1. HIGHLIGHTS

- POLITICAL CORRESPONDENTS WRITE THAT ISRAEL IS AFTER A "NEW POLITICAL SETTLEMENT" IN LEBANON AND IS TRYING TO ENLIST THE HELP OF LEBANON'S "MAJOR POLITICAL FORCES" TO THAT END. GOVERNMENT SOURCES ARE QUOTED TO THE EFFECT THAT ISRAEL STILL PLANS TO PULL OUT OF THE COUNTRY.
 - THE CONSENSUS AMONG EDITORIAL WRITERS IS THAT "THE TIME HAS COME FOR A CEASEFIRE." MAARIV EVEN FEARS THAT "ISRAEL IS TAKING LEAVE OF THE CONSTRAINTS OF POLITICAL REASON."
 - REPORTS FROM WASHINGTON SAY THAT THE U.S. IS WORRIED ABOUT THE ESCALATING ISRAELI OPERATION IN LEBANON.
 - CORR. WOLF BLITZER SAYS THAT "THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION CAN BE EXPECTED TO COME DOWN 'VERY HARD' ON ISRAEL IN THE COMING DAYS."
 - ALL MEDIA CARRY DEFMIN SHARON'S EXPLANATION, THAT THE ATTACK ON THE SYRIAN MISSILES AND ARMOR WAS MOTIVATED BY PURELY MILITARY REASONS.
 - MAARIV MILITARY CDRR. FEELS THAT ISRAELI-SYRIAN CLASHES MAY LEAD TO "THE BIG BANG."
 - ISRAEL RADIO REPORTED IN LATE MORNING THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN SENT AN URGENT MESSAGE TO PRIME MINISTER BEGIN, CALLING FOR AN IMMEDIATE END TO THE FIGHTING.

A) ISRAEL RADIO POLITICAL CORR. SHIMON SHIFFER SAID THIS MORNING THAT WHAT IS UNFOLDING NOW IN LEBANON "GRADUALLY REVEALSTHE POLITICAL OBJECTIVES UP THE 'PEACE FOR GALILEE' OPERATION. ACCORDING TO SOME," SAID CORR. SHIFFER, "THE OPERATION SHOULD ACTUALLY BE CODENAMED 'PEACE FOR THE REGION.' INDEED," OBSERVED THE RADIO CORR., "ISRAEL WILL SEEK, ONCE THE FIGHTING IS OVER, TO ASSIST IN THE CREATION OF A NEW SETTLEMENT IN LEBANON, WHICH WILL INCLUDE, IN ADDITION TO THE EVICTION OF TERRORIST GUNS AND THE DESTRUCTION OF THEIR WAR MACHINE, THE STRENGTHENING OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT. IT CAN BE ASSUMED THAT ISRAEL WILL GET IN TOUCH WITH VARIOUS POLITICAL FORCES IN LEBANON. POLITICAL SOURCES TOLD ME LAST NIGHT," REPORTED CORR. SHIFFER, "THAT ISRAEL DOES NOT WISH TO DRIVE THE SYRIANS OUT OF LEBANON. JERUSALEM MAY ASK THAT ALL FOREIGN FORCES LEAVE THE COUNTRY. HOWEVER, THIS IS NOT GOING TO BE A SINE QUA NON FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE ISRAELI TROOPS...." WHAT ISRAEL PREFERS, SAID CORR. SHIFFER, IS FOR A MULTINATIONALFORCE, BACKED BY THE U.S., "TO FILL THE VOID LEFT BY THE TERRORISTS." FAILING THAT, A STRONGER UNIFIL COULD DO THE JOB. IN ANY CASE, ISRAEL STILL DOES NOT WANT WAR WITH THE SYRIANS, SHIFFER'S SOURCES SAID. A STABLE ARRANGEMENT IN LEBANON COULD BEST BE ACHIEVED THROUGH ISRAELI-SYRIAN COOPERATION.

B) HA'ARETZ POLITICAL CORR. UZI BENZIMAN ALSO WRITES THAT "ISRAEL'S DESIRE TO START TALKING TO POLITICAL ELEMENTS WITHIN LEBANON ABOUT A NEW INTERNAL SETTLEMENT IN THAT COUNTRY WOULD SOON BECOME APPARENT. ISRAEL'S MAJOR THRUST WOULD BE DIRECTED TOWARD THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY IN LEBANON," SAID THE HA'ARETZ CORR.

C) JERUSALEM POST CORR. BENNY MORRIS WRITES THAT "OBSERVERS NOW FEEL THAT THE STAGE IN LEBANON IS NOW GRADUALLY BEING SET FOR THE EVENTUAL ESTABLISHMENT OF A 'PAX ISRAELICA' IN THE AREA, INVOLVING THE COMPLETE DESTRUCTION AND/OR EVICTION OF THE PLO AND ITS MILITARY ARMS FROM THE TERRITORY OF LEBANON, AND THE EVACUATION FROM THAT COUNTRY OF ALL SYRIAN AND ISRAELI FORCES." AS TO AMB. HABIB'S DIPLOMATIC EFFORTS, CORR. MORRIS CITES HIS "OBSERVERS" TO THE EFFECT THAT "HABIB'S CHANCES OF IN ANY WAY AFFECTING THE DIRECTION AND SCOPE OF EVENTS IN LEBANON IN THE COMING DAYS ARE MINIMAL."

D) AL-HAMISHMAR REPORTS THAT "GOVERNMENT SOURCES REITERATED ISRAEL'S WILLINGNESS TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE SYRIANS, THROUGH AMB. HABIB, A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT PREVENTING
