According to Allen Wallis (Tab I), the UK, EC, FRG and Italy have accepted the dates; France agrees in principle and Japan cannot respond at this time.

REQUEST: 1988 Canada Economic Summit Meeting

PURPOSE: Canada would like to get agreement on the dates for the 1988 Economic Summit by the time the Heads of State and Government meet next month in Venice.
