Possible Kohl Meeting with the President

During Jack Matlock's and my talks with German Foreign Ministry State Secretary Meyer-Landrut, and prior to John Poindexter's arrival -- Bud never made it -- Ambassador Hermes suggested that we consider inviting Kohl to join the President at what he understood would be a January Presidential reception for the European Space Lab astronauts. Meyer-Landrut endorsed Hermes' suggestion, but noted that Kohl could not come to the United States simply for a reception, i.e., he would also have to have a substantive meeting with the President.

My informal check indicates that a reception is indeed under consideration for January after the astronauts have returned and been debriefed. I see no immediate action on our part, but we need to keep Hermes' suggestion in the back of our minds. I will give Burt a heads up on the German suggestion during our NATO trip. Knowing the Germans, Genscher may also suggest a Kohl-President meeting when he sees Shultz this week.

SUBJECT: Schedule Proposal for Chancellor Kohl

We have sent Bud under separate cover (NSC #9407) a comprehensive list of European visitors for the first half of 1984. Since I do not believe that Bud will oppose a Kohl visit, and given that we wish to suggest a slightly different meeting format, I am forwarding this memo prior to receiving Bud's reaction to the overall list.

During Secretary Shultz' December visit to Bonn, Kohl suggested that he would like to meet with the President in the first months of 1984. The German Embassy has now recommended, via State, that Kohl meet with the President on March 5 or 6 (Tab II). Kohl has let it be known that he hopes to have a long, personal exchange with the President, preferably over dinner. This is the format that Kohl used with Shultz in Bonn in December, i.e., an informal, small, dinner party with about 6 or 7 on each side.

State (Richard Burt in particular) has strongly advocated that we pursue a small, working dinner. I understand that the President had a small dinner for Kohl on his last U.S. visit, which included wives. Kohl apparently is not bringing his wife this time; and at any rate he prefers a working dinner.

RECOMMENDATION

After checking with Bud, that you sign the Kohl scheduling request to Ryan (Tab I), recommending a small, informal working dinner, preceded by drinks (total of two and one-half hours).

SUBJECT: Request For Brief Presidential Meeting:
Dr. Bruno Heck

Dr. Bruno Heck, Chairman of the Konrad Adenauer Stiftung, has been trying to meet briefly with the President for some time. Our attempt for a photo opportunity earlier this month did not work out because the President was on the West Coast. I have now been informed that Heck will again be in Washington during the week of April 9. The Stiftung's Washington office is pushing hard for a brief meeting with the President. I hope you would agree to take Heck in for a five-minute photo opportunity at the end or beginning of your 9:30 meeting one day during the week of April 9-13. The President's schedule indicates that he will be in town that week.

Heck, who has been Chairman of the Stiftung since its establishment in 1964, was a close friend of Konrad Adenauer. He served as Federal Minister in Adenauer's Cabinet. Heck is also a former Secretary General of the Christian Democratic Union; he was a member of the Bundestag until 1976. More importantly, in 1978 when the President came to Bonn on a private visit, Heck -- through the good offices of Richard Allen -- hosted a luncheon for the President and introduced him to a number of leading German politicians. In short, when the President was out of office Heck gave him red carpet treatment.
