Trade - New Round of Multilateral Negotiations

Current Version - Para 10

The current version (attached) contains five options.

Discussion of Options

- -- Option A -- proposed by U.S.
- -- Option B -- proposed by Germans. Unacceptable. Reference in text to unqualified consensus implies veto of negotiations; lacks sense of political impetus required to move forward.
- -- Option C -- proposed by Germans at request of EC Commission. Unacceptable. Step back from OECD Ministerial where some agreed to date certain and increases risk of veto of negotiations.
- -- Option D -- also proposed by Germans. Acceptable if Option A fails.
- -- Option E -- proposed by France. Unacceptable. Holds agreement on any issue hostage to agreement on all (parallelism). Will appear to U.S. farmers to exclude agriculture from negotiations.

Recommendation

We believe that you should argue strongly for Option A, but be prepared to accept Option D. Even Option D would record that most of the participants argued forcefully in the May 3 session that negotiations should begin early next year.

We recommend this position because:

- Reference to a date in meaningful fashion is key -without it U.S. press will call trade portion of the Declaration a defeat for the United States.
- Agreement to "ambiguous" language on a new round, such as "as soon as possible" or some derivative, will be seen as a victory for the French and a step back from the OECD Ministerial.
- Even a split decision (such as Option D) will allow us discretion post-Summit to decide how U.S. will proceed to meet our objectives of trade liberalization (e.g. begin to negotiate without the EC).

 A split decision would enable us to background the press heavily that only two Summit participants (the French and EC Commission) were unable to join in a consensus. This would allow us to isolate both.

Talking Points

- -- New trade round essential to fight protectionism, create new jobs, stimulate competitive industries, strengthen success of debt strategy.
- -- At London, agreed only to launch new round at an "early date".
- -- Recent OECD meeting agreed to launch "as soon as possible".
- -- Must go beyond these ambiguous statements and agree to launch in early 1986.

o Date important; only real impetus to move forward.

- -- Strongly prefer Option A.
- -- (If Option A unacceptable): Agree to accept Mitterrand's proposal of yesterday that "Most believe this... others that" (Option D).

< Option a)

We agree that the multilateral trade negotiations should begin in early 1986 with as broad a consensus of developed and developing countries as possible.

Option b)

We will work towards a consensus on the launching of the new round in 1986.

Option c)

We will work towards a consensus on the launching of the new round to be confirmed by the Contracting Parties at the earliest possible date. We propose that a GATT Ministerial Meeting should be held in the spring of 1986 to take the necessary decisions <on the agenda, modalities and date of the new round >.

Option d)

Option d)

We agree that a new GATT round should begin as soon as possible. Most of us think that this should be in early 1986.

Option e)

These negotiations should not favour any subject. The negotiations and the results implemented should take place in parallel and not in succession. Negotiations on agriculture should take full account of the specific characteristics of this sector and should not, in any case, place in question the fundamental mechanisms both internal and external of national and common agricultural policies. Once these conditions were fulfilled, the new round could start immediately.>

Positions of Others

France and the EC pushed the bracketed language urging that the Summit should decide the substance and procedure beyond the fall Interim Committee meeting. We do not want to let the Interim Committee decide "further action". Nor do we want to decide the substance of future work. We want to delete the language in both brackets.

Talking Points

- -- On procedure, should not let the fall Interim Committee decide "further action".
- -- On substance, already know how to increase stability and predictability of financial markets -- by following good, non-inflationary policies.
- -- Don't want to suggest any other way possible.
- -- Should not accept language on substance of further work on monetary system at this time.

Space Station

Current Version - Para 17

We welcome the positive responses of the Member States of the European Space Agency (ESA), Canada and Japan to the invitation of the President of the United States to cooperate in the United States Manned Space Station Programme on the basis of a genuine partnership and a fair and appropriate exchange of information, experience and technologies. Discussions on intergovernmental cooperation in development and utilization of permanently manned space stations will begin promptly. We have noted the conclusions of the ESA Council on the need for Europe to maintain and expand its autonomous capability in space activity, and on the long-term European Space Plan and its objectives.

Positions of Others

Underlined portions are inserted mainly to appease French desire to equate their project for a potential independent European space capability with the U.S. program. Others are prepared to go along as a friendly gesture, though even the other Europeans are skeptical about the French proposals. I did not bracket because French said they would bracket rest of paragraph if I insisted on bracketing what they wanted. However I made it clear that we disapproved of these portions. Following points are provided if you decide to make an issue of these portions.

Talking Points

- -- Illogical and strikes discordant note to ask Summit countries who are by definition excluded from an "autonomous European space capability" to take any notice at all of such an effort.
- -- Summit should confine its pronouncements to projects in which all are involved or which clearly involve the interests of all.
- -- For same reason, drop reference in previous sentence to stations in plural; there is only one project for a space station on which discussions among all Summit countries will begin promptly.
