Dear Mr. President,

Thank you very much, indeed, for your letter of 10 June 1985 concerning your intention to establish an interim framework of mutual restraint with respect to existing strategic arms control agreements. I was most interested to read your detailed report and I can assure you that we strongly welcome your decision to refrain from undercutting existing strategic arms agreements to the extent that the Soviet Union exercises comparable restraint.

We, for our part will also press the Soviet Union to cease their violations of existing agreements.

You also have the firm support of Luxembourg for your efforts to further arms control and eventual disarmament.

I do hope that the Geneva negotiations, which we all know will be drawn-out and difficult, will be given a fresh impetus by the new Soviet Foreign Minister and eventually bring about the stated aims.

Dear Mr. President:

In keeping with the new three-year rule limiting the service of non-career Ambassadors, I am herewith submitting my resignation as Ambassador to the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

If at all possible, I would appreciate an effective date of September 30, with departure from this Post on or about September 15, 1985. This would permit me to meet major commitments on our Embassy schedule, and enable us to make arrangements for temporary housing, since our personal home is under lease until January. Several other major inconveniences and expenses can be avoided with this time span.

Mr. President, permit me to thank you again for the opportunity for service which you gave me 3-1/2 years ago. It has been an honor and privilege to be your representative in Luxembourg, and I shall be ever grateful to you. The Luxembourg people have been most generous in response to our efforts. They accepted your appointment of a native Luxembourger as a signal compliment to them and the Grand Duchy. I have had numerous opportunities to emphasize that only in the USA could a 13-year-old immigrant be educated, become "Americanized" and return to his native country as a U.S. Ambassador.

Winnie and I have enjoyed serving you and our country to the best of our ability. Certainly, the successful State Visit of the Grand Duke and Grand Duchess last November was a highlight, and the very popular visit to Luxembourg by Vice President and Mrs. Bush in February last year will never be forgotten.

We will continue to support your Administration and your policies in every way possible. Winnie also joins me in sending you and Mrs. Reagan our warmest regards and all best wishes.


