TO TAKE THE INITIATIVE, WE NEED BOTH TO EDUCATE AND TO INSPIRE. WE MUST BE CANDID ABOUT THE SOVIET THREAT, AND GO ON THE POLITICAL OFFENSIVE WITH POSITIVE WESTERN PROPOSALS. TO TURN AROUND A SOMEWHAT DEFENSIVE AND RESPONSIVE WESTERN POSTURE, WE NEED TO PURSUE THE SAME COMBINATION OF PRESSURE AND PROMISE WHICH THE SOVIETS HAVE DEVELOPED TO SUCH A FINE ART.

WE ALREADY HAVE UNDERTAKEN THIS COMBINATION OF STEPS IN A NUMBER OF MAJOR AREAS: AFGHANISTAN, CSCE/CDE AND TNF. OUR EFFORTS TO FOCUS PUBLIC ATTENTION ON WESTERN INITIATIVES AND POLICIES IN EACH OF THESE AREAS, AND TO EDUCATE OUR PEOPLE ABOUT SOVIET INTRANSIGENCE AND THREATS, MUST BE CONTINUED AND INTENSIFIED. IN ADDITION, TO HELP ON THE EDUCATIONAL SIDE, WE INTEND TO MAKE PUBLIC A NUMBER OF STUDIES ON THE SOVIET MILITARY THREAT, SOVIET COVERT ACTIVITY, AND ACTIVITIES OF SOVIET PROXIES AND SURROGATES IN THE DEVELOPING WORLD.

AS ESSENTIAL AS THESE EXISTING PROGRAMS ARE, THEY WILL NOT BE SUFFICIENT BY THEMSELVES TO INFUSE OUR PUBLICS WITH A NEW SENSE OF PURPOSE AND CONFIDENCE. OUR PUBLICS OF COURSE DIFFER, AND WE WILL EACH NEED TO SHAPE OUR EFFORT SO AS TO MAKE IT MOST EFFECTIVE AT HOME. AND THIS MUST BE A CONTINUING PROCESS. BUT I HAVE TWO SUGGESTIONS FOR PARALLEL ACTIONS FOR THE NEAR TERM.

I PROPOSE WE CONSIDER RECOMMENDING THAT THE SEVEN HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT WHO MET AT OTTAWA SEND PRIVATE LETTERS TO BREZHNEV, WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT THE BROAD THEMES ADDRESSED IN THE LETTERS WOULD BE MADE PUBLIC. LOOKING TOWARD THE UNGA, THE LETTERS WOULD STRESS THAT THE INDUSTRIAL DEMOCRACIES DESIRE A CONSTRUCTIVE RELATIONSHIP WITH THE SOVIET UNION AND A REDUCTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL TENSIONS WHICH ARE SO PROMINENT TODAY. THEY WOULD REITERATE THAT WE ARE PREPARED TO TAKE APPROPRIATE STEPS TO MEET LEGITIMATE SOVIET CONCERNS, BUT THAT PROGRESS IN EAST/WEST RELATIONS DEPENDS UPON THE WILLINGNESS OF THE USSR TO EXERCISE GREATER RESTRAINT IN ITS INTERNATIONAL BEHAVIOR.

SPECIFICALLY, WE WOULD MAKE CLEAR THAT THE SOVIET UNION MUST RESTRAIN AN ARMS BUILD-UP WHICH HAS ALREADY GONE FAR BEYOND REQUIREMENTS FOR LEGITIMATE SELF DEFENSE,

AND DEMONSTRATE GENUINE SERIOUSNESS ABOUT ARMS CONTROL. EQUALLY IMPORTANT WOULD BE A SOVIET DECISION TO ENTER INTO SERIOUS NEGOTIATIONS TO ADDRESS GEOPOLITICAL PROBLEMS WHICH THREATEN PEACE AROUND THE WORLD, INCLUDING THE PRESENCE OF FOREIGN TROOPS IN AFGHANISTAN AND KAMPUCHEA, AND TO TAKE STEPS TO CEASE EXTERNAL STIMULATION OF VIOLENCE AND INSTABILITY IN AFRICA, CENTRAL AMERICA AND ELSEWHERE. THE LETTERS WOULD STATE THAT THE WEST IS READY TO SEEK SOLUTIONS TO THESE PROBLEMS BUT THAT THE USSR MUST NOW DECIDE WHETHER IT IS WILLING TO PARTICIPATE IN BUILDING A MORE RESTRAINED AND HUMANE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY.

THE SOVIETS HAVE USED SUCH HIGH-LEVEL LETTERS CONTINUALLY AND OFTEN TO GOOD EFFECT. TAKING THE INITIATIVE TO SEND LETTERS FROM WESTERN LEADERS WOULD PROVIDE BOTH THE SOVIETS AND OUR PUBLICS WITH A HIGH-PROFILE DEMONSTRATION OF OUR APPROACH, INVITING AND CHALLENGING THE SOVIETS TO JOIN IN AN EFFORT TO SET EAST-WEST RELATIONS ON A MORE CONSTRUCTIVE AND DURABLE BASIS.

MY OTHER SUGGESTION IS THAT WE FIND WAYS TO FOCUS MUCH GREATER ATTENTION ON WESTERN VALUES. WE HAVE FOR TOO LONG PERMITTED THE SOVIET UNION TO PORTRAY ITSELF AS REVOLUTIONARY AND PROGRESSIVE, WHEN WE ARE THE MOST INNOVATIVE AND GENUINELY PROGRESSIVE SOCIETIES. WE MUST DEMONSTRATE HOW THE WESTERN VALUES OF INDIVIDUAL FREEDOM AND INITIATIVE MEET MATERIAL AND SPIRITUAL NEEDS BETTER THAN TOTALITARIAN REGIMES. AND WE MUST TRANSLATE THESE VALUES INTO SPECIFIC PROPOSALS IN THE INTERNATIONAL ARENA WHICH COULD HELP CREATE A BETTER WORLD.

EAGLEBURGER STRESSED THAT WE WOULD NOT YIELD ON "COMPENSATION" FOR EITHER UK/FRENCH SYSTEMS OR F8S. GENSCHER INDICATED AGREEMENT AND

GENSCHER REACTED VERY NEGATIVELY ON THIS POINT, ARGUING THAT INSTEAD WE SHOULD GO BACK AND SUGGEST A DATE A WEEK EARLIER THAN THE SOVIET PROPOSAL, STRICTLY FOR PUBLIC RELATIONS BENEFIT. GENSCHER ALSO STRESSED THE NEED TO

IMPROVE OUR OVERALL PUBLIC RELATIONS EFFORT ON TNF. FOGLEBURGER AGREED, AND SAID THIS WOULD BE A KEY POINT AT AUGUST'S SCG MEETING.

6. FOGLEBURGER OUTLINED FOR GENSCHER OUR THINKING ON HOW WE SHOULD TAKE THE OFFENSIVE TO DEMONSTRATE SOVIET UNRESPONSIVENESS TO WESTERN INITIATIVES ON AFGHANISTAN AND CSCE/CDE. GENSCHER AGREED FULLY, AND EXPLAINED THAT HE HAD ALREADY BEEN TAKING THE SAME LINE WE PLANNED TO USE IN HIS OWN PUBLIC STATEMENTS.

7. GENSCHER REVIEWED HIS RECENT TRIP TO BULGARIA, AND STRESSED THAT BULGARIAN PARTY BOSS ZHIVKOV CAN SERVE AS A USEFUL CONDUIT TO THE SOVIETS IN VIEW OF HIS STANDING WITH THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP. IN ADDITION, GENSCHER RECALLED THAT CZECH PRIME MINISTER STROUGAL SAID ZHIVKOV HAD ARGUED EFFECTIVELY AGAINST INTERVENTION IN POLAND DURING DECEMBER 1980 WARSAW PACT SUMMIT. HE ENCOURAGED FOGLEBURGER TO VISIT BULGARIA, BUT URGED THAT ANYTHING WE TRY TO DO THROUGH THE BULGARIANS NOT DETRACT FROM OUR DIRECT CONTACTS WITH THE SOVIETS. IN LATTER CONTEXT, GENSCHER STRESSED GROMYKO'S INFLUENCE IN MOSCOW AND THE FRG VIEW THAT GROMYKO CAN PLAY A HELPFUL ROLE.

ABSURD IN MILITARY TERMS AND ADDED THAT HE WOULD DISCUSS THE SUBJECT IN CANCUN WITH THE SWEDISH FOREIGN MINISTER.

EAGLEBURGER SOUGHT TO CORRECT THIS IMPRESSION BY POINTING OUT THAT THE EQUIPMENT INVOLVED REPLACED OLDER MODELS AND COULD NOT BE USED FOR THE SIBERIAN PIPELINE. HE ALSO NOTED THAT THIS DECISION WAS A SMALL BUT POTENTIALLY USEFUL SIGNAL TO THE SOVIETS. GENSCHER EXPRESSED FULL SUPPORT FOR THIS VIEW.

12. IN CONCLUSION, GENSCHER MENTIONED A RECENT POLL BY THE ALLENSBACH POLLING INSTITUTE WHICH HE SAID DEMONSTRATED CONCLUSIVELY THAT THERE WAS NO ANTI-AMERICANISM IN THE FRG AND THAT THE MAJORITY OF THE GERMAN PEOPLE SUPPORTED TNF DEPLOYMENT. GENSCHER SAID WHAT ANTI-AMERICANISM THERE WAS IN THE FRG WAS A CREATION OF "CERTAIN POLITICIANS" WHO USE IT FOR THEIR OWN PURPOSES.

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WILL THIS MONTH SEEK BUNDESTAG APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED AID FOR TURKEY. I KNOW THAT YOU SHARE MY VIEW ON THE VITAL IMPORTANCE OF SUSTAINED WESTERN EFFORTS TO HELP TURKEY REGAIN ECONOMIC HEALTH AND STABLE DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENT. SINCE THE GUADELOUPE SUMMIT, YOUR GOVERNMENT HAS PLAYED A LEADING ROLE IN MARSHALING RESOURCES FOR TURKISH ECONOMIC RECOVERY. THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC HAS THEREBY MADE AN IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTION TO OUR COLLECTIVE EFFORTS TO STRENGTHEN STABILITY IN AND AROUND SOUTHWEST ASIA, AND IN THE SOUTHEASTERN FLANK OF NATO.

I WANT YOU AND THE CHANCELLOR TO KNOW IN ABSOLUTE CONFIDENCE THAT I HAVE RECENTLY COMMUNICATED WITH GENERAL EVREN ON THE NEED FOR MEANINGFUL STEPS TO MEET THE CONCERNS IN WESTERN EUROPE. YOUR GOVERNMENT, BY PROMPTLY REDEFINING ITS ECONOMIC PLEDGE FOR 1981, CAN REINFORCE MY EFFORTS WITH EVREN AND INCREASE THE LIKELIHOOD THAT HE WILL BE RESPONSIVE IN MANAGING THE DOMESTIC SITUATION IN TURKEY.
