COLOMBO WAS ACCOMPANIED BY MFA POLITICAL DIRECTOR BOTTAL, MFA ECONOMIC DIRECTOR BUCCI. AND CHEF DE CABINET VANNI. DISARMAMENT CHIEF TALIANI. AND AMBASSADOR TO WASHINGTON PETRIGNANI. WITH THE VICE PRESIDENT WERE AMBASSADOR RABB. ADMIRAL MURPHY, CHAIRMAN FELDSTEIN OF THE COUNCIL OF ECONOMIC ADVISORS, BURT, GREGG, BLAIR, AND BRIDGES (NOTETAKER). 3. THE VICE PRESIDENT BEGAN BY NOTING THAT AT THEIR INITIAL ROME MEETING HE HAD REAFFIRMED TO COLOMBO AND PRIME MINISTER FANFANI THE PURPOSE OF HIS VISIT. IT WAS A GOOD OPPORTUNITY TO CONSULT, IN A REAL SENSE. PRIVATELY WITH OUR ALLIES, WHILE HE WAS ALSO MAKING PUBLIC STATEMENTS INTENDED TO PUT IN PERSPECTIVE OUR VIEWS ON INF -- IDENTICAL WITH ITALIAN VIEWS. AS OF NOW, HE FELT THE TRIP WAS PROVING WORTHWHILE. HE WANTED TO REPEAT, AS HE HAD SAID ON ARRIVAL, WE FELT VERY CLOSE TO ITALY ON THIS AND ON MANY OTHER KEY ISSUES. IT APPEARED THAT RELATIONS BETWEEN OUR TWO GREAT COUNTRIES HAD NEVER BEEN BETTER. 4. COLOMBO SAID THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO CONFIRM THE USEFULNESS OF THIS TRIP. WHICH WAS CERTAINLY PROVING A SUCCESS, BOTH AS REGARDED PUBLIC RELATIONS ASPECTS AND AS REGARDED SUBSTANCE. COLOMBO SAID THAT SOON AFTER THE ANDROPOV PROPOSALS HE HAD BECOME CONVINCED, AND HE REMAIN-ED CONVINCED. THAT IT WAS VITAL FOR THE ALLIES TO COME SENSITIVE

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MESSAGE / ANNOTATION:

TO AGREEMENT, AND ALSO TO HAVE A QUICK EXCHANGE OF VIEWS AS SOON AS ANYTHING NEW DEVELOPED IN THE NEGOTIATIONS. IT WAS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT FOR THE ALLIES TO PRESENT A UNITED FRONT; IF THE SOVIETS SAW WESTERN UNITY. THIS SHOULD MAKE THEM SEE THE NEED FOR NEGOTIATIONS. 5. COLOMBO SAID THAT YESTERDAY'S ITALIAN NEWSPAPERS HAD TAKEN TWO DIFFERENT APPROACHES. THE MAJORITY HAD EMPHASIZED, WITH REGARD TO THE VISIT, THE INTEREST OF THE AMERICAN ADMINISTRATION IN SERIOUS NEGOTIATIONS. SOME PAPERS, HOWEVER, HAD CLAIMED THAT THE SOVIETS WERE NOT REALLY NEGOTIATING. ON THE LATTER POINT. THE VICE PRESIDENT HAD SAID AT PALAZZO CHIGI THAT THE ZERO OPTION WAS NOT A QUESTION OF TAKE IT OR LEAVE IT. COLOMBO THOUGHT THAT THIS ASPECT MIGHT WELL BE STRESSED WITH THE PRESS; WHILE AT THE SAME TIME WE MADE CLEAR THAT ANY MEASURES WE ADOPTED WOULD HAVE TO PROVIDE FOR THE WEST SECURITY, PARITY AND EQUITY. AGAIN, THOUGH, IT WOULD BE IMPORTANT TO STRESS THAT SOMETHING WAS MOVING IN THE **NEGOTIATIONS**.

6. THE VICE PRESIDENT SAID THAT THIS WAS PART OF THE REASON FOR HIS TRIP. THERE HAD BEEN GENERAL UNDERSTANDING ABROAD THAT THE PRESIDENT WAS INTENT ON BUILDING UP OUR DEFENSES, BUT THE OTHER ASPECT HAD NOT BEEN UNDERSTOOD, I.E. THE PRESIDENT'S WILLINGNESS TO TALK PEACE AND REDUCE ARMAMENTS. IT WAS IMPORTANT TO EMPHASIZE BOTH ASPECTS, AND OF COURSE THE FACT THAT WE WOULD ACT IN CONCERT WITH OUR ALLIES.

7. COLOMBO SAID HE THOUGHT THE VICE PRESIDENT MIGHT HE ASKED WHETHER THE UNITED STATES WAS AIMING AT MILITARY SUPERIORITY. PERHAPS HE MIGHT REPLY THAT THE UNITED STATES NATURALLY WANTED TO ENSURE THE SECURITY OF ITSELF AND ITS EUROPEAN ALLIES. THE VICE PRESIDENT MIGHT ALSO BE ASKED WHETHER WE WERE REFUSING TO CONSIDER INCLUSION OF FRENCH AND BRITISH MISSILES, AND WHETHER THIS MEANT THE UNITED STATES DID NOT WANT PARITY BUT SUPERIORITY. THE ITALIANS HAD ALREADY COMMENTED ON THIS LAST TO THE EFFECT THAT THE FRENCH AND BRITISH MISSILES WERE STRATEGIC WEAPONS COVERED BY SALT II -- ALTHOUGH GROMYKO HAD TRIED TO CLAIM THAT THE SOVIETS HAD BEEN "LOOKING THE OTHER WAY" ON THIS -- AND THAT THE FRENCH AND BRITISH WERE NATIONAL WEAPONS WHICH COULD NOT DEFEND OTHER COUNTRIES SUCH AS ITALY AND FRG. FINALLY, COLOMBO SUGGESTED THAT THE VICE PRESIDENT MIGHT BE ASKED WHETHER, IF THE ANDROPOV PRO-POSALS WERE UNACCEPTABLE. WE INTENDED TO WAIT FOR THE SOVIETS TO MAKE NEW PROPOSALS OR WOULD MAKE SOME OF OUR OWN. THIS WAS AN IMPORTANT QUESTION, NOT JUST FOR THE

THE VICE PRESIDENT SAID HE WOULD ONLY ADD TO THIS. IF ASKED. THAT HE WOULD TAKE BACK TO THE PRESIDENT ANY PROPOSALS MADE. COLOMBO SAID THAT HE HAD SUGGESTED THESE POSSIBLE 9 . QUESTIONS BECAUSE WE NEEDED TO THINK AHEAD TO WHAT MIGHT HAPPEN AT THE CLOSE OF THIS YEAR. AS REGARDED CONSULTA-TIONS, COLOMBO THOUGHT THEY WERE GOING WELL, BOTH BILATERALLY AND MULTILATERALLY. THERE WAS HOWEVER A QUESTION HOW WE COULD PUT MORE STRESS PUBLICLY ON THE FACT OF CONSULTATIONS WITH BASING COUNTRIES, IN ADDITION TO THE NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE SOVIETS. 10. THE VICE PRESIDENT SAID THAT MR. BURNT MIGHT BEST REPLY TO THIS: FIRST, HE DID WANT TO STRESS HIS HOPE THAT THIS TRIP WOULD LAY TO REST ANY QUESTION ABOUT THEIR WILLINGNESS TO CONSULT. 11. BURT SAID THAT WE WERE VERY SENSITIVE TO MINISTER COLOMBO'S EXPRESSED CONCERNS. THERE WOULD BE A NEW SCG MEETING LATER IN FEBRUARY. WE HAD ALREADY BEGUN QUINT MEETINGS WITH BASING COUNTRIES. SO FAR THESE MEETINGS HAD BEEN KEPT PRIVATE, IN ORDER NOT TO BROADCAST THE IDEA THAT SOME NATO MEMBERS WERE NOT PARTICIPATING. 12. COLOMBO SAID THAT HE AGREED WITH WHAT BURT HAD SAID. STRESSING THAT HE HAD NOT WANTED IN ANY WAY TO UNDER EVALUATE THE IMPORTANCE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT'S TRIP. 13. THE VICE PRESIDENT SAID THAT HE FULLY AGREED THAT THE LESS THE U.S. APPEARED TO BE DICTATING TO OTHERS, THE BETTER. HE THANKED THE MINISTER FOR HIS SUGGESTIONS. WHICH COULD BE USEFUL IN DISCUSSIONS WITH NON-EXPERTS, DEMONSTRATING GEOGRAPHICALLY AND DRAMATICALLY THE CONTINUED GROWTH OF SOVIET MISSILE DEPLOYMENTS SINCE THE INF DECISION OF DECEMBER 1979. 15. COLOMBO ASKED THE VICE PRESIDENT WHAT HE THOUGHT ABOUT POSSIBILITIES IN THE START TALKS. THE VICE PRESI-DENT NOTED ROWNY'S SOMEWHAT OPTIMISTIC PUBLIC STATEMENT. HE HAD TO NOTE THAT IN THE KARPOV SESSION. AFTER SAYING HELLO TO KARPOV THE LATTER HAD CONTINUED FOR AN HOUR WITHOUT INTERRUPTION -- NOT THAT THE VICE PRESIDENT HAD EXPECTED HOM TO SHOW FLEXIBILITY. SPEAKING GENERALLY, THE VICE PRESIDENT CONTINUED. WE THOUGHT THAT REDUCING STRATEGIC ARMS SHOULD HAVE BROUGHT POPULAR SUPPORT. TO SOME EXTENT START HAD BEEN ECLIPSED BY INF, WHICH WAS ALSO LINKED TO THE GERMAN ELECTIONS. COLOMBO EXPRESSED HIS UNDERSTANDING, AND THEN NOTED THAT HE WOULD BE SEEING AMBASSADOR HABIB LATER IN THE DAY; HE WAS GRATEFUL TO THE VICE PRESIDENT AND MR. BURT FOR HELPING ARRANGE THIS MEETING. COLOMBO ASKED THE VICE PRESIDENT TO EXPRESS TO THE PRESIDENT ITALIAN CONCERNS ABOUT THE MIDDLE EAST AND ESPECIALLY LEBANON. HE SAID THAT THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT WAS CONVINCED THAT THINGS WERE PROCEEDING TOWARD A NEW PERIOD OF DETERIORATION DISORDER. HE COULD BE WRONG ON THIS, POLITICAL MEN HAD TO CONSIDER WORST-CASE POSSIBILITIES. HE WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE EFFECT OF A DELAY IN MIDDLE EAST NEGOTIATIONS. THE FIRST TWO YEARS OF THE REAGAN ADMINIS-TRATION HAD ENDED. AND PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGNING WOULD SOON BEGIN IN THE UNITED STATES. FRANKLY, COLOMBO DID NOT THINK THAT ANY AMERICAN PRESIDENT COULD TAKE STIFF POSITIONS ON THE MIDDLE EAST DURING SUCH A CAMPAIGN. PERHAPS ISRAEL WAS COUNTING ON THIS, ALTHOUGH COLOMBO HOPED THIS WAS NOT SO. 



PEOPLE CONSIST OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE WEST BANK AND GAZA AS WELL AS PALESTINIAN CITIZENS RESIDING ABROAD. WHILE YOUR PROJECT REFERS TO THE WEST BANK AND GAZA INHABITANTS, IT MAKES NO MENTION OF THE PALESTINIAN REFUGEES AND THE HOMELESS FOR WHOM THE UNITED NATIONS RESOLUTIONS GUARANTEED THE RIGHT TO RETURN HOME AND. BECAUSE OF THE DEEPLY-ROOTED AND MOST GENUINE BONDS MUSLIMS ALL OVER THE WORLD FEEL THEY HAVE WITH JERUSALEM, THE ARAB ASPECT OF THIS CITY HAS BEEN, AND CONTINUES TO BE, OF GREAT CONCERN FOR THE WORLD MUSLIM COMMUNITY. FURTHER-MORE, JERUSALEM IS CONSIDERED AS ONE OF THE THREE HOLIEST PLACES AND THE FIRST OF THE TWO PRAYING DIRECTIONS TOWARDS WHICH MUSLIM ANCESTORS ORIGINALLY TURNED. FOR THESE REASONS, IN ADDITION TO MY CAPACITY AS CHAIRMAN OF AL-QODS COMMITTEE WHICH IS THE MOUTHPIECE OF THE MUSLIM WORLD, I PERSONALLY FEEL A SPECIAL CONCERN FOR THE MATTER. BESIDES, YOUR PEACE PROJECT DOES ENVISAGE POSSIBLE NEGOTIATIONS TO DECIDE ON THE FINAL STATUS OF JERUSALEM. IT IS A KNOWN FACT THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA HAVE CONSTANTLY POINTED OUT THAT EAST JERUSALEM IS A PART OF THE WEST BANK, THUS OPPOSING ISRAEL'S DECISION TO ANNEX JERUSALEM, AND VOTING IN FAVOR OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 475 WHICH CONSIDERS THE ANNEXATION PROCESS AS NULL AND VOID.

IN YOUR SPEECH, MR. PRESIDENT, YOU HAVE REFERRED TO A UNIFIED JERUSALEM, SOMETHING ABOUT WHICH A QUESTION REMAINS TO BE ANSWERED.

CONCERNING THE QUESTION OF SETTLEMENTS IN THE OCCUPIED

MESSAGE (CONTINUED):

TERRITORIES, WE KNOW THAT ISRAEL! SETTLEMENTS ESTABLISHED SINCE 1967 HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AS ILLEGAL OPERATIONS OBSTRUCTING THE WAY FOR PEACE.

YOUR PEACE PROJECT, MR. PRESIDENT, HAS COME OUT AGAINST THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW SETTLEMENTS. HOWEVER, IT SAYS NOTHING OF THE REMOVAL OF THE PRESENT ONES ESTABLISHED BY ISRAEL IN THE WEST BANK AND THE GAZA STRIP. SUCH SETTLEMENTS ARE ACTUALLY NOTHING BUT SIGNS OF OCCUPATION. WHILE, AT THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL, YOU HAVE VDTED AGAINST THE POLICY OF SETTLEMENTS AND ANNEXATION, YOUR PROJECT CALLED FOR A "SETTLEMENT FREZE." WE THEREFORE HOPE THAT YOUR ADMINISTRATION WILL CONFIRM A CONTINUED AMERICAN POLICY TOWARDS SETTLEMENTS WHICH SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ILLEGAL. THE PRINCIPLE OF GLOBAL PEACE IN RETURN FOR A TOTAL WITHDRAWAL AS FORMULATED IN YOUR PROJECT, HAS ALREADY BEEN PUT INTO EFFECT IN THE ISRAELI-EGYPTIAN AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE SINAI. IT IS ONLY NATURAL, THEREFORE, THAT IT BE APPLIED IN CONNECTION WITH THE REMAINING ARAB TERRITORIES OCCUPIED SINCE 1967. CONSEQUENTLY, WE FEEL THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA SHOULD CONTINUE TO SUPPORT THE PRINCIPLES THIS FAR ADHERED TO. MR. PRESIDENT, THERE IS ONE MORE POINT THAT NEEDS CLARIFYING, AND THAT IS THE PALESTINIAN REPRESENTATION. OBVIOUSLY, THE CENTRAL PROBLEM IN THE NUDDLE FAST ISSUE IS THE QUESTION

CENTRAL PROBLEM IN THE MIDDLE EAST ISSUE IS THE QUESTION OF PALESTINE. IN THE ARAB-ISRAELI CONFLICT, THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE ARE THE MAIN VICTIMS. WE THEREFORE FEEL THAT THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE PEACE PROCESS IS INDISPENSABLE. CONVENED IN A SUMMIT CONFERENCE IN RABAT IN 1974, ARAB LEADERS AGREED UNANIMOUSLY - ON THE BASIS OF THEIR AWARENESS OF PALESTINIAN REALITIES AND THEIR CONVICTION AS TO THE WISHES OF THE INHABITANTS IN THE WEST BANK AND GAZA - TO RECOGNIZE THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZA-TION AS THE LEGITIMATE AND SOLE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PALESTINIAN PEOPLE. MOREOVER, RECENT EVENTS HAVE CLEARLY SHOWN THAT THE INHABITANTS OF THE WEST BANK AND GAZA INSIST ON SEEING THE P.L.O. AS THEIR REPRESENTATIVE. UNDOUBTEDLY, THE SUREST WAY OF MEASURING THE EXTENT OF THE P.L.O.'S REPRESENTATIVITY WOULD BE TO SOUND THE PALESTINIANS THEMSELVES THROUGH A REFERENDUM FREELY AND IMPARTIALLY

ON GROUNDS THAT BRITAIN CANNOT AFFORE IT; AND THAT THATCHER HAS HARDENED AGAINST FURTHER MILITARY COMMITMENTS ABROAD. WE THEREFORE BELIEVE IT WOULD BE MOST EFFECTIVE FOR WASHINGTON TO PURSUE THE ISSUE AT THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF HMG IN SUPPORT OF THE LEBANESE REQUEST, AND TO KEEP IN MIND THAT A DIRECT APPROACH TO THATCHER FROM PRESIDENTS REAGAN AND GEMAYEL ARE LIKELY TO BE MORE PERSUASIVE ON AN ISSUE WHERE POSITIONS HERE HAVE ALREADY HARDENED THAN MESSAGES PASSED UP BY PYM. -- STRICT REASSURANCES SHOULD BE CONVEYED THAT BRITAIN WILL NOT BE AGREEING TO AN OPEN-ENDED COMMITMENT. THE BRITISH SHOULD BE TOLD EXPLICITLY THAT THEIR MNF CONTINGENT WILL BE WITHDRAWN NO LATER THAN A DATE CERTAIN REGARDLESS OF PROGRESS MADE IN EXPANDING THE CAPABILITIES AND SIZE OF THE LAF.




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

AS OF SEPTEMBER 23, A TOTAL OF 219 CASES HAD BACKED UP AT THEIR FREIGHT FORWARDER N NEW YORK (WEDENAM & GODMEGHT, 75 BROADWAY, N.Y.C. PHONE 212-269-2141, MR. HE!DEL), AND THE NUMBER IS GROWING DAILY. ONLY 21 OF THESE CASES HAVE BEEN RELEASED BY THE FORWARDER AND HAVE ALLEGEDLY BEEN HELD UP SINCE SEPTEMBER 1 IN U.S. CUSTOMS (BRITISH AIRWAYS AIRWAY BILL 12578174821).
