THE ELIMINATION OF PLD TERRORISM WILL BE AN IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTION TO THE WELL-BEING OF THE ARAB INHABITANTS OF JUDEA, SAMARIA AND THE GAZA DISTRICT AND TO THEIR CHANCES OF JUINING THE PEACE PROCESS," SAID THE FOREIGN MINISTER.
