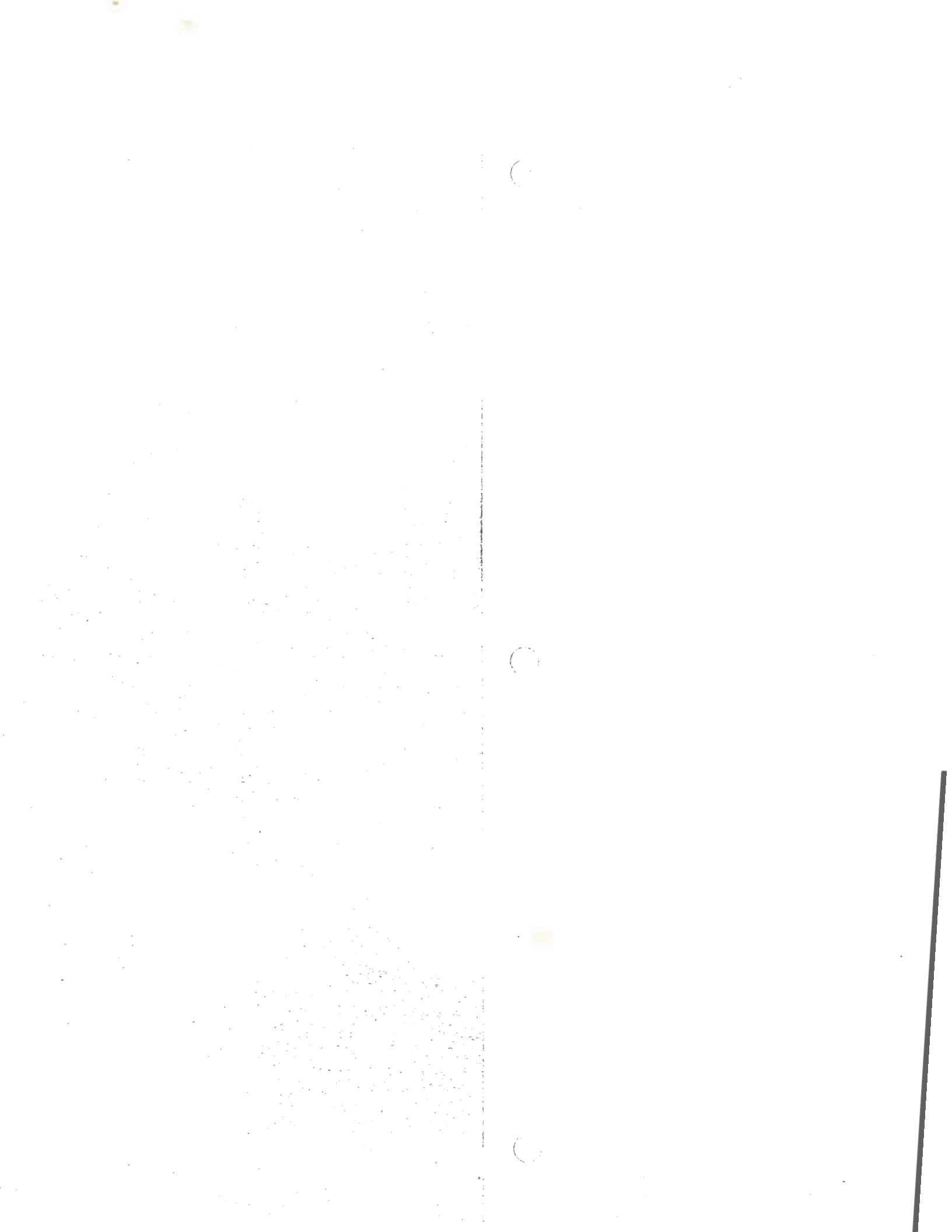

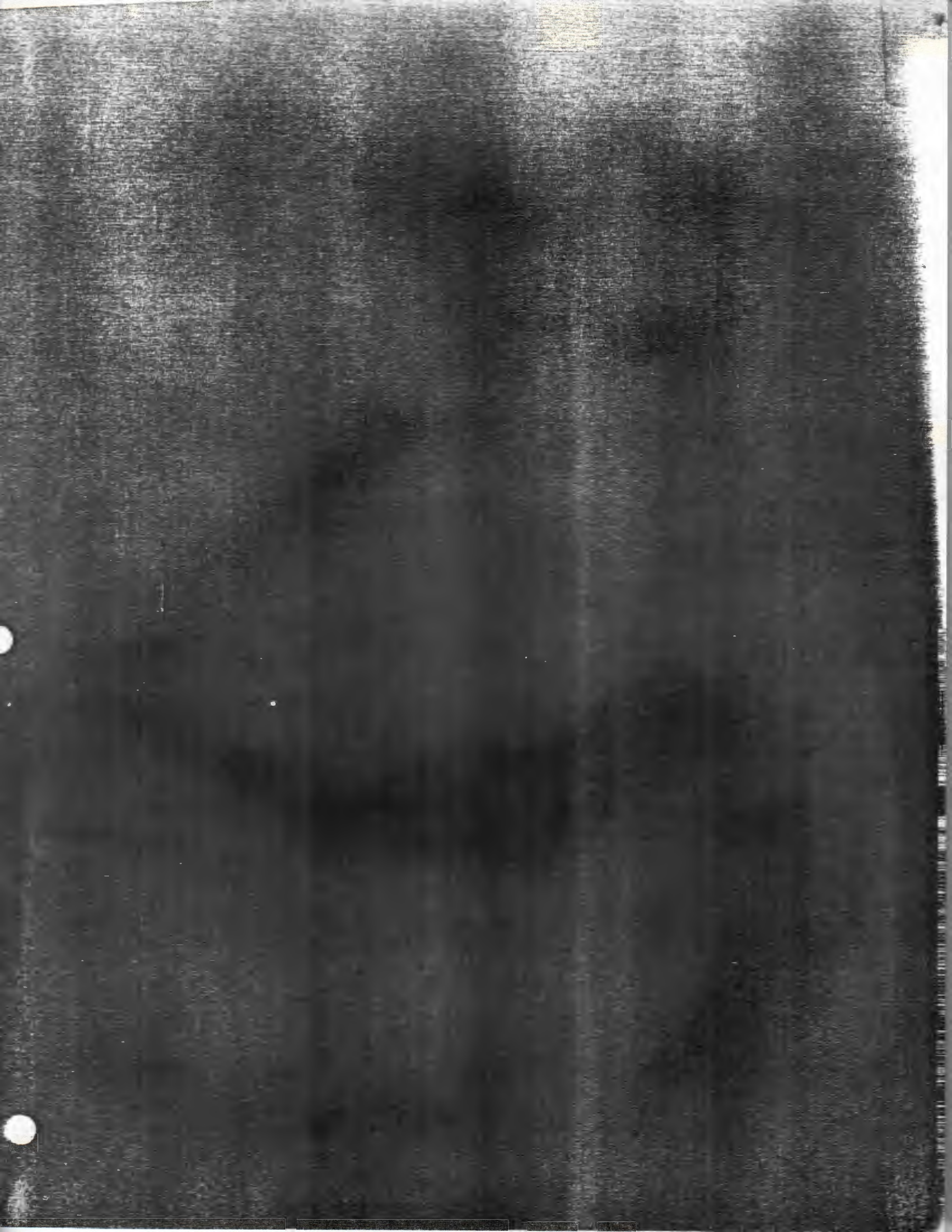

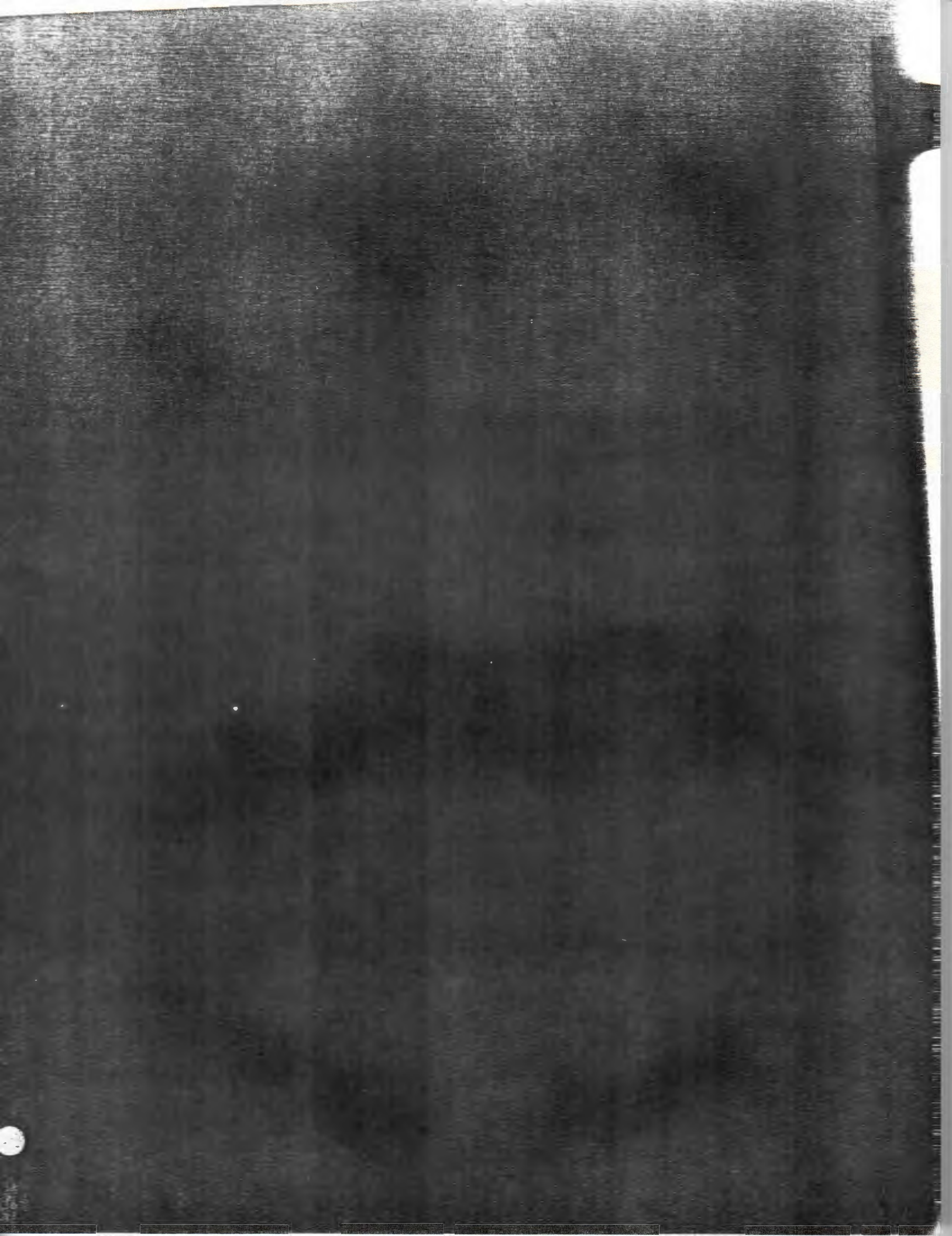

## DEMARCHE TO SOVIETS ON PAKISTAN/AFGHANISTAN BORDER INCIDENTS

-- We remain highly concerned by the continuing situation in Afghanistan which presents a clear danger to the security and stability of the entire region.

-- We continue to support a negotiated political settlement which will allow the people of Afghanistan to determine their own fate free of foreign intervention and permit the millions of Afghans who have fled to Pakistan to return to their homeland.

-- The United States stands ready to help in any way it realistically can to put an end to the suffering of the people of Afghanistan.

-- The Afghan problem, however, cannot be resolved until the Soviet Union ends its efforts to subjugate that war-torn country. Blaming others for the situation in Afghanistan is an attempt to shift the responsibility away from where it properly belongs.

-- A recent example which concerns us is the July 19 Soviet demarche to the Government of Pakistan accusing Pakistan in harsh and provocative language of backing the Afghan resistance.

-- Of even greater concern to us, and to many others, is the series of armed violations of Pakistan's sovereignty carried out by aircraft, artillery, and rocket launchers based in Afghanistan. These attacks have cost the lives of a large number of innocent Afghan refugees and Pakistani civilians.

-- We call upon the Soviet Union to take measures to halt these acts of aggression, and to cease its efforts to pressure Pakistan.

-- I wish to emphasize in the strongest possible terms that the United States firmly supports the independence and integrity of Pakistan and has a long-term commitment to Pakistan's security.

-- The United States fully and firmly backs all efforts to further peaceful solutions to outstanding issues in South Asia. We fully support the efforts of the United Nations to mediate a satisfactory and just solution to the Afghanistan crisis and urge the Soviet Union to do likewise.

-- Only by working to avoid increased tensions in the region can the national interests of both of our countries and those of the countries of South Asia be furthered.

-- (If asked about U.S. arms for the Afghans) Our moral support for the cause of Afghan freedom is well known. We admire what the Afghans are doing to rid their country of a foreign invader. This is the issue, not outside interference.

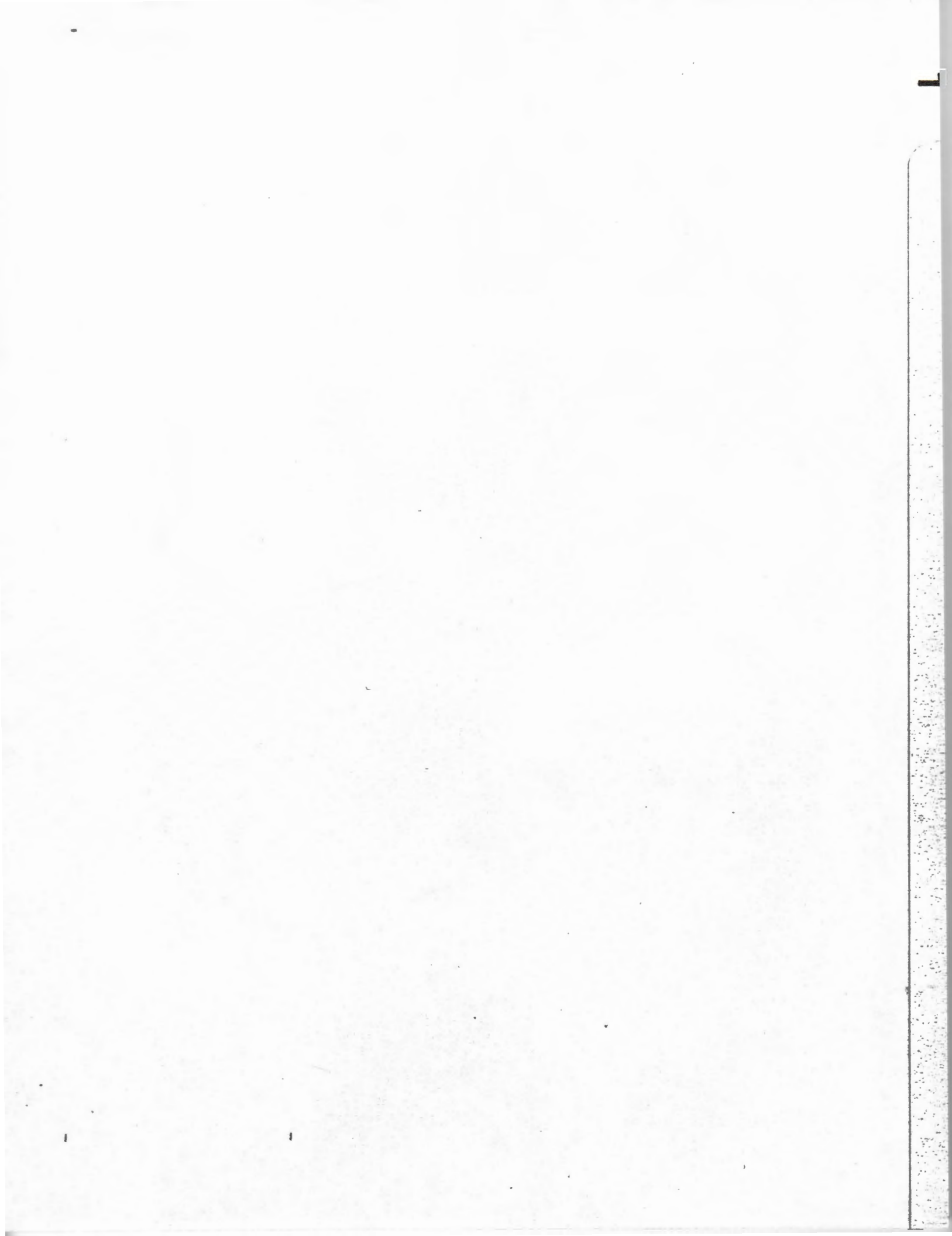

-- We remain highly concerned by the continuing situation in Afghanistan which presents a clear danger to the security and stability of the entire region.

-- We continue to support a negotiated political settlement which will allow the people of Afghanistan to determine their own fate free of foreign intervention and permit the millions of Afghans who have fled to Pakistan to return to their homeland.

-- The United States stands ready to help in any way it realistically can to put an end to the suffering of the people of Afghanistan.

-- The Afghan problem, however, cannot be resolved until the Soviet Union ends its efforts to subjugate that war-torn country. Blaming others for the situation in Afghanistan is an attempt to shift the responsibility away from where it properly belongs.

-- A recent example which concerns us is the July 19 Soviet demarche to the Government of Pakistan accusing Pakistan in harsh and provocative language of backing the Afghan resistance.

-- The United States fully and firmly backs all efforts to further peaceful solutions to outstanding issues in South Asia. We fully support the efforts of the United Nations to mediate a satisfactory and just solution to the Afghanistan crisis and urge the Soviet Union to do likewise.

-- Only by working to avoid increased tensions in the region can the national interests of both of our countries and those of the countries of South Asia be furthered.

-- (If asked about U.S. arms for the Afghans) Our moral support for the cause of Afghan freedom is well known. We admire what the Afghans are doing to rid their country of a foreign invader. This is the issue, not outside interference.
