MEMORANDUM FOR: SENIOR WHITE HOUSE STAFF
FROM: JAMES A. BAKER, III
SUBJECT: STAFF PAY RAISES

As you know, the President has approved a 4% government-wide pay increase for civil service employees effective October 3, 1982. Accordingly, a similar across-the-board adjustment of 4% is approved for White House Office employees with the exception of employees hired subsequent to June 1, 1982 and paid an administratively-determined salary. Also excluded from the 4% general increase are those persons whose salary has been increased subsequent to June 1, 1982 or whose salary is currently at the legal maximum for their level of appointment. A list of the employees on your staff who are affected by either of the above exclusions will be sent to you by John Rogers, Deputy Assistant to the President, under separate cover.

The 4% pay adjustment is intended to cover most of the needs for salary increases. If there are other extraordinary cases of outstanding merit which you may wish to recognize later in the fiscal year, you should address a memorandum of justification to John Rogers. Generally speaking, merit increases will not exceed 2% of the employee's salary. Such requests will be reviewed and approved or disapproved based on the availability of funds for this purpose and the justification provided with the request. The limitation of available funds will result in merit increases being approved in only a small number of cases.


