4. (C/NOFURN) WITHIN ISRAEL, THERE ARE GROWING INDICATIONS THAT THE LIMITS OF TOLERATION FOR A PEACEFUL SOLUTION ARE BEING DUTLINED IF NOT AT THE SAME TIME APPROACHED. AT A PRU-GOVERNMENT RALLY ON 17 JULY PRIME MINISTER BEGIN NOTED THAT "THE MURDERERS IN BEIRUT" DO NOT HAVE 30 DAYS TO LEAVE AND THAT ISRAEL CAN"FINISH UFF" THE REMAINING 10 OF THE "TERRURISTS". FURTHERMORE, WHILE THERE AWARE NO OFFICIAL STATEMENTS FULLOWING THE 18 JULY REGULAR ISRAELI CABINET SESSION, SOURCES INTIMATED THAT NO PROGRESS IS BEING MADE IN THE ONGOING BEIRUT NEGOATIONS. THEREFORE, A PERCEIVED DEADLOCK IN DIPLOMATIC NEGOTIATIONS IN CONJUNCTION WITH MORE INCIDENTS OF HOSTILITIES CAUSING ISRAELI CASUALTIES INCREASES THE POSSIBILITY THAT THE ISRAELI CABINET WILL DECIDE THAT A MILITARY ASSAULT ON AT LEAST THE SUBURBS OF WEST BEIRUT IS NECESSARY REGARDLESS OF THE ASSOCIATED COSTS.
