SUBJECT: Arms Control White Paper

As you know, USIA disclosed at the London meeting on INF that USIA and OSD would draft an arms control white paper in the near future.

We have been working on a similar project for some time and last week completed a first draft, which is attached. We have tried:

-- to address this to a European audience, although it should be suitable for a domestic audience as well;

-- it should focus on five or six key arms control issues;

-- it should stress the continuity of our arms control efforts and objectives.

The paper obviously needs a good deal of cutting and polishing. Nevertheless, we'd be interested in your initial reactions, as well as your thoughts on getting it into the interagency mill.
