- 4. THOUSANDS OF ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, CIVIC AND FRATERNAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT BODIES HAVE IMPLEMENTED PRO-GRAMS OF A VERY DIVERSE NATURE TO FULFILL THE OBJECTIVES OF THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATIONS IN ESTABLISHING WORLD FOOD DAY.

- 5. THE RESPONSE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES TO WORLD FOOD DAY REFLECTS THIS NATION'S ABIDING COMMITMENT TO ELIMINATING POVERTY-RELATED HUNGER WHEREVER IT EXISTS.
- 6. SINCE 1954 WE HAVE PROVICED ALMOST 400 MILLION TONS OF FOOD AID AT THE COST OF \$40 BILLION. WE HAVE SENT HUNDREDS OF AGRICULTURAL EXPERTS TO DEVELOPING NATIONS TO HELP THEM IMPROVE THEIR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTIVITY. WE HAVE MADE THE RESULTS OF EXTENSIVE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH

FREELY AVAILABLE WORLDWIDE, AND WE HAVE PROVIDED AGRICUL-TURAL TRAINING FOR THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS FROM THE THIRD WORLD

- 7. ALTHOUGH MUCH HAS BEEN DONE TO ALLEVIATE WORLD HUNGER, THE MANNER IN WHICH THE AMERICAN PEOPLE HAVE REACTED TO WORLD FOOD DAY INDICATES A CONVICTION THAT MUCH REMAINS TO BE DONE.
