WE CALLED ON FOREIGN MINISTRY DIRECTOR OF NORTH AFRICA/MIDDLE EAST AFFAIRS, SERGE BUIDEVAIX, MORNING OF JUNE 8 TO CARRY DUT REFIEL INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING ISRAELI ATTACK ON IRAGI NUCLEAR FACILITIES. BOIDEVAIX SAID THAT HE MAD BEEN INFURMED OF THE ATTACK THE NIGHT BEFORE IN A REPORT FROM THE FRENCH AMBASSADOR IN BAGHDAD. BUIDEVAIX SAID THAT THE GOF PRESUMPTION WAS THAT IT WAS AN ISRAELI ATTACK, OUR CONFIRMATION OF THIS WOULD BE RECEIVED WITH GREAT INTEREST.

3. QUIDEVALX SAID THAT THERE IS SU FAR AS HE IS AWARE AT THIS PUINT -- NU DANGER OF ESCAPING RADIATION. HE SAID THAT AN INSPECTION TEAM FROM THE TAEA IN VIENNA HAD VISITED THE SITE WITHIN THE PAST TWO MONTHS AND THAT THE RADIACTIVE MATERIAL AT THE SITE WAS STORED -- IN A MANNER APPROVED BY THE AGENCY TEAM -- SEPARATELY FROM THE REACTOR, SUBMERGED IN A TANK. BOIDEVAIX SAID THAT, SU FAR AS HE KNOWS, THE STORAGE FACILITY WAS NOT DAMAGED IN THE ATTACK.

1. (CONFIDENTIAL - ENTIRE TEXT).

- 2. SENATOR LAXALT CAME TO FRANCE WITH SENATOR GOLDWATER TO VISIT THE PARIS AIR SHOW AND MAKE A TRIP TO THE BASQUE COUNTRY WHICH IS THE ANCESTRAL HUME OF HIS PARENTS. I HEARD THAT DURING THIS TRIP HE HAD HAD AN OCCASION TO MEET PRESIDENT MITTERRAND. I THEREFORE CALLED ON THE SENATOR ON MONDAY, JUNE 8, TO GET A READING UF HIS CONVERSATION WITH THE PRESIDENT. THE SENATOR WAS VERY FRIENDLY AND FURTHCOMING. HE SAID THAT HE HAD NUT SOUGHT THE MEETING. IT HAD BEEN ARRANGED BY THE MAYOR OF BIARRITZ LAST WEEKEND DURING THE SENATOR'S VISIT TO THE BASQUE COUNTRY. THE MEETING WAS AT MITTERRAND'S HOUSE IN THE LANDES. THE SENATOR HAD EXPECTED TO MAKE A SIMPLE COURTESY CALL OF 15 MINUTES BUT MITTERRAND FXTENDED IT TO TWO HOURS.
- 3. THE SENATOR WAS STRUCK BY THE SIMILARITIES BETWEEN PRESIDENTS MITTERRAND AND REAGAN AND SO TOLD MITTERRAND. (THE SENATUP ALSO SAID THIS PUBLICLY TO THE MEDIA.) BOTH MEN HAD SHOWN EXTRAORDINARY DETERMINATION IN THEIR LONG MARCH TO THE PRESIDENCY. BOTH WERE SELF-CONFIDENT MEN AND MEN OF CONSIDERABLE CHARM. EACH WAS ROOTED IN HIS NATIVE EARTH. THE SIMPLICITY AND RUSTICITY OF MITTERRAND'S HOUSE IN THE LANDES REMINDED THE SENATOR OF RONALD REAGAN'S HOUSE IN CALIFORNIA.
- 4. MITTERRAND WANTED TO KNOW AND TO UNDERSTAND PRESIDENT REAGAN AND HIS POLICIES. THE SENATOR GAVE HIM A FULL EXPOSITION OF PRESIDENT REAGAN'S OUTLOOK AND IN PARTICULAR

MITTERRAND WAS VERY MUCH CONCERNED BY THE IMPACT OF THE HIGH INTEREST RATES ON THE FRENCH ECONOMY. 5. ON EAST-WEST RELATIONS, MITTERRAND WAS VERY FIRM AND SPECIFICALLY ON THE ISSUE OF THE. THE SENATOR MADE CLEAR TO THE PRESIDENT THAT THE ADMINISTRATION WANTED TO MOVE TO MEGOTIATIONS BUT NOT BEFORE THE UNITED STATES HAD GIVEN CONCRETE EVIDENCE OF A NATIONAL WILL TO BUILD UP ITS DEFENSES. THUS PRESIDENT REAGAN WOULD FIND A SUITABLE TIME TO MAKE AN ANNOUNCEMENT AFTER THE PASSAGE OF A STRONG DEFENSE BUDGET. THE SENATOR TOLD MITTERRAND THAT THE UNITED STATES HAD NO INTEREST IN PURSUING AN ARMS RACE WHICH WOULD CAUSE THE EXPENDITURE OF ENDRMOUS RESOURCES THAT COULD BETTER BE USED OTHER-WISE. ACCURDING TO THE SENATOR, MITTERRAND VERY MUCH WELCOMED HIS PRESENTATION. FINALLY, ACCORDING TO THE SENATOR, MITTERRAND EXPRESSED THE HOPE OF BEING ABLE TO VISIT WASHINGTON REFORE THE END OF THE YEAR. 7. ALTOGETHER THE SENATUR WAS QUITE FAVORABLY IMPRESSED BY MITTERRAND WHOM HE FOUND SIMPLE, DIRECT, DETERMINED, A MAN OF SUBSTANCE, NOT "FLAKEY". 8. ON TUESDAY, JUNE 9, THE SENATOR MET THE NEW MINISTER OF DEFENSE CHARLES HERNU AT A LUNCHEON HOSTED BY THE EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE MAGAZINE LE POINT, OLIVIER CHEVRILLON. THE CONVERSATION WAS APPARENTLY DIFFICULT AS HERNU ANSERED QUESTIONS AT LENGTH, MAKING EXCHANGES, COMPLICATED BY TRANSLATIONS, HEAVY-GUING. 2. WE MET JUNE 11 WITH FOREIGN MINISTRY DEPUTY DIRECTOR (MIDDLE EAST) HENRI SERVANT TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION AFTER THE ISRAELI RAID ON THE IRAQI NUCLEAR FACILITY. SERVANT SAID THAT FOLLOWING DUR CONFIRMATION TO THE GOF ON MORNING OF JUNE 8 THAT THE RAID HAD INDEED BEEN UNDERTAKEN BY ISRAEL, HF AND HIS COLLEAGUES HAD PUT TOGETHER A STATEMENT OF FRENCH REACTION WHICH WAS CRITICAL OF ISRAEL BUT NOT VERY STRUNG. HOWEVER, WHEN THE MINISTRY RECEIVED THAT AFTERNOON THE ISRAELI COMMUNIQUE ANNOUNCING THAT ISRAEL HAD DESTROYED AN IRAQI REACTOR "BUILT BY FRANCE," IT WAS DECIDED THAT A FIRMER POSITION WAS REQUIRED; IT WAS NOT FRANCE'S OBLIGATION TO DEFEND IRAQ BUT WHEN THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT DIRECTLY INVOLVED FRANCE, THE GOF HAD TO REACT STRUNGLY. THUS PRIME MINISTER MAURUY IN THE FIRST

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REACTION MUNDAY EVENING DESCRIBED THE RAID AS "AN UNACCEPT-ABLE ACT WHICH CAN ONLY INCREASE TENSION IN THE REGION . . . AND COMPLICATE AN ALREADY EXPLUSIVE SITUATION." SUBSEQUENT DECLARATIONS HAVE BEEN CONSISTENT WITH THIS. SERVANT SAID IT WAS NOT CLEAR WHAT THE LONGER TERM IMPLICATIONS OF THE RAID WOULD BE, THOUGH IT WAS BEING GENERALLY ASSUMED AT THE MINISTRY THAT BEGIN'S ELECTORAL CHANCES HAD NOT BEEN DAMAGED GIVEN THE NEAR TOTAL ISRAELI CONSENSUS IN FAVOR OF THE RAID. 4. AS FUR ACTION AT THE UN, SERVANT SAID THAT THE ARAB POSITION IN THE SECURITY COUNCIL WOULD ONLY BE DETERMINED AFTER TODAY'S ARAB LEAGUE MEETING IN BAGHDAD. HE SAID FRANCE WOULD SUPPORT A RESULUTION CONDEMNING ISRAELI VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW, AND EVEN ONE CALLING FOR REPARATIONS. A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR SANCTIONS, HOWEVER, WOULD BE MUCH MORE COMPLICATED, ESPECIALLY AS FRANCE TPPOSES SANCTIONS AS A GENERAL PULE. HE DESCRIBED THIS RPPOSITION TO SANCTIONS AS A GENERAL POLICY NOT RELATED TO THIS PARTICULAR QUESTION. THE GENERAL LINE THE FRENCH PERMREP WILL TAKE IN THE SC DEBATE IS THAT THE FACILITY IN IRAQ WAS BUILT IN ACCORDANCE WITH INTERNATIONALLY ACCEPTED PRACTICE, THAT IRAQ IS PARTY TO THE NPT, AND THAT THE FACILITY HAD RECENTLY BEEN INSPECTED BY AN IAEA TEAM. HE WILL SAY THAT UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES WHAT IS AT QUESTION IS NOTHING LESS THAN THE RIGHT OF A DEVELOPED COUNTRY TO GIVE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE IN NUCLEAR MATTERS TO A DEVELOPING COUNTRY. HE WILL CHARACTERIZE THE ISRAELI RAID AS AN UNACCEPTABLE VIOLATION OF INTERNATIONAL LAW. SERVANT SAID HE ASSUMED THAT THE ISRAELI TACTIC WILL BE TO TRY AND JUSTIFY ITS ACTION AS SELF-DEFENSE THROUGH TURNING THE DEBATE INTO A HIGHLY TECHNICAL DISCUSSION. FRANCE, HE SAID, HAS NO INTENTION OF BEING DRAWN INTO THIS KIND OF DEBATE WHICH COULD DRAG ON INTERMINABLY WITH EACH SIDE'S TECHNICAL EXPERTS "PROVING" THEIR POINT OF VIEW. AS TO THE LONGER TERM EFFECT OF THE RAID ON FRANCO-ISRAELI RELATIONS, SERVANT SAID HE DID NOT THINK IT WOULD NECESSARILY BE VERY GREAT. HE SAID THERE IS A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF "INNUCENCE" AMONG THE NEW MITTERRAND PEOPLE BOTH AT THE ELYSEE AND AT THE QUAI CONCERNING ISRAEL. (HE ADDED THAT HE DOES NOT INCLUDE MITTERRAND IN THIS CATEGORY: MITTERRAND HAS WARM SENTIMENTS TOWARDS ISRAEL, RUT HE IS WILY AND KNOWS THE ISRAELIS TOO WELL NOT TO KNOW WHAT THEY ARE UP TO.) THE MOST IMMEDIATE EFFECT IS THEREFORE LIKELY TO BE THE LOSS BY THESE PEOPLE OF THEIR "INNOCENCE" VIS-A-VIS ISRAEL AND POSSIBLY AN EARLIER END THAN WOULD OTHERWISE HAVE BEEN THE CASE OF EXAGGERATED
