MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

OF OUR COUNTRIES, AS WELL AS THE PEOPLE OF THE USA AND AGAINST HUMAN RIGHTS: –

- 1. AIMING AT OUR CIVILIZATION, EXISTANCE AND WEALTH, THE REAGAN GOVERNMENT HAS GONE MAD, AND HAS COMPLETELY BECOME TYRANT AND AGGRESSIVE AND IN RESULT THEREFORE HAS SET FREE ITS CIA AGENTS TO OPERATE AS USUAL A DANGEROUS PLAN TO INFILTRATE THE ARABS AND THIRD WORLD LANDS IN ORDER TO CREATE CHAOS AND ALL POSSIBLE DISTURBANCES AMONGST THE PEOPLE.
- 2. THE IMPERIALISTREAGAN ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN AND IS, IN AGREEMENT WITH CERTAIN TRAITORS WHO HAPPEN TO BE THE RULING PARTIES, BUT AGAINST THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE, TAKING FULL PART IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS AS WELL AS THE EXTERNAL AFFAIRS OF THESE COUNTRIES THROUGH CIA AGENTS, IN ORDER

5. TEL FROM THE U.S. PERSPECTIVE, THE MEETING WITH ASSISTANT SECRETARY ENDERS SHAPES UP AS A SPECIAL OPPOR-TUNITY. THE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE IS ABOUT TO UNDER-TAKE A REVIEW OF BRITISH POLICIES IN THE CARIBBEAN AND CENTRAL AMERICA WHICH UNDOUBTEDLY WILL ZERO IN ON THE EXTENT OF U.S./UK COOPERATION, WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON BELIZE AND EL SALVADOR. THE UK HAS ANNOUNCED PLANS TO ACQUIRE THE TRIDENT MISSILE SYSTEM AS THE MODERNIZATION FOR OUR POLARIS FLEET. THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENSE HAS MADE IT CLEAR TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS STILL STUDYING THE FINAL CONFIGURATION OF THE UNITED KINGDOM TRIDENT FORCE INCLUDING THE CHOICE OF MISSILE.
