- 2. A WELL-PLACED MOD OFFICIAL TELLS US THAT THE "EXCLUSION ZONE" AROUND THE FALKLANDS IS NOT HERMETIC. THE AIR AND NAVAL SHELLING HAS NOT COMPLETELY SHUT DOWN PORT STANLEY AIRFIELD; LIGHT PLANES -- AND PERHAPS SMALL SHIPS -- CONTINUE TO GET TOUGH. THIS SOURCE INSISTED, HOWEVER, THAT THE RESUPPLY EFFORT WAS MARGINAL AND THAT NO MAJOR SUPPLIES WERE COMING THROUGH. THE MOD IS CONCERNED, HOWEVER, THAT C-130 TRANSPORTS WITH REDUCED PAYLOADS COULD LAND.
- 3. WITHOUT RULING OUT A DIRECT ASSAULT, THE SOURCE SAID THAT UNLESS THE ARGENTINES MADE A CONCERTED EFFORT TO BREAK THE BLOCKADE OR ATTACK THE TASK FORCE, THE MDST LIKELY NEXT BRITISH STEP WOULD BE CONTINUED HARASSMENT, SHELLING, AND BOMBING OF THE AIRFIELD AND MILITARY TARGETS. - 2. A SENIOR MOD OFFICIAL ADVISED THAT WE SHOULD EXPECT FURTHER MILITARY ACTION THIS WEEK. HE TOLD US MORNING MAY 4 THAT NOTT WOULD BE ANNOUNCING IN PARLIAMENT THIS AFTERNOON A SECOND AIR ATTACK ON PORT STANLEY AIRFIELD. (WE UNDERSTAND VULCAN (S) WERE AGAIN
- WE COULD NOT DRAW OUT OUR CONTACT ON SPECIFIC LIKELY NEXT STEPS, BUT HE LEFT THE CLEAR IMPRESSION THAT THIS MORNING'S AIR ATTACK WAS THE FIRST OF A SERIES OF MILITARY MEASURES. HE EMPHASIZED HMG REMAINS CONVINCED THAT MILITARY PUNISHMENT IS THE ONLY WAY TO BRING ABOUT A WITHDRAWAL OF ARGENTINE FORCES FROM THE FALKLANDS AND SUGGESTED THAT BRITISH SPECIAL FORCES WERE IN POSITION TO INFLICT DAMAGE. IN RESPONSE TO OUR QUERY HE DID NOT EXPECT THE BRITISH TO KNOCK OUT THE ISLAND'S WATER PURIFICATION PLANT AT THIS STAGE. HE CHARACTERIZED SUCH

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

A MOVE AS A SEVERAL NOTCH TURN OF THE MILITARY SCREW, WHICH THE GOVERNMENT DID NOT CURRENTLY WISH TO IMPLEMENT. HE ADDED THAT THE ROYAL NAVY WAS HAVING A DIFFICULT TIME LOCATING THE ARGENTINE SUBMARINE, WHICH APPARENTLY REMAINS INSIDE THE EXCLUSION ZONE. THE NAVY THOUGHT THEY HAD LOCATED THE SUBMARINE LAST SATURDAY EVENING, BUT THEN LOST IT.

THE SENIOR OFFICIAL UNDERLINED THAT SATURDAY'S AIR RAID HAD BEEN SUCCESSFUL BUT THE ARGENTINES COULD STILL FLY PUCARA AIRCRAFT FROM THE AIRFIELD. TODAY'S RAID (WHICH APPARENTLY TOOK PLACE EARLY THIS MORNING), HE SAID, IS INTENDED TO DISCOURAGE THE ARGENTINES FROM REPAIRING THE AIRFIELD AND AT THE SAME TIME FITS INTO BRITAIN'S STRATEGY OF TIGHTENING THE MILITARY VICE.

UNDER HEADLINE "TOP REAGAN AIDE SPELLS OUT THE TERMS FOR PEACE", APRIL 29 "GUARDIAN" FRONT-PAGED THE FOLLOWING STORY, WHICH WAS ALSO PLAYED UP ON BRITISH RADIO SAME MORNING. BEGIN QUOTE

DR. NORMAN BAILEY, THE WHITE HOUSE'S DIRECTOR OF NATIONAL SECURITY PLANNING, TOLD THE "GUARDIAN" YESTERDAY THAT BRITAIN AND ARGENTINA HAD AGREED TO A MUTUAL WITHDRAWAL OF FORCES, AND HAD ACCEPTED IN PRINCIPLE THE IDEA OF A JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF THE FALKLAND ISLANDS AFTER THE WITHDRAWAL. ACCORDING TO DR. BAILEY--ONE OF PRESIDENT REAGAN'S SENIOR ADVISERS AT THE NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL -- "A VERY SUB-STANTIAL AGREEMENT" HAD BEEN REACHED BEFORE THE BRITISH ASSAULT ON SOUTH GEORGIA. AFTER LAST WEEKEND, HOWEVER, THE GALTIERI GOVERNMENT HAD INITIALLY REACTED BY SAYING THAT, WITH THE OPENING OF HOSTILITIES, IT NO LONGER AGREED TO ANYTHING.

"I THINK IT NOW LOOKS A BIT GRIM, IN THAT BOTH SIDES SEEM TO HAVE PAINTED THEMSELVES INTO A CORNER," DR. BAILEY SAID.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

"IT MAY BE THAT SOME BLOOD HAS TO BE SHED BEFORE EVERYONE AGREES TO COME BACK TO THE NEGOTIATING TABLE." DR. BAILEY SAID THE UNITED STATES LAST WEEK ASKED THAT ANY BRITISH ASSAULT SHOULD BE DELAYED AND MRS. THATCHER HAD AGREED THAT THE NAVAL TASK FORCE WOULD SLOW DOWN. HE ESTIMATED THAT THIS HAD GIVEN MR. HAIG AN ADDITIONAL THREE DAYS FOR HIS DIPLOMATIC EFFORT. STRESSING THE DIFFICULTIES OF A LANDING ON THE FALKLANDS, HE SAID THAT THE ARGENTINIANS "ARE NOT A BANANA REPUBLIC" BUT HAD A WELL-TRAINED AND WELL-EQUIPPED ARMY. "IF THE BRITISH SUCCEED IN LANDING, IT'S GOING TO BE ONE HELL OF A FIGHT. " AMERICA'S CONCERN ABOUT THE POLITICAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE CRISIS, DR. BAILEY SAID, WAS THAT IF BRITISH (LINE MISSING) "THE GOVERNMENT WILL FALL." IT WAS, HE SAID, A "NO WIN SITUATION FOR THE UNITED STATES." HE SAID THAT BEFORE THE WEEKEND BOTH SIDES HAD AGREED TO

DIFFER ON THE KEY ISSUE OF SOVEREIGNTY, SIMPLY RESERVING THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS. MR. HAIG'S CONCILIATION EFFORT HAD FOUNDERED FIRSTLY ON HOW LONG THE INTERIM ADMINISTRATION SHOULD LAST.

"THE ARGENTINES WANT IT TO BE VERY SHORT AND THE BRITISH WANT IT TO BE RATHER LONG. HOWEVER, THAT'S THE KIND OF DISAGREEMENT THAT IS INHERENTLY RESOLVABLE -- YOU SPLIT THE DIFFERENCE OR SOMETHING OF THAT SORT. THAT DISAGREEMENT IS POTENTIALLY MUCH LESS SERIOUS THAN THE OTHER."
THE SECOND IMPASSE HAD ARISEN OVER THE METHOD OF DETERMINING THE WISHES OF THE FALKLANDERS, AND SEEMED TO POSE INSUPERABLE DIFFICULTIES. "OBVIOUSLY AS IN ANY REFERENDUM, THE WAY THE QUESTION IS ASKED CAN HEAVILY INFLUENCE, IF NOT DETERMINE THE OUTCOME OF THE REFERENDUM. THE ARGENTINES ARE CONCERNED THAT IT WILL SIMPLY SAY, 'DO YOU WANT THE FALKLANDS TO BE BRITISH OR ARGENTINE?' THE BRITISH, OF COURSE, ARE OPPOSED TO A SORT OF MEALY-MOUTHED WORDING WHICH WOULD END UP WITH THE SITUATION AS CONFUSED AS IT WAS BEFORE." DR. BAILEY SAID IT WAS CONCEIVABLE THAT SOME KIND OF SOLU-TION COULD BE REACHED BY SAYING, "ALL RIGHT, LET'S AGREE THAT THERE WILL BE A REFERENDUM, AND LET'S AGREE ON SOME KIND OF ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY IN THE ISLANDS IN THIS INTERIM PERIOD, AND THE WORDING OF THE REFERENDUM WILL BE DECIDED DURING THIS INTERIM." "THAT WOULDN'T SOLVE THE PROBLEM--WHICH IS PROBABLY BASICALLY UNSOLVABLE--BUT AT LEAST WOULD STOP THE HOSTILITIES AND DELAY THE ISSUE."

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

DENIED YESTERDAY THAT MR. HAIG HAD MADE ANY SPECIFIC OFFER TO THE GALTIERI GOVERNMENT TO RETURN TO BUENOS AIRES, THOUGH HE REMAINED READY TO DO SO "IF THE PARTIES FEEL IT HELPFUL."

THE OFFICIAL SPOKESMAN AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT STRONGLY

THOUGH A BRITISH SOURCE IN WASHINGTON SAID THAT SOME DETAILS IN THE PROPOSALS HAD BEEN MODIFIED, THE AMERICAN SPOKESMAN SAID THEY WERE THE SAME AS THOSE DISCUSSED WITH MR. PYM DURING HIS VISIT. MR. HAIG HAD "THOUGHT IT BEST TO PRESENT OUR IDEAS ON THE RESOLUTION OF THE DISPUTE DIRECTLY TO ARGENTINA, RATHER THAN TO AWAIT THE OUTCOME OF THE OAS MEETING.

- SUMMARY: WITH SOUTH GEORGIA RETAKEN, HMG IS NOW LOOKING TOWARD ADDITIONAL MILITARY STEPS TO BUILD PRESSURE FOR A SETTLEMENT ON BRITISH TERMS. FOR THE MOMENT, MRS. THATCHER HAS A RELATIVELY FREE HAND. GIVEN HER OWN JNCOMPRCEISING MOOD, WE EXPECT HER TO FORCE THE MILITARY PACE, CHOOSING ADDITIONAL STEPS IN THE NEAR TERM TO MINIMIZE RISK AND MAXIMIZE PUBLIC IMPACT. END SUMMARY.
- WE BELIEVE THAT HMG CONSIDERS AN ALL-OUT ASSAULT ON THE FALKLANDS A LAST RESORT. TO KEEP MILITARY PRESSURE ON THE ARGENTINES HMG COULD FOLLOW-UP THE SOUTH GEORGIA SUCCESS WITH A SERIES OF MILITARY ACTIONS INCLUDING ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- UNCONVENTIONAL WARFARE: THE PRESS TODAY IS FILLED WITH SPECULATION THAT THE NEXT MILITARY STEP WILL BE UNDERTAKEN ON THE FALKLANDS BY BRITISH SPECIAL AIR SERVICE (SAS) OR SPECIAL BOAT SERVICE (SBS) OPERATIONS.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

INDEED, THERE ARE REPORTS THAT THE SAS HAS ALREADY LANDED. DBVIOUS TARGETS FOR SUCH ACTION ON THE FALKLANDS WOULD INCLUDE POL FACILITIES, AIRCRAFT AT STANLEY AIRPORT, ESPECIALLY C-130 TRANSPORTS, AND WATER STORAGE SITES. THE BRITISH ARE CAPABLE OP DESTROYING POL FACILITIES WITH SAS OR SBS PERSONNEL WITHOUT CAUSING EXCESSIVE COLLATERAL DAMAGE OR CIVILIAN CASUALTIES.

- 2. DISAPPOINTMENT AND RESENTMENT AT THE U.S. ROLE IN THE FALKLANDS CRISIS HAS BEEN PRESENT IN THE PUBLIC DEBATE HERE SINCE THE INVASION (SEE REFS B, C AND D). THESE SENTIMENTS HAVE BEEN MUTED BY GENUINE APPRECIATION FOR THE SECRETARY'S EFFORTS TO RESOLVE THE CRISIS; BUT THEY COULD STILL BUBBLE OVER IF MEDIATION FAILS.

- -- FOURTH, SOLVE THE PROBLEM. GET BRITAIN OFF THE HOOK WITH A PEACEFUL OUTCOME THAT RESCUES BRITISH HONOR. ASSUAGE THE ARGENTINES.
- 6. IF HOPES FOR PEACE FADE, OPINION HERE WILL EXPECT US TO COME DOWN HARD ON ARGENTINA (AND WILL ACCUSE US OF NOT HAVING PRESSURED ARGENTINA HARD ENOUGH AT THE OUTSET).  THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT SHALL ADOPT MEASURES NECESSARY TO COMPLY, WITH RESPECT TO THE MALVINAS, SOUTH GEORGIA, AND SOUTH SANDWICH ISLANDS, WITH RESOLUTION 1514 (XV) OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS, COMPLETING THE DECOLONIZATION OF THE SAME BY 31 DECEMBER 1982, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTIONS 2065 (XX), 3160 (XXVIII), AND 31/49 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED STATES, IN THIS CASE THE PRINCIPLE OF ARGENTINE TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY IS APPLICABLE.

WE ARE CONCERNED THAT AMBASSADOR BROCK'S VISIT TO BUENOS AIRES, PRESUMABLY TO CHAIR U.S. SIDE OF REGULAR MEETING OF U.S.-ARGENTINE MIXED ECONOMIC COMMISSION, W BE MISINTERPRETED IN BRITAIN AND SPARK QUESTIONING OF U.S. CREDIBILITY. IF NOT TOO LATE, WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND THE MEETING BE POSTPONED. THE BRITISH HAVE NOT PRESSED US FOR A RESPONSE TO THEIR REQUEST FOR ACTION ON EXPORT CREDITS AND BANKS (LONDON 7519). HOWEVER, HMG WILL FIND IT HARD TO UNDERSTAND WHY WE APPEAR TO BE CONDUCTING ECONOMIC BUSINESS AS USUAL WITH ARGENTINA WHEN THEY ARE ON THE BRINK OF HOSTILITIES AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE EC HAVE RALLIED TO THEIR REQUEST FOR ECONOMIC SANCTIONS. THE GOVERNMENT WILL FACE SHARP QUESTIONING AND THE LEFT AND SOME OF THE PRESS WILL LIKELY TRY TO TURN THE DEBATE AGAINST US.

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

- 3. IN ECONOMIC TERMS, WE ASSUME THAT THE EFFECT OF EUROPEAN ACTIONS, IF THE CRISIS CONTINUES, WILL BE DISRUPTIVE TO THE ARGENTINE ECONOMY AND THAT IT WOULD NOT BE POSSIBLE NOW TO MAKE USEFUL LONGER TERM PLANS OR COMMITMENTS ABOUT BILATERAL ECONOMIC COOPERATION. POLITICALLY, THE VISIT COULD COMPLICATE THE SECRETARY'S POSITION AND CREDIBILITY WITH BRITISH AND WILL BE TAKEN AS EVIDENCE OF U.S. SUPPORT, REGARDLESS OF HOW LOW-KEY BROCK PLAYS IT.
- IF THE VISIT PROCEEDS, WE RECOMMEND WE BE AUTHORIZED TO INFORM BRITISH IMMEDIATELY AND GIVE SOLID RATIONALE FOR IT. IT WOULD HELP SUGAR THIS PILL IF WE COULD ALSO SAY THAT USG WILL IMPLEMENT THE ACTIONS THEY HAVE REQUESTED OF US, IF ONLY QUIETLY AND WITH NO PUBLICITY. OTHERWISE, WE BELIEVE OUR POSITION HERE MAY BE IN TROUBLE.
