NOTES, HOWEVER, THAT SINCE THE STORY WAS LEAKED BY "VERY HIGH SOURCES IN THE WHITE HOUSE," IT MAY HAVE MEANT TO INDICATE A "POST-HAIG SHIFT IN U.S. FOREIGN POLICY."

CORR. SHIFFER PROCEEDED TO QUOTE ISRAELI SOURCES TO THE EFFECT THAT "SOME PROGRESS HAS BEEN MADE YESTERDAY ON A NUMBER OF ISSUES," AND THAT "MORE PATIENCE IS NEEDED." CORR. SHIFFER ALSO REVEALED ISRAELI-RUMANIAN CONTACTS IN RECENT DAYS, ABOUT A "RUMANIAN PLAN TO EVACUATE THE TERRORISTS." THE U.S. IS AWARE OF THOSE CONTACTS, SAID CORR. SHIFFER. JERUSALEM, HOWEVER, DOES NOT THINK MUCH OF THE RUMANIAN PLAN.

B) ISRAEL RADIO AND HA'ARETZ REPORT THAT GREECE IS READY TO SEND A "SMALL CONTINGENT" TO A PEACEKEEPING FORCE IN LEBANON, PROVIDED ALL PARTIES INVOLVED, INCLUDING THE U.S. AND THE SOVIET UNION ACCEPT THE OFFER.
