Mrs. Reagan, I am pleased to state is in good spirits, and in the days ahead will continue to be the strong and supportive to the final wife that she has always been for so many years.

I want to reassure you the American people that following this the senseless assult on the President, this government has continued and will continue to function in the most effective manner possible in order to carry out the programs and policies of the President.

During the time the President is recovering, and I expect that the period to be very short, the Cabinet and other officials of this government will continue to operate in a highly effective manner both for the President and his programs and for the benefit of the American people.

To those nations abroad, their leaders should know that this nation will fully exercise its duties and responsibilities throughout the world. President Reagan has built the foundations of a strong federal government and because of his leadership, in selecting the men and women to important positions of government, he has selected individuals who are able to carry out the role he has

established for the United States of America.

Finally, I ask all of you to join with me in asking your God for the fastest and most complete recovery for the President and for those who were stricken with him today. I am very confident that our prayers will be quickly and fully answered.
