THE TERRORISTS HAVE EVERY INTEREST IN GAINING TIME. THEY ASSUME THAT AS LONG AS DIPLOMATIC NEGOTIATIONS ARE GOING ON, THE IDF WILL NOT ENTER WEST BEIRUT." IN BEIRUT YESTERDAY THE DEFENSE MINISTER SAID TO PHILIP HABIB: "WE HAVE OUSTED THE TERRORISTS FROM SOUTH AND CENTRAL LEBANON. THEY SHALL ALSO NOT REMAIN IN WEST BEIRUT. WE WANT THE POLITICAL PROCESS TO BEAR FRUIT. IT IS THE ONLY WAY FOR THE TERRORISTS TO SAVE THEIR LIVES." HE STRESSED THAT ISRAEL WILL NOT AGREE TO ANY PROCRASTINATION BY THE TERROR ORGANIZATIONS. PHILIP HABIB EXPRESSED CAUTIOUS OPTIMISM REGARDING THE PROSPECTS OF A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT. AS FOR LEBANESE PRIME MINISTER SHAFIK EL-WAZZAN'S NINE POINT DOCUMENT, WHICH PHILIP HABIB REPORTED TO HIS ISRAELI INTERLOCUTORS TO HAVE BEEN SIGNED BY THE TERRORISTS, THE DEFENSE MINISTER CLEARLY ASSERTED THE ISRAELI GOVERNMENT'S POSITION ACCORDING TO WHICH ALL TERRORISTS AND THEIR LEADERS, WITHOUT ANY EXCEPTION, MUST UNCONDITIONALLY LEAVE LEBANON. HE REJECTED OUT OF HAND THE LEBANESE PRIME MINISTER'S PROPOSALS FOR A COMPREHENSIVE SETTLEMENT OF THE LEBANON PROBLEM. ISRAEL HAS ALSO REJECTED PROPOSALS FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF IDF FORCES FROM BEIRUT, AS PART OF THE POLITICAL SETTLEMENT PERMITTING THE TERRORISTS TO MAINTAIN A POLITICAL OFFICE IN BEIRUT AND A LIMITED PRESENCE WITHIN THE LEBANESE ARMY, UNTIL THEIR EVACUATION HAS BEEN ACHIEVED. ISRAEL'S STANCE, AS EXPRESSED BY SHARON, WAS THAT THE TERRORISTS WERE IN NO POSITION TO DICTATE TERMS TO ISRAEL.
