2. DAHRENDORF CALLED DCM AGAIN DECEMBER 27 TO REPORT THAT VOGEL, BRANDT, AND SCHMIDT HAD CONSULTED OVER WEEKEND ABOUT VOGEL'S PROPOSED TRIP TO WASHINGTON AND HAD REAFFIRMED THE OVERRIDING IMPORTANCE OF SCHEDULING IT BEFORE VOGEL'S TRIP TO MOSCOW JANUARY 10-12. IN VIEW OF THE PRESSURE OF TIME, VOGEL WOULD NOW LIKE TO PROCEED WITH A VISIT TO WASHINGTON JANUARY 6-7, EVEN IF A MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT CANNOT BE SCHEDULED AT THAT TIME. HE DOES, HOWEVER, REQUEST AN APPOINTMENT WITH SECRETARY SHULTZ ON ONE OF THOSE DATES.

3. AMBASSADOR'S COMMENT: I STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT THE SECRETARY SPEND A GOOD HALF HOUR WITH VOGEL. THAT BECOMES ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT IF THE PRESIDENT IS TOTALLY UNAVAILABLE.
