

EUROPEAN COMMUNIT! - UNITED STATES RELATIONS:

- -- THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL HAD A DETAILED DISCUSSION OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF ECONOMIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY AND THE UNITED STATES.
- -- IN PARTICULAR, THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL CONSIDERED THAT IT WAS IN THE INTERESTS OF THE WORLD ECONOMY TO ADHERE TO THE LINES OF POLICY AGREED BY THE PARTICIPANTS AT VERSAILLES. IT CONFIRMED ITS INTENTION FOR ITS PART OF DOING SO TO THE FULL.
- -- IT CONSIDERED THAT A LOWERING OF INTEREST RATES WAS A PREREQUISITE FOR THE RECOVERYOF THE WORLD ECONOMY AND EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT THE US ADMINISTRATION AND CONGRESS WILL TAKE THE NECESSARY DECISIONS TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEM OF THE BUDGET DEFICIT.
- -- SO FAR AS TRADE POLICY ISSUES WERE CONCERNED, THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL CONFIRMED THE CONCLUSIONS OF THE MINISTERS FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, MEETING IN THE COUNCIL ON 21-22 JUNE, WITH RESPECT TO THE DECISIONS OR INTENTIONS ANNOUNCED BY THE UNTITO STATES CONCERNING STEEL MARKETS. AND EXPORT AND LECENSING OF EQUIPMENT FOR INCLUSION IN THE GAS PIPELINE, AND THOSE CONCERNING THE COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY.
- -- THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL EMPHASIZED ITS VIEW THAT THE MAINTENANCE OF THE OPEN WORLD TRADE SYSTEM WILL BE SERIOUSLY JEOPARDISED BY UNITATERAL AND RETROACTIVE DECISIONS ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE, ATTEMPTS TO EXERCISE EXTRATERRITORIAL LEGAL POWERS AND MEASURES WHICH PREVENT THE FULFILMENT OF EXISTING TRADE CONTRACTS.
