SUBJECT: Ambassador Hermes Meeting, 3:45 p.m.

Ambassador Hermes wants to discuss two subjects:

- The Carstens visit in October
- INF.

On the Carstens visit, we have submitted a schedule proposal for the President to receive Carstens both in Philadelphia for the Tricentennial celebration and in Washington. We have not focused yet on the specific details of the events during the visit so we can listen to Hermes' ideas.

On INF, Hermes will be interested in current thinking on an interim solution. He has read the press leaks of the last several days like everyone else and is concerned that his government be consulted. As our thinking develops you can reassure him that just as we have consulted closely with Cancellor Kohl in the past (the President's American Legion speech for example) we will continue to consult as we develop positions in the future.



SUBJECT: Format and Participants for Kohl Visit, April 15

Attached is a memorandum to the State Department informing them of the format and participants in Friday's visit by Chancellor Kohl. Once you approve, Mike Wheeler will sign the memo.

The format and participation in this meeting will be the pattern for all six of the pre-Summit bilateral visits. These visits will be different from the normal bilateral working visit because they will concern both summit and bilateral issues. In order to obtain the maximum benefit from these visits, we recommend that the format for the meeting and the luncheon be larger than usual. In addition to the standard participants, we should include the cabinet officers who will be involved in the summit issues -- Secretary Regan and Ambassador Brock -- and the Sherpa team members who are working on the Summit. We have drawn up the attached memo based on this format. Jim Rosebush and the Social Office have no objection to handling the luncheon this way.

An alternative which we do not recommend would be to restrict the luncheon to cabinet-level officers only. Although this format would control the numbers, it would exclude the staff members who will have done the preparation for both the meeting and the summit, and will be responsible for implementing the decisions made in the meetings.
