SUBJECT: Soviet Space Spectacular (U)

There is a chance that the Soviets will attempt a manned space spectacular prior to our space Shuttle launch, now scheduled for early April.

[Redacted] Regardless of application--civil or military--the Soviets certainly would publicize the event as another "space first" to gain prestige. Moreover, it would likely be timed to compete with the publicity attending a successful Shuttle launch. (S)

This possible Soviet event--even if exaggerated--is not the equal of the Shuttle. It is indeed only a logical next step in the extensive Soviet manned space program. Nevertheless, it may take on inappropriate significance with worrisome political and military overtones. As with Sputnik, it might be viewed as being a greater threat than is actually the case. (S)

We need to take precautions to assure that the US Government is able to respond to anticipated inquiries in a way that places the possible Soviet event in proper perspective. Accordingly, I have directed that an interdepartmental task force examine what the Soviets are up to and how we should respond, both substantively and in terms of public relations. I will keep you informed. (G)
