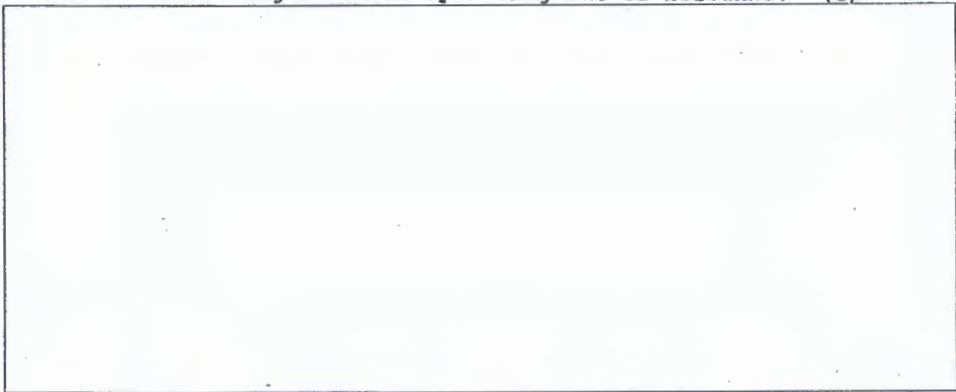

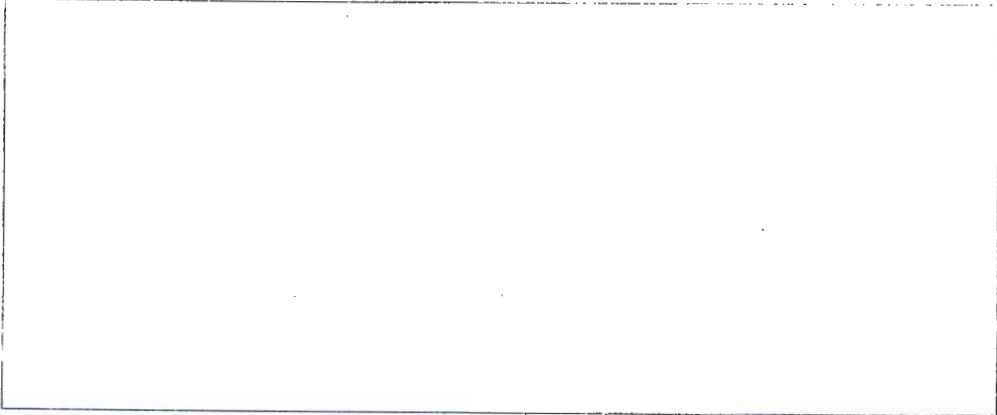

this Soviet front organization has been highly successful in promoting and running the European "peace movement". If allowed to operate with impunity in this country, it could well engender a similar mass movement here, using for this purpose generous funds allocated to it by Moscow. (S)

In view of this fact, the President has concluded that visas should be refused to foreign visitors connected with the World Peace Council (its President, Romesh Chandra, among them) as well as other individuals planning to come to this country to attend World Peace Council functions. I would appreciate it if you would issue instructions to this effect to the appropriate office of the Department of State.

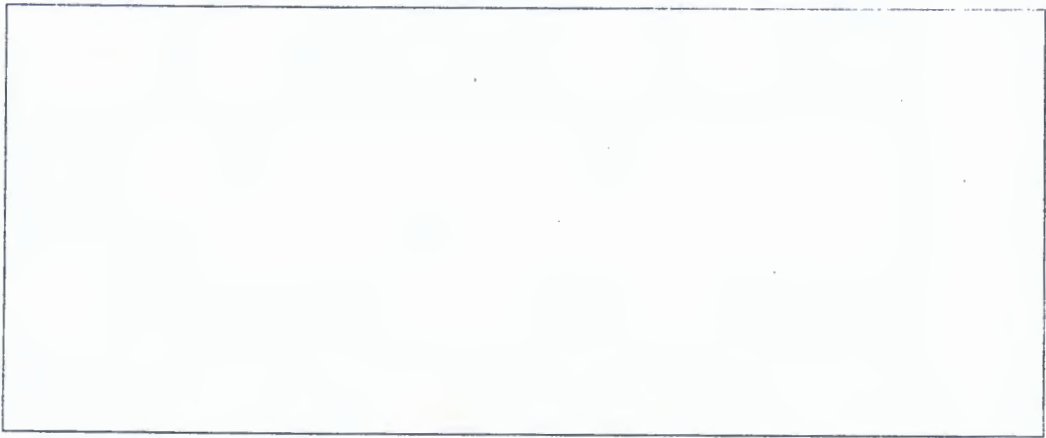

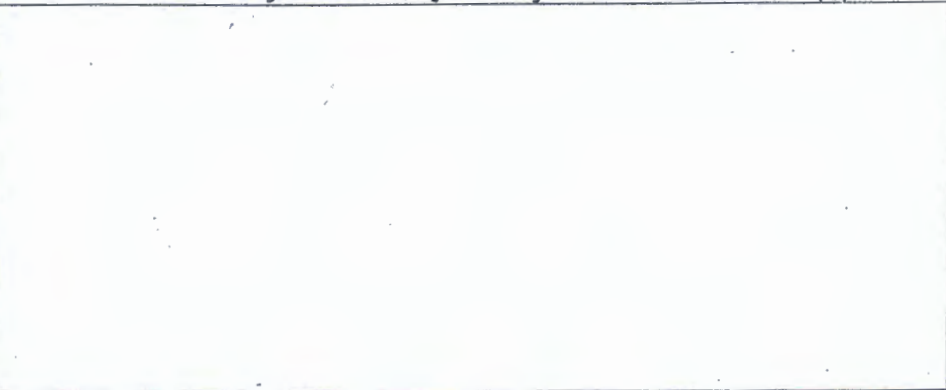

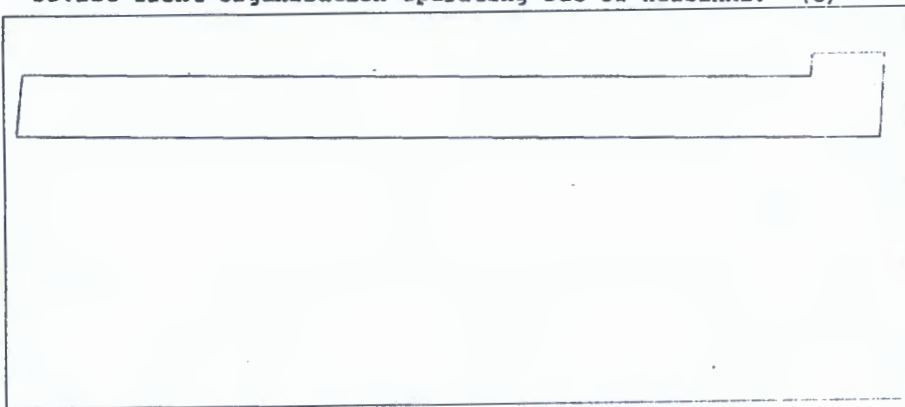
