NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO THAT THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES ARE URGED TO ACTIVELY INTERVENE AND BRING PEACE TO ALL OF IRELAND BY RECOGNIZING IRELAND'S RIGHT TO SOVEREIGNTY, INDEPENDENCE AND SELF DETERMINATION; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT IN THE STRUGGLE FOR JUSTICE ALL PERSONS IN IRELAND MUST RECOGNIZE THAT VIOLENCE ONLY DELAYS THE DAY OF JUSTICE AND THAT VIOLENCE DESTROYS THE WORK OF JUSTICE; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT COPIES OF THIS MEMORIAL BE TRANSMITTED TO THE NEW MEXICO CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
