DRAFT TOAST FOR PRESIDENT'S LUNCHEON FOR PRIME MINISTER FANFANI

This house is deeply honored today by the presence of a man whose political life spans Italy's postwar history, and who symbolizes the flourishing of Italian democracy. Prime Minister Fanfani stands second to none as a symbol of close, friendly, and mutually beneficial ties between the United States and Italy since the closing days of World War II. For example, Mr. Prime Minister, I recall vividly the account Ambassador Rabb provided me of his first meeting with you in July 1981. History was tangibly present in that room as you eloquently traced the role of US-Italian relations in Italy's reconstruction and democratic development after the war.

I would like to take this occasion, however, to do more than acknowledge the accomplishments of Amintore Fanfani as an individual. I want to thank Prime Minister Fanfani for Italy's continuing vital contribution to the Western Alliance. Italy's staunch support of both tracks of the NATO 1979 INF decision has been exemplary. I say without reservation, Mr. Prime Minister, that we regard Italy's importance in NATO as second to no other member of the Alliance. I want also to applaud the decisions Italy has taken, with a view to laying the foundation for successful resolution of long bitterly contested issues, to participate in the Multinational Force and Observers in the Sinai, UNIFIL in Lebanon, and the Multinational Force in Lebanon. We appreciate that Italy, as well as we, has suffered





loss in Lebanon -- I note with respect the death of Italian soldier Filippo Montesi and the wounding of several other Italian soldiers.

As we proceed on to Williamsburg, I hope as in the past to have the continued benefit of Italy's wise counsel and advice on the important economic issues which we will address there. As experience has shown, sound and coordinated fiscal and monetary policies are essential if the Summit nations' economies are to emerge from their recent troubles. We look forward to this opportunity to hasten the Summit partners along the road to recovery.

The maintenance of peace is not easy, and Italy has accepted the burdens of her world position. As we move ahead together, I look forward to continuing to have the counsel and support of Amintore Fanfani as political leader, elder statesman, and esteemed friend.

Please join me in a toast to Prime Minister Fanfani, to Italian-American friendship, and to the values of democracy, human rights, and liberty which both our nations hold dear.
