economic policy among the seven Summit countries.

I understand that Secretary Baker has been in touch with Minister Goria to discuss exchange market developments, and other matters of mutual concern. As you know, he met Mr. Goria in Turin in December.

We would consider a meeting of the G-7 Finance Ministers to be an essential part of a serious, high-level discussion of improvement of the international monetary system and related economic policy measures. I know that Secretary Baker has well in mind the possible need for a Group of Seven meeting prior to the April meetings of the Interim and Development Committees. Should such be deemed appropriate, I feel confident that our Ministers can work out the best timing for any such meeting.




