1. FOLLOWING, TITLED "US AID OFFICIAL ARRIVES IN LEBANON," HAS BEEN PREPARED FOR RELEASE AT 0900 GMT, JULY 8:

2. BEGIN TEXT: M. PETER MCPHERSON, ADMINISTRATOR OF THE US AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT, ARRIVED IN BEIRUT TODAY TO EXPEDITE THE U S HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM IN LEBANON. MR MCPHERSON IS PRESIDENT REAGAN'S PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE COORDINATION OF LEBANESE RELIEF.

3. MR MCPHERSON WAS ACCOMPANIED, ON HIS ARRIVAL IN LEBANON, BY ARTHUR E. DEWEY, DEPUTY ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE FOR REFUGEE PROGRAMS.

4. DURING THEIR VISIT, MR MCPHERSON AND MR DEWEY WILL MEET WITH OFFICIALS OF THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT, THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY. THEY WILL CALL ON PRESIDENT SARKIS TOMORROW AT 0900 HRS (0700 GMT). THE MCPHERSON PARTY WILL ALSO VISIT SOUTH LEBANON.

5. MR MCPHERSON AND MR DEWEY LEAVE LEBANON FRIDAY AFTERNOON.

6. ON HIS RETURN TO WASHINGTON, MR MCPHERSON WILL REPORT TO PRESIDENT REAGAN IMMEDI-53)6. HE WILL GIVE THE PRESIDENT HIS VIEWS ON THE DAMAGE AND NEEDS IN LEBANON AND ON ASSISTANCE THE UNITED STATES CAN PROVIDE FOR RELIEF, REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION.

7. THE UNITED STATES HAS ALREADY PLED \$ 17 MILLION DOLLARS FOR URGENT NEEDS IN LEBANON. THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS HAS ALSO GIVEN PRELIMINARY APPROVAL FOR AN ADDITIONAL 50 MILLION DOLLARS FOR LEBANON. END TEXT.

HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS;" THAT ISRAEL MAKES A "PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL FROM THE BEIRUT-DAMASCUS HIGHWAY;" THAT TWO PLO MILITARY UNITS, OF 250 TROOPS EACH, BE STATIONED IN NORTH LEBANON AND THE BEKA'A VALLEY; AND THAT PLO MEN EVACUATED FROM BEIRUT BE ALLOWED TO KEEP THEIR HEAVY MILITARY HARDWARE, AND NOT JUST PERSONAL ARMS. HA'ARETZ POLITICAL CORR. REPORTS THAT THE PLAN WAS SUBMITTED SATURDAY NIGHT BY AMB. LEWIS TO PRIME MINISTER BEGIN. 3. "NEW INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE PRESIDENT TO HABIB," ISRAEL RADIO POLITICAL CORR. SHIMON SHIFFER REPORTS THAT "SECRETARY HAIG AND AMB. HABIB HAVE ASKED ISRAEL TO BE PATIENT, SINCE THEY ARE ON THE WAY TO FIND A SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM OF THE TERRORISTS IN BEIRUT." THE SECRETARY'S APPEAL WAS CONVEYED THROUGH AMB. ARENS, SAYS ISRAEL RADIO, AND AMB. HABIB'S THROUGH DEFMIN SHARON. THE LATTER, SAYS THE RADIO REPORT, REPLIED THAT ISRAEL WAS WILLING TO GIVE DIPLOMACY A CHANCE, BUT THAT, CONCURRENTLY, THE NOOSE AROUND TERRORIST QUARTERS IN BEIRUT WILL BE TIGHTENED. CORR. SHIFFER ADDS THAT PLO'S ARAFAT DID GIVE THE LEBANESE A "WRITTEN PAPER," TO THE EFFECT THAT HIS PEOPLE ARE PREPARED TO LEAVE BEIRUT, PROVIDED ONE OF THEIR LEADERS BE ALLOWED TO STAY BEHIND TO RUN AN INFORMATION OFFICE. ISRAEL RADIO ALSO QUOTES WHITE HOUSE SPOKESMAN LARRY SPEAKES, THAT THE PRESIDENT LAST NIGHT SENT AMB. HABIB "NEW INSTRUCTIONS" REGARDING THE LEBANON CRISIS.

4. SHARON, KIMCHE, MEET WITH AMB. HABIB; ALL MEDIA REPORT ON THE MEETING YESTERDAY IN BEIRUT BETWEEN THE TWO ISRAELI OFFICIALS AND THE U.S. SPECIAL ENVOY. DAVAR SAYS THAT SHARON AND KIMCHE "WANTED TO LEARN FIRSTHAND WHETHER THE AMERICAN OPTIMISM REGARDING A POLITICAL SOLUTION TO THE PRESENCE OF THE TERRORISTS IN LEBANON WAS JUSTIFIED." CORR. DENIAL BLOCH ADDS THAT SHARON AGREED TO THE AMERICAN REQUEST TO LIFT A LITTLE THE PRESSURE IN WEST BEIRUT AND LET THE AREA GET WATER AND ELECTRICITY.

5. "NO ROOM FOR OPTIMISM," HA'ARETZ CORR. BEGIN, SHARON RISE IN POPULARITY POLL: A JERUSALEM POST PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY, CONDUCTED BY MODI'IN EZRAHI INSTITUTE DURING THE THIRD WEEK OF THE WAR (JUNE 21-30) GIVES THE FOLLOWING RESULTS: 51.5 PCT NOW FEEL THAT BEGIN IS BEST SUITED TO BE PREMIER.
