The Facts About Small Businesses in 1980

- *Small business bankruptcies have incresed 48 percent since October 1979 ("Small Business Bankruptcies Rise After Credit-Tightening," Washington Post, May 15, 1980).
- *An estimated 666,000 small businesses will fail in 1980 ("The Impact of Inflation on Small Business," Small Business Administration, May, 1980).

Mr. Carter's Promise as a Candidate in 1976

"As President, I would introduce and support concrete programs which would have as high priority the expansion of the independent small business sector of the economy" (Position Paper, October 11, 1976).

Mr. Carter's Promise as President in 1978

"In 1978, we will continue efforts to support small business through tax cuts and special tax incentives, reduced regulations, and other programmatic reforms, and expanded SBA loan authority" (Presidential Documents, January 19, 1978).

Mr. Carter summarizes Small Business Problems on January 14, 1980

"Inflation is one of the most vexing and intractable problems we face as a nation. It afflicts all segments of our society, but some elements are especially vulnerable. Small business is on of the sectors that is particularly hard hit" (Presidential Documents, January 14, 1980).
