I CONGRATULATE YOU ON YOUR ELECTION TO THE PRESIDENCY OF  
THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT. YOUR ELECTION IS AN AFFIRMATION  
OF EUROPEAN PARLIAMENTARIANS' CONFIDENCE IN YOUR LEADER-  
SHIP IN ADDRESSING THE DIFFICULT ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND  
SOCIAL CHALLENGES AHEAD.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

THE UNITED STATES AND THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY SHARE BASIC  
VALUES AND ASPIRATIONS AND FACE MANY OF THE SAME FUNDAMEN-  
TAL CHALLENGES. WE HAVE APPRECIATED THE EUROPEAN PARLIA-

MENT'S MAKING COMMON CAUSE WITH US ON MAJOR ISSUES, SUCH  
AS AFGHANISTAN, POLAND AND THE RELEASE OF US HOSTAGES  
FROM IRAN.

WE LOOK FORWARD TO CONTINUED COOPERATION WITH YOU AND THE  
INSTITUTIONS OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY TO BUILD FURTHER  
THE COOPERATIVE RELATIONSHIP WE HAVE ENJOYED IN THE PAST.

I WISH YOU EVERY SUCCESS IN YOUR TERM OF OFFICE.
