Dear General Culbertson:

I am replying to your letter to President Reagan concerning the U.S. initiative to Iran. The President appreciates the special effort you took to convey your thoughts.

The Persian Gulf region is important to the United States, and to many of our allies as well, for a variety of strategic, economic, and political reasons. A quarter of the free world's oil flows through the Persian Gulf, and it is vital that Western access to that oil continues. The region is also a strategic focal point for the Soviet Union. The Soviets have long sought to expand their presence and control in the area, and the United States has an important stake in denying the Soviets the opportunity for such an expansion. The long, destructive war between Iran and Iraq also threatens the stability of the area.

In view of these conditions, the United States engaged in an effort to establish contacts with certain groups within the Iranian leadership to explore the possibility of forging a new and better relationship. This was done in order to encourage negotiations to end the war in the Gulf, prevent Soviet expansionism, end Iranian support for international terrorism, and effect the safe return of all hostages from Lebanon.

The President has stated that he authorized sales of arms to Iran as part of this strategic initiative. In his March 4 speech to the nation, the President said he accepted the conclusion of the Tower Commission report that the initiative to Iran deteriorated into trading arms for hostages. He said that this was a mistake, and that it ran counter to the Administration's policy and original strategy. The President has taken steps to reform the national security decision-making process to ensure that such mistakes do not occur again.

I am enclosing material that I believe will be of interest to you.

This letter is not to question the right and freedom of debate by the press and individuals or even criticism of the president of the United States and his administration over the Irancontra affair.

This letter is to suggest that the continuing discussion and criticism await the findings and conclusions of the investigation in order that the debate and its determinations will be based on truth.

Mistakes have been made, as has been stated by the president, but there is nothing that we have heard or read to show that the president has been deliberately untruthful in his statements. It is only fair to await the findings and conclusions of the special fact-finding committees of the House and Senate. Also, there is the committee named by the president himself composed of respected citizens, and only recently has he named David Abshire, recently ambassador to NATO, to oversee and coordinate the work of the National Security Council.

I hope that the committees will study the Constitution and that it will be read by all of us. The Constitution provides that the president possesses not only the right and authority as commander in chief of the armed forces of our country, but also through its construction, the duty to protect the United States and its people. Mistakes may be made, but this authority and duty rest alone with the president, and not with any other branch of the government. Congress has the power to declare war and to fund or reduce support for it by its power of appropriation, but it has no power over the president's authority and duty to protect our country and its people.

In the early days of the Republic, President Jefferson ordered out small fighting ships to go into the harbors and on the shores of Libya and destroy the Libyan powers and pirates who were attacking U.S. ships. Last year, President Reagan ordered the same harbor and coast to be bombed because Libya was firing at our Air Force planes and supporting terrorism. Today, it is reported by the press that Libyan forces are attacking a neighbor, Chad.

It is my belief that this investigation will disclose that President Reagan has acted constitutionally and rightly in his effort to protect our country, its people, including those held as hostages. He has taken an oath to protect and defend the Constitution.

The people of our country should stand in support of the president and thus not weaken our country before the peoples and governments of other countries.

Dear Fellow American:

It is from deep conviction and with sincere regret that I observe votes and acticns in our nation that reflect a decaydence in civilization. It is in pain that I am forced to observe the widening division within a once more closely united land. Occasioned by the vote to honor Mr. King in a national way, I am compelled to this open letter. I know from wide contacts with many peoples served in my travels and business that this vote did not represent the majority voice of our nation. This vote and the Presidential signature were not the will of the people.

Laura White called herself my"Negro mammy" and raised me, along with my mother, from the age of two thru high school. We had a strong family love for each other. Throughout my youth I honored all races. In teaching grade school, high school, and college I espoused the causes and rights of all groups and, particularly, the black race. For twenty-three years I have worked closely with a black congregation, I now serve as Elder and Evangelist with that Church. This is thus not a racial issue. Along with the principles of those I serve, expressed concurrence of the Black Silent Majority, and close personal black friends. I opposed such a day. Had the decision been to honor George Washington Carver, our one thousand percent endorsement would have been unanimous. We regret the dishonesty and the cowardice that blocked the full disclosure of information available. Among other factors reported and confirmed of his moral life and the numerous communist affiliations were numerous items known to any seeking inquirer. Those who opposed this decision would have opposed such a day honoring any man in like situation regardless of his race, color, or creed.

In fact millions of us will have no pride in this day. We will not observe it. We will not honor the vote, the voters. This day will be one to espouse principles of righteousness, loyalty to America, and that presented herein.

Our pathetic state of national leadership, particularly in the present congresssenate-supreme court-Bureau levels, is worthy of national lamentation.Such leaders often forsake common sense reason. They abandon the basic rights assured in the Bill of Rights. They distort the constitution to assert that which is the very opposite of the design and intent of the faithful framers of that document. They have cringed in cowardice before pressures, loud minority voices, marches and bribery and succumed to the ideologies of humanism, communism, and other God-denials of specific groups and organizations. Numerous unfounded and undeserved demands of minorities are paid for by the majorities thru the loss of their own rights and they also foot the bill. Lobbyists, Laborites, Big business, and other self-centered special interest groups - ignoring everyone else - daily thrust at the very heartline of righteousness and fairness. Groups, organizations, and persons who manifest this attitude are all suspect.

This betrayal attitude sold our own canal, denies our prayer rights in public schools enjoyed for over 300 years and persecutes religious schools and churches through infringement that denies the free exercise of religion and IRS tyranny. This capitulates to enemies of the USA and fortifies financially those who would destroy us. In fact our enemies have been nourished to affluence and power by tax money, technocracy, and timidity. Those contributing to this situation are, perhaps without avarice, traitors. We dance to the tune of bureaucratic betrayal, legislative laxity, and postponed promises. We surrender thru a Supreme Court suppineness. We are "murdered" by a media that withholds, slants, perverts, and misrepresents. The further pity is that polls show that the average, and naive, American holds to higher morals and traditional standards at about the rate of 83 % while only 6% of the news media concur. They ride us. They don't guide is aright. They use us. They abuse us.

I do not have the time to write a book. I would like to. It is needed. Many good ones have yeen written. Russel Kirk, Frances Shaffer, Richard A. Viguerie, and Malcolm Muggeridge are among a host of excellent, informed and patriotic writers. The "Conservative Digest," "University Bookman," "Human Events," "Freeman," and "National Observer" and other like quality writing and news-providing publications are most commendable. They manifest a concern for truth, accountable reporting, and a commitment to our American heritage and value systems, and a balance with truth as the crux. We need to read these and make a long over-due application.

My belief and regret is that a majority of our leaders forfeit virtue for votes, abandon principles for politics, substitute dereliction for dutifulness, exchange intwined citizenship for inevitable comminuation, and tolerate a paradox of acquiescent laxity when we ought to have paragons of active leadership.

An equal fact to bring pity is that good, well-meaning millions are misled by the age and the media and fail to realize that the selfishness that grips our people lures them to sell themselves out. They vote for the "quick buck" without realizing they are farther away (from their financial goals because they did not found their views on solid principles. And, more importantly, the greater individual freedom, fulfillment, and happiness is lost for them personally along with our national honor and greatness.

In 1835, Alexis De Tocgueville said: "America is great because America is good. And America will cease being great if America ceases to be good." The calamity is that we have made it come true, or we are very close.

"Righteousness exalteth a nation, but sin is a reproach to any nation." This is Bible. And it is more - it is also the voice of history, logic, common sense, personal experience, and the conviction of most Americans.
