Activities in connection with Audio-Visual Section of Reagan Memorial Library & Museum

There are two distinct activities on-going in my Department to produce material for the Reagan Library/Museum.

A. Audio-Visual

We are maintaining a daily record of all Presidential public appearances on 3/4" video tape. This material is deposited in the National Archives and will eventually go to the Library.

We are also producing documentaries in those areas which have special historical significance. These will be available in the Reagan Library/Museum.

- 1. The Gipper Goes Home 26 minutes The President's speech at Notre Dame with the opening narrated by Pat O'Brien. This was the President's first speech after the assassination attempt.
- President Reagan's Inaugural Address 28 minutes.
- 3. Sunrise at Montebello 9 minutes This is a brief documentary of the President's first Summit Meeting held in ottawa, Canada narrated by Ralph Edwards.
- 4. Connie is my Lady 28 minutes Documentary of the President's visit aboard the aircraft carrier USS Constellation narrated by Vince Skully.
- 5. Summit at Cancun This is a documentary about the Summit Meeting on the Mexican Caribbean. Incomplete.
- 6. The First Year This will be a one-hour documentary of the President's first year. While we have been compiling material all year, we will not begin post-production until February 1st.

B. Daily Oral History of the President

We are preparing a radio script each day of the President's Day. This is then recorded on cassette, combined with any Presidential remarks and held for the Library/Museum use.

All Presidential audio tapes have been given to the National Archives but never have they been compiled so that a student, scholar or historian could someday hear a Presidential Day.
