1. LATE JULY 28, PRIME MINISTER SPADOLINI'S OFFICE ISSUED A STATEMENT ON THE SITUATION IN LEBANON EXPRESSING GOI'S "FIRMEST CONDEMNATION OF THE PROLONGING OF THE RECOURSE TO FORCE ON THE PART OF THE GOVERNMENT OF TEL AVIV" AND UNDERSCORING "THE HEAVY LOSS OF LIFE THAT ISRAELI ACTION IN LEBANON CONTINUES TO CAUSE." THE NOTE FURTHER UNDERSCORES NEW GOI INITIATIVES TO BRING SUCCOR TO THE STRICKEN POPULATION.


