2. <u>Ruckelshaus Resignation</u> : Guidance is that Ruckelshaus decided on his own to return to the private sector; we would have preferred that he stay. It is our intention to announce a successor this week.	Speakes Herrington
3. <u>Budget</u> : Guidance is that we should continue to decline comment on budget deliberations.	Speakes
4. <u>Leading Indicators</u> : The index for October was down 0.7%, though coincident indicators were up 0.5%.	Speakes Niskanen

6. <u>Arms Control</u> : Regarding the <u>Boston Globe</u> story about a non-disclosure pledge, guidance is that receipt of classified information must be acknowledged. The only new element is that, on returning the material, a statement is signed that there was no disclosure to unauthorized personnel.	McFarlane Speakes
7. <u>Soviet Treaty Violations</u> : Three reports on this subject are required to be submitted to Congress by February 15. A letter will be sent this week which responds to allegations that we are delaying the submission of requested information. The difficulty has arisen, in part, because of the ambiguity of certain verification data.	McFarlane
8. <u>Inaugural Tickets</u> : Margaret Tutwiler briefed senior staff on the ticket allocation procedure. It was noted that there are a total of 400,000 commemorative invitations, as well as 50,000 ball and 12,000 salute tickets (both of which are limited due to site capacity). Historical precedent is being followed, insofar as possible, in allocating the tickets. All White House employees will receive a ball invitation, and all White House staffers of equivalent rank are receiving the same allocations. Cabinet officers will decide the allocation of tickets among their departmental staff. Regarding commemorative invitations, senior staff may submit additional names, which will be taken care of if state allocations are not fully used. Regarding housing, the Inaugural Committee will not book reservations, but is working with local hotels in order to advise where rooms are available.


