2. THE US EXPECTS TO ISSUE A PRESIDENTIAL STATEMENT IN

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

THE NEAR FUTURE REGARDING THE US POSITION ON THE LAW OF THE-SEA TREATY. THE TEXT OF THE ANNOUNCEMENT IS CONTAINED IN PARA 3 BELOW. PLEASE PROVIDE THE TEXT AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE TO THE FOREIGN MINISTER OR HIGHER APPROPRIATE HOST GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL, BUT ASK THAT THEY HOLD THE INFORMATION IN CONFIDENCE UNTIL THE PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT IS MADE. WE WILL INFORM YOU WHEN THAT IS DONE.

3. TEXT: STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT

THE UNITED STATES HAS LONG RECOGNIZED HOW CRITICAL THE WORLD'S OCEANS ARE TO MANKIND AND HOW IMPORTANT INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS ARE TO THE USE OF THOSE OCEANS. FOR OVER A DECADE, THE UNITED STATES HAS BEEN WORKING WITH MORE THAN

150 COUNTRIES AT THE THIRD UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCE ON LAW OF THE SEA TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE TREATY.

ON JANUARY 29 OF THIS YEAR, I REAFFIRMED THE UNITED STATES' COMMITMENT TO THE MULTILATERAL PROCESS FOR REACHING SUCH A TREATY AND ANNOUNCED THAT WE WOULD RETURN TO THE NEGOTIATIONS TO SEEK TO CORRECT UNACCEPTABLE ELEMENTS IN THE DEEP SEABED MINING PART OF THE DRAFT CONVENTION. I ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT MY ADMINISTRATION WOULD SUPPORT RATIFICATION OF A CONVENTION MEETING SIX BASIC OBJECTIVES.

ON APRIL 30 THE CONFERENCE ADOPTED A CONVENTION THAT DOES NOT SATISFY THE OBJECTIVES SOUGHT BY THE UNITED STATES. IT WAS ADOPTED BY A VOTE OF 130 IN FAVOR, WITH 4 AGAINST (INCLUDING THE UNITED STATES) AND 17 ABSTENTIONS. THOSE VOTING "NO" OR ABSTAINING APPEAR SMALL IN NUMBER BUT REPRESENT COUNTRIES WHICH PRODUCE MORE THAN SIXTY PERCENT OF THE WORLD'S GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT AND PROVIDE MORE THAN SIXTY PERCENT OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE UNITED NATIONS.

WE HAVE NOW COMPLETED A REVIEW OF THAT CONVENTION AND RECOGNIZE THAT IT CONTAINS MANY POSITIVE AND VERY SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS. THOSE EXTENSIVE PARTS DEALING WITH NAVIGATION AND OVERFLIGHT AND MOST OTHER PROVISIONS OF THE CONVENTION ARE CONSISTENT WITH UNITED STATES INTERESTS AND, IN OUR VIEW, SERVE WELL THE INTERESTS OF NATIONS. THAT IS AN IMPORTANT ACHIEVEMENT AND SIGNIFIES THE BENEFITS OF WORKING TOGETHER AND EFFECTIVELY BALANCING

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

NUMEROUS INTERESTS. THE UNITED STATES ALSO APPRECIATES THE EFFORTS OF THE MANY COUNTRIES THAT HAVE WORKED WITH US TOWARD AN ACCEPTABLE AGREEMENT, INCLUDING EFFORTS BY FRIENDS AND ALLIES AT THE SESSION THAT CONCLUDED ON APRIL 30.

OUR REVIEW RECOGNIZES, HOWEVER, THAT THE DEEP SEABED MINING PART OF THE CONVENTION DOES NOT MEET UNITED STATES OBJECTIVES. FOR THIS REASON, I AM ANNOUNCING TODAY THAT THE UNITED STATES WILL NOT SIGN THE CONVENTION AS ADOPTED BY THE CONFERENCE, AND OUR PARTICIPATION IN THE REMAINING CONFERENCE PROCESS WILL BE AT THE TECHNICAL LEVEL AND CONCERNED WITH THOSE PROVISIONS THAT SERVE UNITED STATES INTERESTS.

THESE DECISIONS REFLECT THE DEEP CONVICTION THAT THE UNITED STATES CANNOT SUPPORT A DEEP SEABED MINING REGIME WITH SUCH MAJOR PROBLEMS. IN OUR VIEW, THOSE PROBLEMS INCLUDE:

-- PROVISIONS THAT WOULD ACTUALLY DETER FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF DEEP SEABED MINERAL RESOURCES, WHEN SUCH DEVELOPMENT COULD SERVE THE INTEREST OF ALL COUNTRIES.

-- A DECISION-MAKING PROCESS THAT WOULD NOT GIVE THE UNITED STATES OR OTHERS A ROLE THAT FAIRLY REFLECTS AND PROTECTS THEIR INTERESTS.

-- PROVISIONS THAT WOULD ALLOW AMENDMENTS WITHOUT APPROVAL OF ALL PARTICIPATING STATES, INCLUDING IN OUR CASE THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE. THIS IS CLEARLY INCOMPATIBLE WITH THE UNITED STATES PROCESS ON TREATIES.

-- STIPULATIONS RELATING TO MANDATORY TRANSFER OF PRIVATE TECHNOLOGY AND THE POSSIBILITY OF NATIONAL LIBERATION MOVEMENTS SHARING IN BENEFITS.

-- THE ABSENCE OF ASSURED ACCESS FOR FUTURE QUALIFIED DEEP SEABED MINERS TO PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT OF THESE RESOURCES

WE RECOGNIZE THAT CURRENT WORLD DEMAND AND MARKETS DO NOT JUSTIFY COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT OF DEEP SEABED MINERAL RESOURCES, AND IT IS NOT CLEAR WHEN SUCH DEVELOPMENT WILL BE JUSTIFIED. WHEN FACTORS BECOME FAVORABLE, HOWEVER,

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

THE DEEP SEABED REPRESENTS A POTENTIALLY IMPORTANT SOURCE OF STRATEGIC AND OTHER MINERALS. THE AIM OF THE UNITED STATES IN THIS REGARD HAS BEEN TO ESTABLISH WITH OTHER NATIONS AN ORDER THAT WOULD ALLOW EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT UNDER REASONABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

4. THE FOLLOWING ARE TALKING POINTS WHICH MAY BE USED AT TIME OF DELIVERING THE TEXT: -

- THE UNITED STATES APPRECIATES THE CONTRIBUTIONS (HOST GOVERNMENT) HAS MADE TO THE LOS NEGOTIATIONS OVER THE YEARS.

- WE BELIEVE THAT WE HAVE MANY LAW OF THE SEA INTERESTS IN COMMON.

- WE WOULD LIKE TO CONSULT WITH (HOST GOVERNMENT) IN NEAR FUTURE ON OUR POLICIES ON FULL RANGE OF LOS ISSUES.

5. IF ASKED ABOUT PARTICIPATING IN THE CONFERENCE PROCESS AND SIGNING THE FINAL ACT, YOU SHOULD NOTE THAT THE STATEMENT SPEAKS TO OUR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE. WE EXPECT TO SIGN THE FINAL ACT TO ATTEST TO OUR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE.

6. IF ASKED WHETHER WE WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE PREPARATORY COMMISSION, WE DO NOT PLAN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PREPARATORY COMMISSION IN ANY CAPACITY.

7. IF ASKED ABOUT US VIEWS ON THE POSSIBILITY OF IMPROVING THE LOS SEABED PROVISIONS OF THE TREATY IN COMING MONTHS, YOU MAY SAY THAT THE US IS AWARE OF THIS SPECULATION BUT, UPON EVALUATION, THERE IS NO EVIDENCE OF ANY PROSPECT FOR ACHIEVING SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO MEET US OBJECTIVES. STOESSEL

1. ENTIRE TEXT ~~SECRET~~.
2. UNDER SECRETARY EAGLEBURGER CALLED IN BRITISH CHARGE BRAITHWAITE JULY 2 TO REQUEST HMG'S REACTION TO POSSIBLE LIFTING OF US ECONOMIC SANCTIONS ON ARGENTINA. HE SAID THAT THE LONGER US SANCTIONS REMAIN IN FORCE, THE MORE DIFFICULT IT WILL BE FOR THE USG TO REPAIR RELATIONS WITH LATIN AMERICA.
3. EAGLEBURGER STRESSED THAT THE ADMINISTRATION WANTED TO BE SURE AND CONSULT WITH HMG BEFORE MAKING A DECISION, AND THAT THE UK WOULD BE INFORMED IN ADVANCE OF ANY FINAL DETERMINATION. BRAITHWAITE PROMISED TO SEEK AN EARLY REPLY FROM LONDON.
4. THE BRITISH THEN INFORMED US THEY HAD ASKED THE

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

SWISS TO PROPOSE TO THE ARGENTINES THAT THE UK AND ARGENTINA ENTER INTO IMMEDIATE COMMUNICATION THROUGH SWISS GOOD OFFICES, REGARDING THE EARLY EXCHANGE OF REMAINING PRISONERS OF WAR ON THE BASIS THAT ACTIVE HOSTILITIES ARE NOW AT AN END AND THE EXCHANGE WOULD BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GENEVA CONVENTION. THE UK HOPES TO ELICIT A TACIT RECOGNITION ON THE RECORD THAT ARGENTINA CONSIDERS ACTIVE HOSTILITIES OVER. EAGLEBURGER REMARKED THAT WE WOULD APPRECIATE BEING KEPT INFORMED OF DEVELOPMENTS ON THE PRISONER QUESTION, IN HOPES THAT ITS RESOLUTION COULD HELP THE U.S. BEGIN TO REPAIR RELATIONS WITH ARGENTINA.

5. PRESENT AT THE MEETING WERE RENWICK, UK HEA OF CHANCERY; DAVID GOMPERT FROM P; SHAW SMITH OF ARA/SC; AND KEITH SMITH OF EUR/NE.

SIDED AND HAVE NOT TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT THE SOVIET
INSISTENCE ON "EQUAL SECURITY". AS IN OUR PREVIOUS
MEETINGS, HE TRIED TO EVADE SOVIET RESPONSIBILITY FOR
THE DETERIORATION OF OUR BILATERAL RELATIONS AND INCREASED
INTERNATIONAL TENSIONS GENERALLY BY SHIFTING THE BLAME
TO US. MY RESPONSE FORCEFULLY REITERATED OUR CONVICTION
THAT IT IS THE SOVIETS THEMSELVES WHO HAVE CONSISTENTLY
VIOLATED THE PRINCIPLES OF INTERNATIONAL CONDUCT WHICH ARE
THE ONLY HOPE FOR A PEACEFUL WORLD. I REITERATED THE
PRESIDENT'S SINCERE DESIRE FOR A STABLE AND CONSTRUCTIVE
EAST/WEST RELATIONSHIP, BUT THAT THIS DEPENDS ON SOVIET
WILLINGNESS TO EXERCISE INTERNATIONAL RESTRAINT.

THE JUNE 18 DISCUSSION, WHICH LASTED FIVE HOURS, WAS
HEAVILY DEVOTED TO ARMS CONTROL ISSUES. GROMYKO STRONGLY
CRITICIZED OUR PROPOSALS WHILE PRESSING HARD FOR THE
RESUSCITATION OF INADEQUATE ARMS CONTROL AGREEMENTS OF
THE PAST, ESPECIALLY THE 1974 VLADIVOSTOK UNDERSTANDING
AND THE SALT II TREATY. HE REITERATED THE SOVIET NUCLEAR
NON-FIRST-USE PLEDGE HE MADE AT THE UN ON TUESDAY.

IN RESPONSE, I TOLD HIM IN NO UNCERTAIN TERMS THAT
STRICT EQUALITY IS THE ONLY BASIS FOR AGREEMENTS
BETWEEN US; THAT PREVIOUS AGREEMENTS WERE INADEQUATE
BECAUSE THEY DID NOT PROVIDE FOR SUCH EQUALITY AND
BECAUSE THEY FAILED TO LIMIT THE MOST DESTABILIZING
STRATEGIC SYSTEMS; AND THAT EQUITABLE AND SIGNIFICANT

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

REDUCTIONS IN SUCH SYSTEMS ARE THE ONLY MEANS OF EN-
SURING STRATEGIC STABILITY AT LOWER LEVELS OF FORCES.
AT THE SAME TIME, I MADE CLEAR THAT WE WILL CONSIDER
SERIOUSLY SOVIET PROPOSALS AND THAT NOTHING IS RULED
OUT OF THE NEGOTIATIONS. I TOLD HIM THAT THE NUCLEAR
NON-FIRST-USE PLEDGE IS ENTIRELY SELF-SERVING GIVEN THE
TREMENDOUS SOVIET CONVENTIONAL ADVANTAGE AND REITERATED
THAT NATO WOULD NEVER BE THE FIRST TO USE FORCE OF ANY
KIND IN EUROPE. IN SUM, I CHALLENGED GROMYKO TO STOP
POSTURING AND GET DOWN TO SERIOUS NEGOTIATIONS WITH US
IN THE INTEREST OF PEACE.

OUR SECOND DAY OF DISCUSSIONS WAS DEVOTED ALMOST
ENTIRELY TO REGIONAL ISSUES. GROMYKO LISTENED IMPASSIVELY
TO MY PRESENTATION ON THE URGENT NEED FOR POSITIVE
MOVEMENT IN POLAND. HE REACTED STRONGLY TO THE PRESI-
DENT'S DECISIONS ON POLISH SANCTIONS, BUT I REMINDED
HIM THAT WE HAD REPEATEDLY MADE CLEAR THAT OUR ECONOMIC
RELATIONS COULD NOT BE INSULATED FROM THE IMPACT OF
IRRESPONSIBLE SOVIET INTERNATIONAL BEHAVIOR. GROMYKO
DISCUSSED AFGHANISTAN IN FAMILIAR TERMS BUT DID AGREE
THAT WE WOULD CONTINUE WITH INTENSIFIED DISCUSSIONS OF
THIS ISSUE THROUGH OUR RESPECTIVE EMBASSIES. I
UNDERScoreD AGAIN THAT THE SOVIET OCCUPATION REMAINS
A MAJOR IMPEDIMENT TO IMPROVEMENT OF OUR BILATERAL
RELATIONSHIP.

GROMYKO PRESSED HARD ON THE MIDDLE EAST AND SEEMED
ANXIOUS TO CLAIM A SOVIET ROLE IN MIDDLE EAST DIPLOMACY.
HE PUSHED THE SOVIET PROPOSAL FOR AN INTERNATIONAL CON-
FERENCE, LINKING IT TO RECENT EVENTS IN LEBANON. I
REPLIED THAT WE INTEND TO CONTINUE ENERGETICALLY WITH
OUR OWN EFFORTS IN THE REGION, WHICH OFFER THE MOST
PROMISING AVENUE TO PEACE.

PERHAPS GROMYKO'S MOST POSITIVE COMMENTS ON REGIONAL
ISSUES CONCERNED SOUTHERN AFRICA. HE HINTED THAT THE
SOVIET UNION MIGHT BE WILLING TO STEP ASIDE AND
PERMIT THE CONTACT GROUP INITIATIVE TO PROCEED, BUT

HE ALSO EXPRESSED CONCERN FOR THE FUTURE OF THE MPLA REGIME IN ANGOLA IF IT WERE FORCED TO CONSIDER A RECONCILIATION WITH SAVIMBI. I MADE CLEAR THAT, IF THE SOVIETS CONTINUE THEIR DISRUPTIVE TACTICS, THEY WILL ONLY ISOLATE THEMSELVES. I ALSO RAISED CUBAN DE-

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

STABILIZING ACTIVITIES IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE VIETNAMESE OCCUPATION OF KAMPUCHEA, BUT GROMYKO'S REPLIES WERE STANDARD SOVIET FARE.

AT THE CLOSE OF OUR SECOND MEETING, GROMYKO ASKED FOR MORE PRECISE DETAILS ON OUR COMMITMENT NOT TO UNDERCUT EXISTING STRATEGIC ARMS AGREEMENTS AS LONG AS THE SOVIETS EXERCISE SIMILAR RESTRAINT. I REPLIED THAT WE ARE COMFORTABLE WITH EXISTING POLICY, AND THAT SPECIFIC QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DEALT WITH AT GENEVA.

GROMYKO ALSO RAISED THE POSSIBILITY OF A SUMMIT. I EXPRESSED REGRET THAT BREZHNEV HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO MEET WITH PRESIDENT REAGAN HERE, AND REPEATED THE PRESIDENT'S STATEMENT THAT HE LOOKED FORWARD TO SUCH A MEETING IN THE FUTURE WHEN POSITIVE RESULTS MIGHT BE EXPECTED.

FINALLY, I RAISED WITH GROMYKO A NUMBER OF HUMANITARIAN ISSUES, INCLUDING THAT OF SOVIET JEWISH EMIGRATION AND REMINDED HIM OF THE PRESIDENT'S PERSONAL INTEREST IN EARLY PROGRESS IN THIS AREA.

OVERALL, I CAME AWAY IMPRESSED HOW WORRIED AND DISTURBED GROMYKO WAS AT THE DEGREE TO WHICH WE HAVE SEIZED THE HIGH GROUND AND THE INITIATIVE IN EAST/WEST RELATIONS. I AM CONVINCED THAT THIS IS IN LARGE MEASURE DUE TO THE COMPREHENSIVE ARMS CONTROL PROGRAM WE HAVE PROPOSED AND THE IMPRESSIVE DEGREE OF UNITY AMONG US ON IT. AT THE SAME TIME, GROMYKO'S ATTITUDE TOWARDS OUR PROPOSALS INDICATE CLEARLY THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS AHEAD WILL BE DIFFICULT. I BELIEVE THE MEETING WAS USEFUL IN MAKING ABSOLUTELY CLEAR TO THE SOVIETS THAT OUR FULL AGENDA IS INTACT, AND THAT WE ARE PREPARED TO MOVE FORWARD ON A BROAD FRONT IF THE SOVIET UNION IS PREPARED SERIOUSLY TO ADDRESS THE FULL RANGE OF OUR CONCERNS. 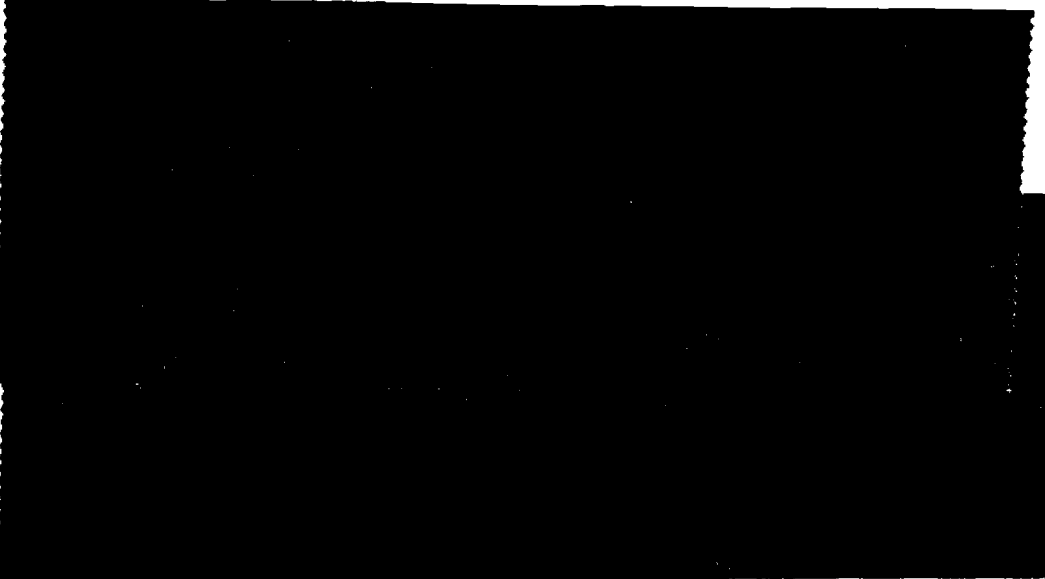

4. THE PARTIES TO THE 1959 ANTARCTIC TREATY INCLUDE

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

COUNTRIES HAVING TERRITORIAL CLAIMS TO ANTARCTICA AND OTHERS WHO REFUSED TO RECOGNIZE SUCH CLAIMS. THE US, THE UK AND ARGENTINA ARE ALL PARTIES. THE PRINCIPAL PURPOSES OF THE TREATY ARE THE DEMILITARIZATION OF ANTARCTICA AND THE ENCOURAGEMENT OF SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION.

5. ARTICLE I OF THE TREATY PROVIDES:
