

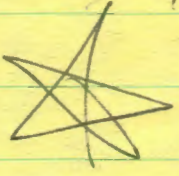

Well-Traveled Lady To Call At San Diego

WASHINGTON, D.C. — She's been everywhere since she was launched in 1954. She is Queen Elizabeth II's yacht, Britannia. She has sailed the Pacific, sailed the Atlantic, the Mediterranean, the Indian Ocean, the Baltic, the north seas, the south seas — every ocean on the globe. She's a state yacht, a floating hotel, a voyager to exotic places, and a honeymoon hideout.

She carried Princess Margaret on her 1960 honeymoon with her then-husband Anthony Armstrong Jones. She has borne the Queen Mother over to Northern Ireland, and to the Channel Islands. Princess Anne and Mark Phillips spent their 1973 honeymoon sailing aboard the royal yacht through the Caribbean to Galapagos. And more recently, Prince Charles and Princess Diana cruised the Mediterranean after their big splashy wedding with the privacy of Britannia to protect them against the prying eyes of a watching world.

And on Feb. 26, Britannia will anchor in San Diego harbor as the queen's floating base at the start of her California visit.

Britannia's complement of 22 officers and 254 men are a mix of permanent and temporary crewmen who have volunteered from the Royal Navy for this special duty. They try always to work silently on the upper decks, in order not to disturb the traveling royals — usually the queen and Prince Philip making state visits to British Commonwealth and foreign nations.

Seamen wear British naval uniform with three exceptions — their jumpers are tucked inside the top of their trousers instead of outside (no one at the embassy here seems to know why), their trousers are decorated at the back with a black silk bow (probably a holdover from the days when sailor's trousers were laced up the back) and they wear white badges instead of the usual red ones.

The yacht replaced the old Victoria and Albert, and was built 28 years ago at John Brown's shipyards on the Clyde, for 2 million pounds. She is 412 feet, 3 inches long, 55 foot in the beam, 5,769 tons, and draws 17 feet. Her topgoing speed is 21 knots and she has all the most up-to-date equipment for security and safety.

The yacht has a royal blue hull with a gold band below the white superstructure and buff colored funnel. The Royal coat of arms is on the bow, the royal cypher on the stern. The main mast once had to be hinged, apparently

so Britannia could pass under the bridges of the St. Lawrence Seaway.

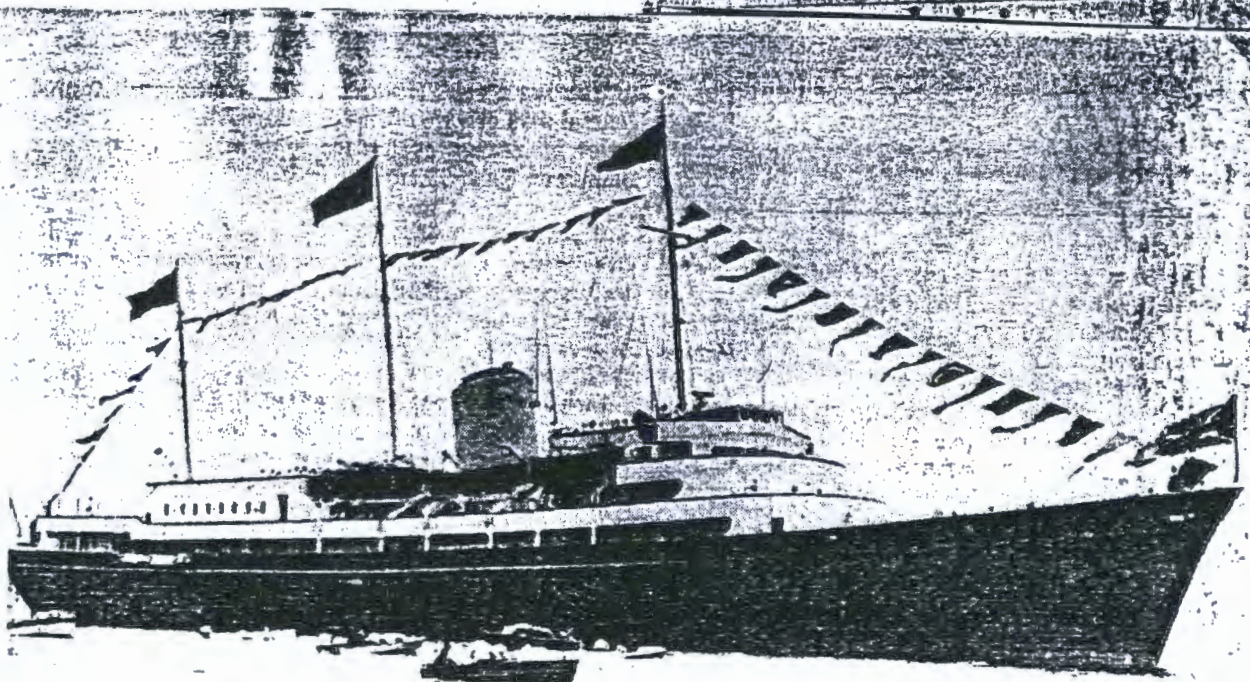
According to a description in the book "The Royal Family" by former footman Ralph White, a wide mahogany staircase leads below to a luxurious drawing room where doors to the adjoining dining salon can be opened for receptions for as many as 200 guests. The dining table is edged with ebony and seated 32 people until Prince Philip, years ago, added leaves to allow 28 more guests to be seated. Sliding panels can be opened to disclose a movie screen. Mahogany sideboards and the Hepplewhite chairs came from the Victoria and Albert.

The Queen and Prince Philip both have private sitting rooms, the queen's is white paneled and decorated in rose and green. Prince Philip's has teal walls and a concealed cocktail cabinet. A model of the frigate Magpie, which he once commanded, hangs over an electric fire. Each sitting room has a built-in desk, telephones and an intercom system.

An elevator connects the sitting rooms with the royal bedrooms — a suite with dressing rooms where the queen's 6-foot, blue leather traveling wardrobes full of evening gowns, her chest of drawers on wheels full of gloves and lingerie, her hat boxes, shoe boxes, crocodile dressing case containing a 30-piece set of silver-gilt brushes and cosmetic bottles, and her umbrella and parasol case are unpacked before she comes aboard.

In the stern is a glass-enclosed sun lounge where the royals breakfast below a map marking the previous day's run. The windows of the royal sleeping quarters are set at an angle, Ralph White wrote, so that crew members walking outside on the deck in their rubber-soled meak-

ers cannot see in. The cabins are fitted with more than 100 bunks, and like most of the ship, are air-conditioned.

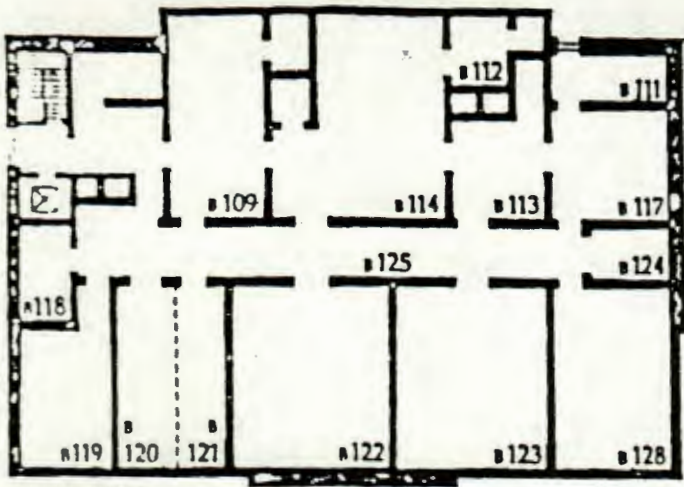

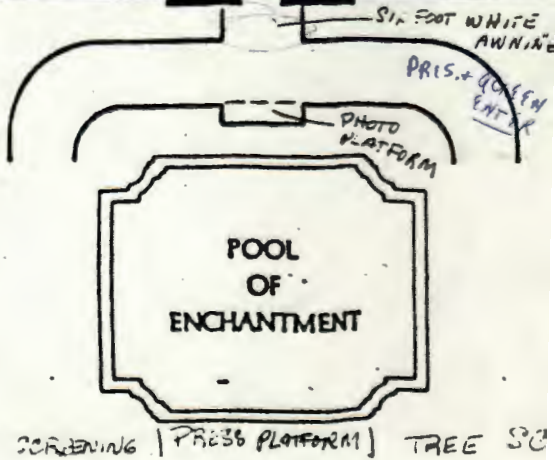
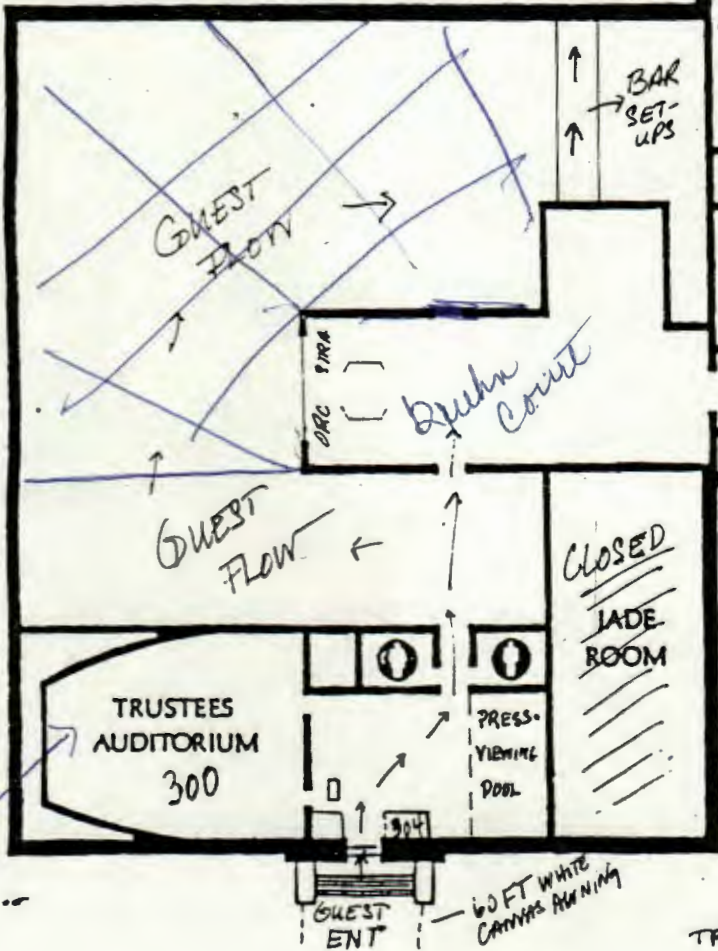
