- 2. KING HUSSEIN ASKED THAT I RETURN TO HIS LONDON RESIDENCE LATE THIS AFTERNOON FOR A FOLLOW-ON CONVERSATION TO OUR MEETING THIS MORNING WITH PHIL HABIB. GENERAL BIN SHAKER WAS ALSO PRESENT.
- 3. THE KING MADE TWO PRINCIPAL POINTS:
- (A) ALTHOUGH HE HAD NOT RAISED THE ISSUE TODAY WITH HABIB, NOTHING HE HEARD FROM PHIL THIS MORNING HAD DIMINISHED HIS CONVICTION OF THE IMPERATIVE NEED FOR THE U.S. TO LINK RESOLUTION OF THE LEBANESE PROBLEM (NOT RPT NOT THE BEIRUT PROBLEM) WITH A NEW COMPREHENSIVE PEACE INITIATIVE. IN THIS RESPECT, HE SAID, HIS POSITION AND MUBARAK'S ARE IDENTICAL.
- (B) JORDAN IS NEXT ON THE ISRAELI HIT LIST. HIS DECISION TO GRANT ASYLUM TO A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF PLO COMBATANTS IMMEDIATELY INCREASES JORDAN'S INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL SECURITY PROBLEMS. HE WOULD "PAY DEARLY FOR THIS DECISION." THIS MADE IT ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

THAT THE U.S. BE RESPONSIVE TO JORDAN'S SECURITY REQUIREMENTS WHICH GENERAL BIN SHAKER WILL BE DISCUSSING LATER THIS WEEK. JORDAN IS FACING A "NEW BALL GAME" AND IT IS INADEQUATELY PREPARED FOR THE CHALLENGE. THE U.S. MUST HELP. IF WE DO NOT, "YDU CAN KISS GOODBY TO YOUR OLDEST FRIEND AND ALLY IN THE MIODLE EAST."

1. SECRET - ENTIRE TEXT.

2. SUMMARY: KING HUSSEIN TOLD ME JULY 26 THAT JORDAN WOULD TAKE ANY PLO FIGHTERS FROM WEST BEIRUT WHICH HAVE JORDANIAN NATIONALITY, INCLUDING THE KARAMAEH BRIGADE. HE ESTIMATED THIS WOULD INCLUDE 3,888 POTENTIAL RETURNEES. HOWEVER, HE STRESSED THAT THOSE PEOPLE UNDER CRIMINAL CHARGES MUST FACE THIS RESPONSIBILITY IF THEY RETURN TO JORDAN THE KING

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

AGREED TO CONSIDER SENDING A FEW JORDANIAN OFFICIALS
TO WEST BEIRUT TO SCREEN RETURNEES IF NECESSARY AND IF
A REAL CEASE-FIRE IS ESTABLISHED. HE AGREED THAT RETURNEES
COULD TRAVEL OVERLAND FROM BEIRUT TO JORDAN UNIMPEDED
VIA SYRIA. THE KING ALSO SAID THE IRAQIS HAD TOLD HIM
THAT THEY WOULD ACCEPT THE ARAB LIBERATION FRONT (ALF)
UNIT SO LONG AS IT DID NOT REMAIN MORE THAN 24 HOURS
IN DAMASCUS. END SUMMARY

3. I MET FOR ALMOST AN HOUR WITH HUSSEIN AND CINC BIN SHAKER MORNING JULY 26 AT HIS LONDON RESIDENCE. I WAS ACCOMPANIED BY DRAPER, VIETS AND EMBASSY NOTETAKER. I BEGAN WITH A DETAILED REVIEW OF THE NEEOTIATING PROCESS INCLUDING THE KHADDAM/SAUD TALKS IN WASHINGTON, AND MY SUBSEQUENT DISCUSSIONS WITH SARKIS, ASSAD, FAHD AND MUBARAK. I STRESSED ELEMENTS IN THESE CONVERSATIONS WHICH

UNDERLINED THE NECESSITY FOR THE ARAB STATES TO TAKE THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES IN RESOLVING THE WEST BEIRUT PROBLEM AND FINDING DESTINATIONS FOR THE PLO. I DID NOT HIDE THE FACT THAT MUBARAK HAD MADE CLEAR THAT, BEFORE COMMITTING HIMSELF TO RECEIVE A SPECIFIC NUMBER OF COMBATANTS, HE WANTED REASSURANCE THAT THERE WOULD BE MOVEMENT TOWARD A COMPREHENSIVE PEACE SETTLEMENT. TO THAT END, HE HAD INFORMED ME THAT HE WOULD BE SENDING ALI TO WASHINGTON THIS WEEK TO PRESS FOR SUCH LINKAGE.

- 4. HUSSEIN AND BIN SHAKER LISTENED ATTENTIVELY TO MY PRESENTATION, INTERRUPTING ONLY ONCE TO ASK WHETHER THE U. S. HAD AN ISRAELI COMMITMENT TO WITHDRAW TOTALLY FROM LEBANON. I REITERATED THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT TO KHADDAM AND SAUD THAT U. S. POLICY UNEQUIVOCALLY SUPPORTS THE COMPLETE ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL FROM LEBANON.
- S. CONCLUDING THAT HIS DECISION WOULD STRONGLY INFLUENCE THE EGYPTIANS AND OTHER ARAB LEADERS, I ASKED HUSSEIN WHETHER WE COULD COUNT ON HIM TO HELP US AT THIS CRUCIAL JUNCTURE. HE REPLIED, "I WILL TAKE ANYONE WHO IS MY RESPONSIBILITY. JORDAN WILL NOT DENY ACCEPTING THE RETURN OF ITS NATIONALS." HUSSEIN SAID HIS DECISION TO ACCEPT PLO COMBATANTS WITH JORDANIAN NATIONALITY INCLUDED THE KARAMEH BRIGADE. HUDDLING WITH BIN SHAKER, HE ESTIMATED THAT TOTAL NUMBER OF POTENTIAL RETURNEES TO JORDAN WOULD AMOUNT TO 3,000 COMBATANTS. HOWEVER, THE KING AND BIN SHAKER REPEATEDLY COMMENTED THAT SOME OF THESE RETURNEES

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

WILL FACE CHARGES FOR CRIMINAL ACTS THEY COMMITTED PREVIOUSLY IN JORDAN.

- 6. HUSSEIN CONTINUED THAT HE WOULD CONSIDER SENDING A FEW JORDANIAN OFFICIALS TO BEIRUT TO SCREEN RETURNEES IF NECESSARY AND IF A REAL CEASEFIRE IS ESTABLISHED. I ASKED HOW RETURNEES SHOULD PROCEED TO JORDAN. HE REPLIED FIRMLY, "BY LAND, DIRECT AND UNIMPEDED THROUGH SYRIA."
- 7. THE KING ALSO TOLD ME THAT HE HAD OBTAINED AN IRAQI COMMITMENT TO ACCEPT THE ALF BATTALION SO LONG AS THIS UNIT DOES NOT REMAIN MORE THAN 24 HOURS IN DAMASCUS DURING TRANSIT.
- 8. I CONCLUDED BY THANKING THE KING FOR HIS READINESS TO ASSIST US AND URGING HIM TO WORK WITH OTHER ARAB LEADERS TO ENSURE THAT THEY DO THEIR SHARE TO ACCEPT PALESTINIANS FROM BEIRUT. HIS OWN FINAL REMARK, HOWEVER, WAS MORE SOBERING AND REVEALING OF HIS PRESENT STATE OF MIND IN COPING WITH THE ISRAEL! INVASION: "WE KNOW WE ARE THE NEXT TARGET IN JORDAN."

- 2. I WANTED YOU TO KNOW HOW GRATIFIED I HAVE BEEN WITH THE DECISIVE AND STATESMANLIKE ATTITUDE DISPLAYED BY KING HUSSEIN OF JORDAN THIS MORNING, JULY 26, WHEN I ASKED HIM FOR ASSURANCES THAT JORDAN WOULD ACCEPT A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF PALESTINIAN COMBATANTS WE HAVE BEEN TRYING TO EVACUATE FROM BEIRUT. I PRESENTED THE FACTS TO HIM AND DESCRIBED OUR DILEMMA. WHEN I OUTLINED TO HIM THE CONCEPT THAT ARAB COUNTRIES SHOULD SHARE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR DEALING WITH THE BEIRUT PROBLEM, HE AGREED COMPLETELY. HE SAID THAT JORDAN WOULD ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY OF TAKING BACK THE PALESTINIAN COMBATANTS WHO HAD CONNECTIONS WITH JORDAN BY VIRTUE OF THEIR ORIGIN OR THEIR CITIZENSHIP. "THIS WILL BE OUR RESPONSIBILITY", HE SAID. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

JORDAN WILL NECESSARILY TAKE ALL THE PERHAPS 3,000 PALESTINIAN COMBATANTS WITH JORDANIAN CONNECTIONS, SINCE SOME WILL NOT WANT TO RISK PROSECUTION FOR CRIMES THEY HAVE COMMITTED IN JORDAN. HOWEVER, THE KING'S READINESS TO TAKE A SUBSTANTIAL PROPORTION COULD ASSIST US GREATLY IN OUR SEARCH FOR COUNTRIES TO ACCEPT THE PALESTINIANS.

- 3. KING HUSSEIN ALSO VOLUNTEERED THAT HE HAD BEEN IN TOUCH WITH THE IRAQI LEADERSHIP, AND THE LATTER HAD AGREED TO ACCEPT PALESTINIANS FROM UNITS WHICH HAD BEEN FORMED ORIGINALLY IN IRAQ.

- 4. HE CLAIMED THAT IF JBL DOES NOT SHIP THE TURBINES THE FIRM WILL SUFFER DAMAGES AS FOLLOWS: 6.4 MILLION POUNDS IN FORFEITURE OF PERFORMANCE BONDS, 184 MILLION POUNDS IN CANCELLED CONTRACTS, 27 MILLION POUNDS IN DTHER DAMAGE CLAIMS, AND 5 MILLION POUNDS IN LEGAL FEES. LOSSES WOULD TOTAL 137 MILLION POUNDS; JOHN BROWN ENGINEERING WOULD BE INSOLVENT; 1700 WORKERS WOULD LOSE THEIR JOBS. MAYHEW-SANDERS SAID HE WAS FAMILIAR WITH EXCHANGE OF CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN PRESIDENT AND PRIME MINISTER AND HAD, IN FACT, SUPPLIED DATA ON POTENTIAL JOB LOSSES AND ECONOMIC IMPACT TO PM'S OFFICE.  TO THE PRESIDENT WITH ASSURANCES, WHICH WERE LESS
 THAN THOSE HE HAD GIVEN ME ORALLY. I DID NOT REPEAT NOT
 SHOW THEM THE LETTER. I DID DESCRIBE IN SOME DETAIL
 MY TWO TALKS WITH PRESIDENT ZIA AND THAT WITH FOREIGN
 MINISTER YAQUB KHAN AND THE IMPRESSIONS I DERIVED THEREFROM. I SAID THAT I HAD PROTECTED THE UK COMPLETELY
 AS TO SOURCES OF OUR INFORMATION.
- 3. THE BRITISH ASKED WHAT WE WOULD DO NOW. I SAID THAT MY RECOMMENDATION WOULD BE THAT WE ACCEPT FOR A SHORT PERIOD THE ASSURANCES WHILE MONITORING ALL

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

SOURCES TO SEE WHETHER THEY ACTUALLY SHUT OFF FURTHER PURCHASE ATTEMPTS OR; ON THE OTHER HAND, TOOK DELIVERY OF OR MADE FURTHER ATTEMPTS TO SECURE COMPONENTS. WITHIN A VERY FEW SEEKS, INDICATORS SHOULD APPEAR THAT WOULD ENABLE US TO MAKE A FINAL DECISION. WE SHOULD HAVE INFORMATION WITHIN A MONTH.

4. I SAID PAKISTAN WAS IMPORTANT TO US BECAUSE OF AFGHANISTAN AND IRAN. WE HAD LABORIOUSLY WORKED OUT A LARGE AID PROGRAM FOR PAKISTAN, WHICH WE HOPED TO IMPLEMENT. PREMATURE DISCLOSURE OF THE NEW INFORMATION ON PAKISTAN'S EXPLOSIVES PROGRAM OR THAT THEY HAD YIELDED TO OUR PRESSURE AND STOPPED IT COULD WELL LEAD TO ZIA'S OVERTHROW AND SUBSEQUENT CONFUSION IN PAKISTAN. PERSONALLY I HOPED THEY WOULD NOT AT THIS TIME GO FORWARD WITH THEIR IDEA OF DISCLOSING THIS INFORMATION TO 15

INTELLIGENCE SERVICES. THEY ASSURED ME THAT THEY WOULD NOT UNTIL THEY GOT A GREEN LIGHT FROM US AND WOULD PUT FURTHER DISCLOSURE BY THEM ON HOLD. I SAID THAT I EXPECTED THAT WE WOULD VERY QUICKLY AFTER MY RETURN TO WASHINGTON MAKE OUR DECISION ON WHEN AND TO WHOM IN CONGRESS TO REPORT THIS, IN ACCORD WITH OUR LAW, AND WOULD THEN BE BACK TO THEM.

- 5. I CONCLUDED BY SAYING THAT ZIA HAD ALSO GIVEN US ADDITIONAL ASSURANCES ON SAFEGUARDS DESIRED BY THE IAEA AND THAT I HAD EXPLAINED TO HIM UNMISTAKABLY OUR POSITION ON REPROCESSING.
- 6. I MENTIONED THAT THE PAKISTANI'S BELIEVED THAT THIS MIGHT WELL BE THE RESULT OF AN INDIAN DECEPTION OPERATION, AND I ASKED THE BRITISH TO CHECK ON THIS. WE DID NOT BELIEVE IT WAS TRUE, BUT IT SHOULD BE CHECKED SINCE THE INDIANS KNEW WHO ALL OF THE COMPONENT SUPPLIERS WERE. HURD SAID HE DID NOT BELIEVE THAT THE INDIANS WERE CAPABLE OF SUCH A DECEPTION OPERATION, BUT THEY WOULD VERY DISCREETLY CHECK IT OUT.
- 7. THE BRITISH ASKED ABOUT MY RECENT TRIP TO LUANDA AND OTHER AFRICAN CAPITALS, AND I BRIEFED THEM, AS I HAD THEIR AMBASSADORS IN LUSAKA AND LUANDA.
- 8. HURD AND HIS COLLEAGUES SEEMED PLEASED AND SATISFIED WITH WHAT I TOLD THEM.

- 2. THATCHER IS TRIUMPHANT AND REVELLING IN VICTORY. PUBLIC SUPPORT FOR HER LEADERSHIP IS FIRM AND OVERWHELM-ING. THE SHOCK OF THE EARLY WAR LOSSES HAS LONG SINCE WORN OFF. THE PUBLIC, RECONCILED TO CASUALTIES, CREDITS HER BOLDNESS THAT THEY WERE NOT GREATER. CRITICS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE TORY PARTY ARE AT BAY. PARLIAMENT, EVEN THE OPPOSITION, IS PAYING TRIBUTE.
- 3. SHE KNOWS, HOWEVER, THAT LETDOWN WILL FOLLOW EUPHORIA, AND THAT TO CONSOLIDATE HER POLITICAL BASE SHE MUST SECURE PEACE. SHE WANTS, ABOVE ALL, TO BE PRIME MINISTER FOR A A FULL TEN YEARS, AND SHE KNOWS, DESPITE HER PATRIOTIC MYOPIA, THAT PROTRACTED CONFLICT IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC SOONER OR LATER WILL UNDERCUT HER.
- 4. YET THE CURRENT AIM OF BRITISH POLICY IS TO HOLD THE FALKLANDS FOR BRITAIN. THATCHER AND HER CLOSEST ADVISERS HAVE ARGUED THAT IT IS WRONG TO CONTEMPLATE ANY ARGENTINE PARTICIPATION IN THE FUTURE OF THE ISLANDS: RECENT OFFI-

CIAL STATEMENTS HAVE HARDENED PUBLIC OPINION ON THIS THEME. BRITISH CASUALTIES ARE CITED, AND THE COSTS OF WAR ARE SAID TO DICTATE THE TERMS OF PEACE. ON THE ISSUE OF KEEPING THE FALKLANDS BRITISH, THATCHER IS CONFIDENT SHE CAN DEFEAT ANY DISSENTERS: BUOYED BY MILITARY SUCCESS AND OUTRAGED AT ARGENTINE AGGRESSION, SHE IS OPTIMISTIC THAT THE POLITICAL AND ILITARY COSTS OF RESTORED BRITISH RULE CAN BE KEPT IN BOUNDS.

5. FOR ALL HER RHETORIC, THATCHER, WE BELIEVE, WILL NOT BE INFLEXIBLE -- PARTICULARLY ON TACTICS. BUT SHE WILL BE SWAYED LESS BY ADVICE THAN BY EXPERIENCE AND HER SENSE OF THE POSSIBLE. JUST AS RETAKING THE ISLANDS HAS LED HER NARROWLY TO WANT TO HOLD THEM, THE EXPERIENCE OF KEEPING THEM WILL SHAPE HER LATER POLICY.

- 6. THE IMMEDIATE BRITISH OBJECTIVE WILL BE TO LEAD ARGENTINA TO ACCEPT THAT HOSTILITIES ARE OVER. RECENT IDEAS INCLUDE:
- -- OFFERING TO NEGOTIATE A NON-USE-OF-FORCE PLEDGE, WHICH ARGENTINA WOULD LIKELY TURN DOWN, BUT WITH DETRIMENT TO ITS INTERNATIONAL SUPPORT; AND
- -- DELAYING PRISONER RETURN PENDING ARGENTINE AFFIRMATION THAT IT WILL END HOSTILITIES, THOUGH THIS OF COURSE COULD BACKFIRE ON BRITAIN.

THESE IDEAS MAY BE DROPPED AS BRITAIN SEEKS TO HANDLE THE SURRENDER WITH SOME GENEROSITY, IN WAYS IT HOPES WILL HELP MAKE THE ARMISTICE STICK.

- 7. MEANWHILE, IN THE MEDIUM TERM, BRITAIN ALSO WILL SEEK TO FORCE ARGENTINA TO ACCOMMODATE TO BRITISH VICTORY THROUGH:
- -- SUBSTANTIAL GARRISONING OF THE ISLANDS: AND -- WINNING ALLIED BACKING (INCLUDING SANCTIONS, IF NECESSARY) AND LATIN AMERICAN SUPPORT FOR SELF-GOVERNING FALKLANDS, WITH FEWER COLONIAL TRAPPINGS. OFFICALS HERE SEEM CONFIDENT THAT THEY CAN AFFORD A PERIOD OF ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL CONSOLIDATION, INCLUDING CONSULTATIONS WITH THE FALKLANDERS; THAT THE COSTS OF A BRITISH GARRISON ARE SUSTAINABLE: AND THAT RELATIONS WITH THE LATIN AMERICANS WILL IMPROVE AS THEY BECOME BORED WITH AN ARGENTINA THAT WILL BE INCREASINGLY ISOLATED IF IT REMAINS RECALCITRANT.

5. IF. ON THE OTHER HAND, ARGENTINA DIGS IN FOR A CRUSADE, THATCHER'S OPTIONS SHIFT. AS ARGENTINA LASHES OUT MILITARILY, THATCHER WILL STRIKE BACK.

10 U.S. AIMS PARALLEL THOSE OF E-ITAIN IN SEEKING A DEFINITIVE END TO HOSTILITIES. BUT BEYOND THAT WE MAY DIERGE. IT IS ALREADY CLEAR FROM PHIL HABIB'S TALKS IN ISRAEL THAT THE ISRAELIS ARE PREPARED TO DEAL WITH WHATEVER PRESSURES MIGHT BE BROUGHT TO BEAR UPON THEM IN THE DAYS AND WEEKS AHEAD AS WE TRY TO BRING ABOUT THEIR WITHDRAWAL. THE ISRAELIS APPEAR FULLY DETERMINED TO SET UP A BUFFER ZONE IN LEBANON WIDE ENOUGH TO ASSURE THAT HOSTILE ARTILLERY OR ROCKETS CANNOT REACH ISRAEL. WHILE IT IS ALSO CLEAR THAT THE ISRAELIS DO NOT WANT TO KEEP PERMANENT OCCUPATION FORCES IN THAT AREA. THEY WILL PROBABLY STAY THERE UNTIL SOME SOLUTION IS DEVISED BY THEM OR BY OTHERS.

WHATEVER THE RIGHTS AND WRONGS IN THE ISRAELI POSITION. WE HAVE A NEW SITUATION ON OUR HANDS. THERE IS NO PROSPECT THAT CONDITIONS IN SOUTHERN LEBANON CAN RETURN TO THE STATUS QUO ANTE. IT IS UP TO HIS TO THINK IMAGINATIVELY AND COLLECTIVELY ON WAYS TO CHANGE WHAT WILL OTHERWISE BE AN INTOLERABLE SITUATION. IT SEEMS TO ME THAT WE MUST AIM AT DEVELOPING A NEW STATUS QUO WHICH WOULD REST ON TWO BASIC COMPONENTS. THE PROBLEM IN LEBANON SHOULD BE DEALT WITH IN OTHER THAN A PURELY ARAB CONTEXT, WHERE THE SYRIANS AND PALESTINIANS EXERT DISPROPORTIONATE INFLUENCE AND CONTROL.

WE COULD MOVE TOWARDS THIS POSITION BY DEVELOPING A COORDINATED APPROACH TOWARDS PEACEKEEPING IN SOUTHERN LEBANON. (FOR USE WITH DUTCH, FRENCH AND NORWEIGIANS: IN

THE MEANTIME, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT UNIFIL REMAIN INTACT AND THAT YOU AND OTHER TROOP CONTRIBUTING STATES MAINTAIN YOUR FORCES THERE. WE WILL DO WHATEVER WE CAN TO ENSURE THAT THE ISRAELIS DO NOT INTERFERE WITH THEM.) ONLY IF WE HAVE A COORDINATED APPROACH WHICH DEALS FIRST WITH PEACEKEEPING AND ULTIMATELY WITH ALL ASPECTS OF THE SITUATION CAN WE HOPE TO ASSIST LEBANON, PROMOTE STABILITY, AND COUNTER SOVIET EFFORTS TO EXPLOIT THE

- SUMMARY: AS WE PREPARE THE WAY FOR THE PRESIDENT'S VISIT, WE WANT TO FOCUS MORE PUBLIC ATTENTION IN BRITAIN ON HIS START PROPOSALS, WHICH HAVE BEEN SIDELINED BY THE FALKLANDS. CAN YOU SEND A HIGH-LEVEL VISITOR? END SUMMARY.
- WITH THE PRESIDENT'S VISIT APPROACHING, A SPECIAL EFFORT IS WARRANTED TO DRIVE OUR MESSAGE HOME. THE START PROPOSALS GIVE US AN EXCELLENT POSITION TO ADDRESS PUBLIC INITIAL PRESS REACTION WAS GOOD, AND THE CONCERNS HERE. ANTI-NUCLEAR MOVEMENT APPEARS CONCERNED ABOUT HOLDING SUPPORT FOR THEIR JUNE DEMONSTRATIONS. BUT THE FALKLANDS HAVE LESSENED THE IMPACT.
