: VISIT OF VICE PRESIDENT BUSH

1. AS YOU KNOW, PLANNING HAS BEGUN ON A VISIT TO YOUR POST BY THE VICE PRESIDENT. THE VISIT WILL BE PLANNED AND PREPARED BY ADVANCE PERSONNEL FROM THE WHITE HOUSE WHO WILL BE LOOKING TO YOU FOR SUPPORT. THIS MESSAGE IS TO GIVE YOU AN IDEA OF THE NORMAL COMPOSITION OF THE PRE-ADVANCE AND ADVANCE TEAMS, WHAT SUPPORT THEY WILL REQUIRE, AND WHAT YOU CAN DO PRIUR TO THEIR ARRIVAL TO FNSURE THAT THEIR WORK GETS UNDERWAY QUICKLY AND SMOOTHLY.

IN PREPARING FOR THE VICE PRESIDENT'S VISIT, YOU WILL WANT TO MAKE MAXIMUM USE OF THE EXPERIENCE YOU HAVE GAINED FROM OTHER VIP MISSIONS. AT THE SAME TIME IT IS FSSENTIAL TO KEEP CLEARLY IN MIND THAT A VISIT BY THE VICE PRESIDENT IS QUITE UNLIKE THOSE OF OTHER OFFICIALS, AND THAT EACH VICE PRESIDENTIAL VISIT HAS A DYNAMIC AND CHARACTER OF ITS OWN. THE KEYS TO ENSURING THE VISIT

ORKS SMOOTHLY ARE FLEXIBILITY AND RESPONSIVENESS. THE TEAM OF WHITE HOUSE SPECIALISTS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VISIT WILL BE EXPERIENCED AND CAPABLE. THEY WILL BE LOOKING TO YOU FOR SUPPORT IN AN ENVIRONMENT THAT IS NEW TO THEM. YOUR EXPERIENCE AND PROFESSIONALISM CAN BE CRITICAL ELEMENTS IN MAKING THE VISIT A SUCCESS.

ALL TRAFFIC CONCERNING THE VICE PRESIDENT'S SCHEDULE AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE WHITE HOUSE FOR MR. MICHAEL FARLEY AND MR. JUSEPH CANZERI, AND THE DEPARTMENT FOR A/EX - MIKE NEWELL.

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- THIS VISIT WILL HAVE TWO PREPARATORY PHASES: A PRE-ADVANCE AND AN ADVANCE.
- 3. THE PRE-ADVANCE TEAM WILL ARRIVE ON MONDAY, JUNE 15 1981. IT WILL CONSIST OF APPROXIMATELY 10 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE VARIOUS OFFICES IN THE WHITE HOUSE AND OTHER AGENCIES WHICH HAVE A DIRECT INTEREST IN ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE ACTUAL VISIT. INCLUDED ARE; WHITE HOUSE STAFF, STATE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR, WHITE HOUSE ADVANCE PERSONNEL, THE WHITE HOUSE COMMUNICATIONS AGENCY, THE SECRET SERVICE, ETC.

HOST GOVERNMENT COUNTERPARTS ASSIGNED RESPONSIBILITY FOR EACH POSSIBLE EVENT OF THE VISIT SHOULD BE IDENTIFIED AT THIS TIME.

BECAUSE THE PRE-ADVANCE IS SHORT, TEAM MEMBERS EXPECT TO MEET EMBASSY COUNTERPARTS ON ARRIVAL, HOST COUNTRY CONTACTS AS SOON AS THIS IS FEASIBLE AND THEN MOVE QUICKLY TO SITE INSPECTIONS. PRIOR TO ARRIVAL OF PRE-ADVANCE, POST SHOULD DESIGNATE EMBASSY OFFICERS TO HANDLE FOLLOWING FUNCTIONS:

- --VICE PRESIDENT'S PROGRAM/SCHEDULE (SENIOR EMBASSY
- --OFFICER;
- -- SECURITY (RSD, POST SECURITY OFFICER)
- -- TRANSPORTATION (ADMIN. GSO)
- -- COMMUNICATIONS (ADMIN. CRO)
- -- ACCOMMODATIONS (ADMIN. ASST. GSO)
- -- PROTOCOL (EXECUTIVE OR POLITICAL SECTION)
- -- GIFTS (CONSULAR SECTION)
- -- VISITOR'S CONTROL ROOM (ADMIN. B&F/GSD)
- --MILITARY LIAISON FOR AIR FURCE/HELICOPTER ADVANCE
- -- (DEFENSE ATTACHE)
- -- MEDICAL LIAISON (ADMIN)
- -- THANK YOU LETTER FOR HUST GOVERNMENT (POLITICAL
- -- OFFICER,
- --THANK YOU LETTERS FOR EMBASSY STAFF, HOST COUNTRY --NATIONALS (CONTROL OFFICER OR ADMIN)

POSTS SHOULD ALSO DESIGNATE UFFICERS TO COORDINATE WITH WHITE HOUSE PERSONNEL ON EACH OF THE MAJOR EVENTS OF THE PROPOSED SCHEDULE. MOST POSTS FIND IT NECESSARY TO ASSIGN OFFICERS TO MORE THAN ONE FUNCTION. ON ARRIVAL, THE PRE-ADVANCE TEAM SHOULD BE GIVEN A COMPLETE LIST, WITH TELEPHONE CONTACTS. THE

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PRE-ADVANCE WILL LOOK TO THE EMBASSY'S CONTROL OFFICER TO COORDINATE THE POST'S SUPPORT OF THE VISIT AND SERVE AS THE POST'S LIAISON WITH THE WHITE HOUSE LEAD ADVANCE.

- 5. POST ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL SHOULD WORK CLOSELY WITH THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR, WHO WILL VISIT POST WITH THE PRE-ADVANCE TEAM AND RETURN WITH THE ACTUAL VISIT. THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR WILL WORK WITH THE POST ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REGARDING FUNDING FOR THE TRIP. ONLY THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR HAS THE AUTHORITY TO CHARGE OR OBLIGATE DEPARTMENT OF STATE FUNDS.
- 6. MEMBERS OF THE ADVANCE TEAM MAY ACCOMPANY THE PRE-ADVANCE AND REMAIN FOR THE ACTUAL VISIT. THEY WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DEVELOPING THE SCHEDULE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT AND FOR HIS DIRECT SUPPORT DURING THE ACTUAL VISIT. THE FOLLOWING ARE THE KEY MEMBERS OF THE ADVANCE TEAM:

LEAD ADVANCE—REPRESENTS THE WHITE HOUSE ADVANCE OFFICE AND IS THE LEADER OF THE ADVANCE TEAM. THE LEAD ADVANCE COURDINATES THE WORK OF UTHER TEAM MEMBERS AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VICE PRESIDENT'S SCHEDULE AND ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE VISIT. THE LEAD ADVANCE WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH THE MISSION'S CONTROL OFFICER AND THE HOST GOVERNMENT. CONTROL OFFICER SHOULD BE PREPARED TO BRIEF THE LEAD ADVANCE ON ALL ASPECTS OF THE VISIT ON ARRIVAL AND BE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST ON A TWENTY-FOUR HOUR BASIS THROUGHOUT THE VISIT.

VICE PRESIDENT'S AD; VANCE--WORKS CLOSELY WITH THE OTHER ADVANCE TEAMS AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ARRANGING ALL ASPECTS INCLUDING PRESS COVERAGE OF ALL EVENTS. WORKS CLOSELY WITH ICA AND WITH THE APPROPRIATE MINISTRY OR MINISTRIES OF THE HOST GOVERNMENT, USUALLY THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION OR ITS EQUIVALENT. USICA IS RELIED UPON HEAVILY FOR SUPPORT OF ALL BASIC PRESS REQUIREMENTS. ICA PERSONNEL SHOULD CONSULT ICA MANUAL "POST SUPPORT FOR PRESIDENTIAL VISITS" FOR DETAILS. USICA WILL BE TASKED WITH OPGANIZING AND MANNING THE PRESS CENTER, AND PROVIDING LOGISTICAL SUPPORT FOR WHITE HOUSE PRESS AND THE WHITE HOUSE PRESS UFFICE. USICA WILL ALSO DEVELOP A PRESS INFORMATION KIT, WITH BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON SITES AND PERSONALITIES, AND PROVIDE FOR SUPPORT OF THE LOCAL PRESS, TO THE EXTENT THAT THEIR

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SFCRET SERVICE AGENT-IN-CHARGE--ADVISES THE LEAD ADVANCE ON SECURITY AND IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A TEAM OF AGENTS WHO WILL HAVE TOTAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SECURITY OF THE VICE PRESIDENT AND HIS FAMILY AS LONG AS HE IS AT THEIR LOCATION. SOME MEMBERS OF THE SECRET SERVICE TEAM ARRIVE WITH THE SECRET SERVICE AGENT-IN-CHARGE; OTHERS ARRIVE LATER. AGENTS ARE ASSIGNED TO EVERY SITE, AND MONITOR EVERY ACTIVITY, AS WELL AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MOTORCADE. THEY NATURALLY WORK CLOSELY WITH THE POST SECURITY OFFICER AND LOCAL SECURITY ORAGANIZATIONS.

WHITE HOUSE COMMUNICATIONS AGENCY (WHCA)—RESPONSIBLE FOR VALIDATING AND ESTABLISHING ALL DEFICIAL COMMUNICATIONS IN SUPPORT OF THE VICE PRESIDENT, WHITE HOUSE STAFF, AND USSS. THE WHCA TRIP OFFICER AND A TEAM OF TECHNICIANS WILL ESTABLISH THE COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM. THEY WILL COORDINATE DIRECTLY WITH POST FOR FREQUENCY AND TECHNICAL COMMUNICATIONS MATTERS AND WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH POST CRO AND WITH THE LOCAL TELEPHONE/TELEGRAPH COMPANY.

STATE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE ADVANCE--ASSISTS THE LEAD ADVANCE ON SUPPORT QUESTIONS, CHORDINATES EMBASSY INTERACTION WITH THE ADVANCE TEAM AS A WHOLE, AND OFTEN FUNCTIONS AS AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR THE LEAD ADVANCE WORKING CLOSELY WITH EACH MEMBER OF THE ADVANCE TEAM ON THEIR REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCOMMODATIONS, TRANSPORTATION AND OTHER SUPPORT. EMBASSY SHOUL; D REFER ANY QUESTIONS ON ADMINISTRATION AND FUNDING TO THIS OFFICER.

- 7. THE ADVANCE TEAM WILL RELY BUTH ON POST AND WHCA CAPABILITIES IN COMMUNICATIONS WITH WASHINGTON. POST CRO SHOULD WORK CLOSELY WITH WHCA AND THE STATE ADMIN ADVANCE TO ENSURE EFFECTIVE SUPPURT AND APPROPRIATE DISTRIBUTION OF INCOMING MESSAGES TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE ADVANCE TEAM. ALL INCOMING TRAFFIC ON THE VISIT WILL RE COORDINATED WITH THE LEAD ADVANCE FOR APPROPRIATE DISTRIBUTION.
- P. ALL DUTGUING EMBASSY CABLES ON THE VISIT SHOULD BE CLEARED WITH THE LEAD ADVANCE AND SUCH OTHER MEMBERS OF THE ADVANCE TEAM AS HE MAY INDICATE. THERE MAY, OF

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COURSE, BE SUBSTANTIVE MATTERS SO SENSITIVE THAT THEY MUST BE RESTRICTED TO DIRECT COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE AMBASSADUR AND THE SECRETARY OR THE VICE PRESIDENT. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THIS WOULD BE RARE, AND THAT EVEN IN SUCH CASES THE CHARGE' WOULD KEEP THE LEAD ADVANCE AS FULLY BRIEFED AS NATIONAL SECURITY CONSIDERATIONS WILL ALLOW ON ALL TRAFFIC.

- 9. THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES ARE PROVIDED TO FACILITATE ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT FOR PRE-ADVANCE, ADVANCE AND THE ACTUAL VISIT. SPECIFIC DETAILS AND REQUIREMENTS WILL BE PROVIDED AS THE TRIP DEVELOPS. NOTE THAT THE GUIDELINES APPLY TO ALL PHASES OF THE VISIT UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED.
- --A. ALL U.S. GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL AND AVAILABLE RESOURCES ARE TO BE USED IN SUPPORT OF THE TRIP.
- --B. TRANSPORATION EVERY EFFORT SHOULD BE MADE TO DBTAIN VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO ADEQUATELY SUPPORT THE VISIT FROM USG OR HOST GOVERNMENT SOURCES. RENTALS MUST BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM. THE NUMBER OF ASSIGNED VEHICLES WILL BE HELD TO A MINIMUM, MAKING MAXIMUM USE OF POOL VEHICLES.
- --1. PRE-ADVANCE TEAM BUSES SHOULD BE USED FOR PRE-ADVANCE PARTY TO AND FROM AJRPORT AND AS PRACTICAL, i.e. FOR SURVEYS OF EVENT SITES.
- --2. ADVANCE TEAMS AND ACTUAL VISIT -- BUSES SHOULD BE USED TO MOVE SUPPORT PARTY TO AND FROM AIRPORT AND AS PRACTICAL DURING THE VISIT. AN AMERICAN SHOULD BE ON THE BUS, PARTICULARLY ON ARRIVAL. THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR TRAVELING WITH THE PRE-ADVANCE WILL BE ABLE TO ADVISE AND ANSWER SPECIFIC QUESTIONS REGARDING TRANSPORTATION.
- --C. HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS THE FOLLOWING IS PROVIDED FOR THE EMBASSY'S GUIDANCE AT THIS TIME AND MAY BE USED FOR DISCUSSIONS WITH HOST GOVERNMENT AND HOTEL OFFICIALS. FINAL ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE BY THE LEAD ADVANCE AFTER HIS ARRIVAL.
- --PLEASE MAKE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR PRE-ADVANCE TEAM AND ΔDVANCE TEAM AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ΔCCOMMODATIONS TO BE USED DURING THE ACTUAL VISIT.

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- D. EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH TRIP -
- 1. TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES ALL RENTAL CHARGES FOR VEHICLES FOR COMMON USE BY MEMBERS OF PRE-ADVANCE, ADVANCE AND ACTUAL VISIT WILL BE PAID BY POST AND CHARGED TO POST ALLOTMENT. VEHICLES FOR EXCLUSIVE USE OF USSS, WHCA, AIR FORCE ADVANCE, MARINE ONE ADVANCE AND PRESS WILL BE PAID BY THOSE ORGANIZATIONS. SPECIFIC BILLING INSTRUCTIONS ARE EXPLAINED BELOW PARA F.
- POST SHOULD PAY HOTEL ROOM COSTS FOR EACH PHASE ON PURCHASE ORDER ON CONTRACT BASIS FOR WHITE HOUSE STAFF, (INCLUDING WHITE HOUSE PRESS STAFF, BUT NOT PRESS;, NSC STAFF, USSS, WHCA, STATE (INCLUDING TDY OC PERSONNEL, SCO'S AND CED'S,, ICA, AIR FORCE ADVANCE OFFICERS (NOT AIR FORCE CREWS) DOTHER U.S. MILITARY. THESE BASIC ROOM COSTS WILL BE CHARGED BACK TO AGENCY FUNDING THE TRAVEL.
- 3. COMMUNICATION EXPENSES 
  A. WHITE HOUSE COMMUNICATIONS AGENCY (WHCA) WHCA IS ONLY RESPONSIBLE FOR COMMUNICATIONS EXPENSES WHICH RESULT FROM SERVICES ORDERED AND INSTALLED SPECIFICALLY IN SUPPORT OF THE VICE PRESIDENT, WHITE HOUSE STAFF, USSS, AND UTHERS AS DIRECTED. THESE SERVICES DO NOT INCLUDE THUSE URDERED FOR USE BY OTHER AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS (STATE, ICA, UPI, AP, TELEX, TELEVISION NETWORKS, NEWSPAPER REPORTERS, OR ANY OTHER NEWS RELATED COMPANIES;. THE WHCA TRIP OFFICERS WILL COORDINATE ALL REQUIREMENTS WITH PUST CRO AND LOCAL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANIES.
- 4. POST EXPENSES POST IS RESPONSIBLE FOR FUNDING ALL OVERTIME (AMERICAN AND NATIONAL EMPLOYEES), SUPPLIES, PRINTING, RENTAL CHARGES FOR OFFICES AND TRANSPORTATION, ETC. INCIDENTIAL TO VISIT THAT CANNOT SPECIFICALLY BE IDENTIFIED AS A SEPARATE AGENCY EXPENSE.

THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OR BUDGET AND FISCAL OFFICER SHOULD REVIEW ALL QUESTIONS CONCERNING ANY EXPENSE WITH STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR DURING PRE-ADVANCE AND ACTUAL PHASES OF VISIT.

5. OTHER EXPENSES - NO INDIVIDUAL OTHER THAN THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR ACCUMPANYING THE PRE-ADVANCE

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AND ACTUAL VISIT HAS ANY AUTHORITY TO CHARGE OR OBLIGATE STATE DEPARTMENT FUNDS IN SUPPORT OF THE VISIT. HE MUST APPROVE ALL SUCH EXPENDITURES IN ADVANCE. THEREFORE, ANY CATEGORIES OF EXPENSES NOT MENTIONED OR EXPLAINED ABOVE MUST BE DISCUSSED WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR.

#### F. BILLING INSTRUCTIONS

- PERSONS ARRIVING WITH THE ADVANCE TEAM AND ON THE ACTUAL VISIT FUR WHOM POST PAYS BASIC ROOM CUSTS PER ITEM D.2 ABOVE WILL BE TRAVELING ON GOVERNMENT ORDERS AND RECEIVING 50 PER DIEM. HOTEL(S) SHOULD THUS BE INSTRUCTED TO PREPARE TWO SEPARATE BILLS FOR THESE PERSONNEL AS FOLLOWS: (1) BASIC ROOM COSTS INCLUDING TAX TO BE PAID BY POST (2) PERSONAL EXPENSES MEALS, ROOM SERVICE, LAUNDRY, TELEPHONE CALLS, ETC; WHICH WILL BE PAID BY INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS OF PARTY PRIOR TO DEPARTURE. COPIES OF TRAVEL ORDERS AND FISCAL DATA TO COVER THE COST OF ROOMS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR DURING VISIT.
- 2. OFFICES, RENTAL OF VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES AND OTHER SERVICES FOR USSS, WHOA AND MILITARY PERSONNEL (I.E. AIR FORCE AND MARINE PERSONNEL) ARE TO BE PAID BY POST AND CHARGED BACK TO AGENCY FUNDING THE TRAVEL. APPROPRIATE FISCAL DATA WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR DURING VISIT.
- 3. TO INSURE THAT WHCA AND MOST HOST COUNTRY SUPPLIERS ARE IN AGREEMENT AS TO COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES ORDERED, THE WHCA TRIP OFFICER WILL PREPARE AN ITEMIZATION OF SERVICES ORDERED (WHCA FORM 67) WHICH WILL BE VERIFIED AS CORRECT BY BOTH PARTIES ON COMPLETION OF THE VISIT AND PRIOR TO DEPARTURE OF THE TRIP OFFICER. WE BELIEVE THAT A CAUTIONARY APPROACH TOWARD ECONOMIC RELATIONS WITH THE USSR REMAINS WARRANTED. MESSAGE COUNTINUEDET

SINCE THE SOVIET INVASION OF AFGHANISTAN. IFLTHE SOVIETS HOVE INTO POLAND, HE HOULD MAKE FURTHER CUTS AND MOULD STRONGLY FAVOR SIMILAR ACTION BY THE ALLIES.

TOLLOWING ARE OUR COMMENTS ON SPECIFIC POINTS RAISED IN THE BRITISH CABLE REGARDING EXCHANGES WITH THE USER'S

ACTIVITY UNDER CULTURAL AGREEMENTS

AT PRESENT THERE IS NO CULTURAL AGREEMENT SETWEEN THE U.S. AND THE USSR. THE LAST AGREEMENT LASSED ATTTHE END OF 1979. AND WE INFORMED MOSCOW THAT, SECAUSE OF THE SOVIET INVASION OF AFGHANISTAN, WE WOULD NOT NEGOTIATE A NEW ONE. CURRENTLY, ONLY ONE OFFICIAL CULTURAL EXCHANGE IS TAKING PLACE -- THE DISTRIBUTION OF AMERICA ILLUSTRATED IN THE SOVIET UNION AND OFFICIAL TO US THAN TO THE SOVIET WE WOULD SE LIKELY TO CONTINUE IT DESPITE A SOVIET MOVE INTO POLAND.

OFFICIALLY SUPPORTED ACADEMIC EXCHANGES ARE CONTINUING TO TAKE PLACE, CURRENTLY THERE ARE 30 SCHOLARS IN EACH COUNTRY FOR THE SEST OF THE YEAR POR ABOUT DS SCHOLARS TO SPEND BRIEFER SESTODS IN EACH COUNTRY. WE WOULD SE LIKELY TO MAKE SOME CUTS HERE, ALTHOUGH WE AGREE WITH THE BRITISH THAT WE SHOULD AVDIO SUSPENSION OF PROGRAMS WHICH WOULD DISRUFT SHOULD AVDIO SUSPENSION OF PROGRAMS WHICH WOULD DISRUFT EXCHANGES GIVE US UNIQUE ACCESS TO SOVIET SOCIETY AND EXCHANGES AT TRAINING MECHANISH FOR SPECIALISTS ON THE USER. IN ANY EVENT, BUDGETARY CUTS COULD LIMIT USG FINANCED

MAJOR GULTURAL EVENTS

THERE MAVE BEEN NO OFFICIALLY OR PRIVATELY SPONSORED CULTURAL EVENTS IN EITHER COUNTRY SINGE THE INVASION OF AFGHANTSTAN, WE ARE NOT AWARE OF PLANS FOR ANY SUCH EVENTS IN 1986. IN THE EVENT OF SOVIET INTERVENTION IN POLAND, WE WOULD MOPE THAT, AS THE U.K. PAPER SUGGESTS, OTHER GOVERNMENTS WOULD ALSO MAKE CLEAR THAT EVEN PRIVATELY ORGANIZED CULTURAL EVENTS WERE INAPPROPRIATE.

MESSAGE TRONT INUEDS &

NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES AND THE BOVIET ACADEMY OF SCIENCES -- IS IN LARGE PART OFFICIALLY FUNDED. WE WOULD EXPECT TO REDUCE ACTIVITIES UNDER THIS AGREEMENT. FOR EXCHANGES THAT ARE WHOLLY PRIVATE WE WOULD, IF CONSULTED. SUGGEST THAT AN INTERVENTION IN POLAND MADE MANY COOPERATIVE ACTIVITIES WITH THE SOVIETS INAPPROPRIATE. AS THE SRITISH INDICATE, PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS WOULD BE LIKELY TO AGREE WITH THIS POSITION.

OTHER ORGANIZATIONS

THERE ARE NO USG-SPONSORED PRIENDSHIP SOCIETIES OR SIMILAR ORGANIZATIONS AGAIN, IF CONSULTED BY PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS WE WOULD NOTE THE INAPPROPRIATENESS OF MANY EXCHANGES FOLLOWING A SOVIET MOVE INTO POLAND.

SPORTING EXCHANGES \*\*

THERE ARE NO SPORTING EVENTS INVOLVING THE USER PLANNED FOR 1981 WHICH WOULD HAVE USE SUPPORT. HERE TOO, DEPENDING ON THE CIRCUMSTANCES, HE MIGHT TRY TO DISSUAGE PRIVATE GROUPS FROM EITHER INVITING SOVIET COMPETITORS TO THE USE, OR SENDING USE, TEXAS TO THE USER.

OFFICE AL BECENTIFER AND TECHNICAL EXCHANGES
