GENERALLY QUIET AS OF 1700 EDT, ALTHOUGH SMALL ARMS AND ARTILLERY FIRE WAS EXCHANGED AROUND BURJ AL-BARAJINAH FOR SEVERAL HOURS EARLIER IN THE DAY. THE MUSEUM AND PORT CROSSINGS HAVE REMAINED CLOSED, AND BEIRUT RADIO REPORTS THAT THE GALERIE SEMAAN CROSSING WAS CLOSED AT 1600 GMT AS A RESULT OF PALESTINIAN SNIPER FIRE. EMBASSY BEIRUT REPORTS THE ISRAELIS ALLOWED A FIVE TRUCK ICRC RELIEF CONVOY (4 TRUCKS OF FOOD AND 1 OF MEDICINE INTO WEST BEIRUT AND THAT ICRC WILL ATTEMPT TO GET ANOTHER CONVOY IHROUGH TOMORROW. THE SYRIAN PRESS CARRIED A STATEMENT BY A MILITARY SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCING THAT SYRIAN CASUALTIES IN BEIRUT IN THE LAST WEEK WERE 64 DEAD AND WOUNDED, SUGGESTING THAT THE REMAINING SYRIAN TROOPS IN BEIRUT ARE ACTIVELY RESISTING ISRAELI FURCES.
